Unit No. 137-A as delineated on Survey of the following described Parcel of Real Estate (hereinafter referred to as "Parcel"): Part of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 24, Township 42 North, Range 11 East of the Third Principal Meridian, being situated in Wheeling Township, Cook County, Illinois, which Survey is attached as Exhibit "A" to Declaration of Condominium for Quincy Park Condominium Number 2, made by Exchange National Bank of Chicago, a National Banking Association, as Trustee under Trust Agreement dated January 4, 1971 and known as Trust Number 24678 recorded in the Office of Recorder of Cook County, Illinois as Document 21720673 together with an undivided .90845 percent interest in said Parcel (excepting from said Parcel all the property and space comprising all the units thereof as defined and set forth in said Declaration and Survey) in Cook County, Illinois

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
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
