

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person hable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount including any interest additional amount, addition to tax or dispossable perivate together with any costs that may accele in addition. Sharelpy shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the habitity for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxon, eraining out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgmant Lien Creditors,—Incident apposed by seath a 8321 shall not be valid as opened any porchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic scener, or pagament ion or aditor until notice thereof which mepts the reducements of subsection (f) has been filled by the Secretary

n Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed-

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental auditivation), as designated by the laws of auch State, in which the property subject to the lien as attuitated; and

(ii) Personal Property-in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the Len is situated; except that State law merely conforming to reducting Federal law establishing a national filing system does not constitute a second office for fiting in designated by the laws of such State, or

(B) With Clerk Of District Courl-in the office of the clerk of the Indiced States particl courl for the judicial district in which the property subject to flux is situated, whonever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the

requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbla - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia. 2) Sius Of Emperty Subject To Libra - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated-(A) Feat Property - In the case of real property, at its physical state - or

(B) Personal Property in the case of personal property, whether varigible or intengible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time of involves of lien is filed.

Fir purplishs of peragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or patherning shall be deemed to be the place at which the principle of active office of the business is located, and the residence of a copyer whose residence is without the United State conditions of and the place of the p

(3) Form - ha form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid remainful anding any other provision of law regarding the form or could's of a notice of lien.

(g) Refiling Of Notice.—For purposes of this section-

(1) General Rule,—unless notice of lian is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refling period, such notice of lian shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsoction (f) after the expiration of such refilling period.

(2) Place For Filling,—A notice of tien ratifed during the required refilling period shall be effective only-

(A) If-

(i) such notice of lian is railled in the office in which the prior notice of lian was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, and the fact of retilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refling of notice of tien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concurring a change in the Lapsyer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filled in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is tocalled.

(3) Required Refilling Period,—Its the case of any notice of tien, the term "lequired retiting period" means.

(A) the she-year period ending 30 days after the expertuon of 10 years after the date of the assessment of the tax and

(B) the pre-year period ending with the expiration of 10 years after the close of the preceding required reffling period for such notice of ten.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lieft.—Subject to such requirations as the Secretary may preactibe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any illen imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or

has become iscally uncolorceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest to respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any numeric relating to tenns, and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to tenns, conditions, and form of the bond an sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6:03. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(to Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes.—

{2} Disclosure of amount of outstanding illen,-if a notice of iter has been filled pursuant to section 5323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such illen may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
