THIS MORTGAGENS DATED JUNE 13, 1991, between FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF EVERGREEN PARK, whose address is 3101 VEST 95TH STREET, EVERGREEN PARK, IL 60642 (referred to below as "Grantor"); and SOUTHWEST FINANCIAL BANK AND TRUST, whose address is 9901 S. WESTERN AVENUE, CHICAGO, IL 60643 (referred to below as "Lender").

GRANT OF MORTGAGE. For valuable consideration, Grantor not personally but as Trustee under the provisions of a deed or deeds in trust duly recorded and delivered to Crimtor pursuant to a Trust Agreement dated February 17, 1988 and known as TRUST \$15083, mortgages and conveys to Lender all of Grantot's hight, title, and interest in and to the following described real property, logether with all existing or subsequently erected or affixed buildings, improvements and fixtures; all easements, rights of way, and appurtenances; all water, water rights, watercourses and ditch rights (including stock in utilities with cital or irrigation rights); and all other rights, royalties, and profits relating to the real property, including without limitation all minerals, oil, gas, geothermy and similar matters, located in COOK County, State of Illinois (the "Real Property"):

The Real Property or its address is commonly known as 2605 WEST 106TH STREET, CHICAGO, IL 60655. The Real Property tax Identification number is 24-13-227-013

Grantor presently assigns to Lender all of Grantor's right, tile, and interest in and to all leases of the Property and all Rents from the Property. In addition, Grantor grants to Lender a Uniform Commercial Code of carrier in the Personal Property and Rents.

DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following meal sings when used in this Mortgage. Terms not otherwise defined in this Mortgage shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Uniform Commercial Code. All references to dollar amounts shall mean amounts in lawful money of the United States of America.

Credit Agreement. The words "Credit Agreement" mean the revolving I' he of credit agreement dated June 13, 1991, between Lender and Grantor, with a credit limit of \$30,000.00, together with all renewals of, extensions of modifications of, refinancings of, consolidations of, and substitutions for the Credit Agreement. The interest rate under the revolving line of cientify a variable interest rate based upon an Index. The index currently is purely 8.500% per annum. The interest rate to be applied to the outstanding account balance shall be at a rate 1.000 percentage points above the index, subject however to the following minimum and maximum rates. Under no closur stances shall the interest rate be less than 5.000% per annum or more than the lesser of 18.000% per annum or the maximum rate allowed by a plicable law.

Existing indebtedness. The words "Existing indebtedness" mean the indebtedness described below in the Existing Indebtedness section of this Mortgage.

Grantor. The word "Grantor" means FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF EVERGREEN PARK, T.ur.ee under that certain Trust Agreement dated February 17, 1988 and known as TRUST #10083. The Grantor is the mortgagor under this Mortgago.

Quarantor. The word "Quarantor" means and includes without limitation, each and all of the price; sureties, and accommodation parties in connection with the indebtedness.

Improvements. The word "Improvements" means and includes without limitation all existing and future improvements, fixtures, buildings, structures, mobile homes affixed on the Real Property, facilities, additions and other construction on the Real Property.

Indebtedness. The word "Indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under the Credit Agre me it and any amounts expended or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Grantor or expenses incurred by Lender to enforce obligation of Grantor under this Mortgage, together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Mortgage. Specifically, without limitation, this Mortgage secures a revolving line of credit, which obligates Lender to make advances to Grantor so long as Grantor compiles with all the tomic of the Gredit Agreement.

Lender. The word "Lender" means SOUTHWEST FINANCIAL BANK AND TRUST, its successors and assigns. The Lender is the mortgages under this Morigage.

Mortgage. The word "Mortgage" means this Mortgage between Grantor and Lender, and includes without limitation at a signments and security interest provisions relating to the Personal Property and Rents.

Personal Property. The words "Personal Property" mean all equipment, fixtures, and other articles of personal property now or hereafter owned by Grantor, and now or hereafter attached or affixed to the Real Property; together with all accessions, parts, and additions to, all replacements of. and all substitutions for, any of such property; and together with all proceeds (including without limitation all insurance proceeds and refunds of premiums) from any sale or other disposition of the Property.

Property. The word "Property" means collectively the Real Property and the Personal Property.

Real Property. The words "Real Property" mean the property, interests and rights described above in the "Grant of Mortgage" section.

Related Documents. The words "Related Documents" mean and include without limitation all promiseory notes, credit agreements, loan agreements, guaranties, security agreements, mortgages, deeds of trust, and all other instruments and documents, whether now or hereafter existing, executed in connection with Grantor's Indebtedness to Lender.

Rents. The word "Rents" means all present and luture rents, revenues, income, issues, royalties, profits, and other benefits derived from the Property.

THIS MORTGAGE, INCLUDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND THE SECURITY INTEREST IN THE RENTS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY, IS GIVEN TO SECURE (1) PAYMENT OF THE INDESTEDNESS AND (2) PERFORMANCE OF ALL OBLIGATIONS OF GRANTOR UNDER THIS MORTGAGE AND THE RELATED DOCUMENTS. THIS MORTGAGE IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except as otherwise provided in this Mortgage, Grantor shall pay to Lender all amounts secured by this Mortgage as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grantor's obligations under this Mortgage.

POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that Grantor's possession and use of the Property shall be governed by the following provisions:

Possession and Use. Until in default, Grantor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the Rents from the Property.

Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in tenantable condeon and promptly perform all repairs, replacements, and maintenance necessary to preserve its value. Hazardous Substances. The terms "hazardous waste," "hazardous substance," "disposal," "release," and "threatened release," as used in this

(c) Except as previously disclosed to and acknowledged by Lender in writing, (f) neither Grantor nor any tenant, contractor, agent or other authorized user of the Property and (ii) any such activity shall be conducted in compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations and ordinances, including without limitation those laws, regulations, and ordinances described above. Grantor substance of the Property so make such inspections and tests as Lander may deem appropriate to determine compliance of the Property with this section of the Mortgage. Any inspections or tests made by Lender shall be for Lender's purposes only and shall not be construed to create any responsibility or liability on the part of Lender to Grantor becomes l

Nulsance, Waste. Gramor shall not cause, conduct or permit any nulsance nor commit, permit, or suffer any stripping of or waste on or to the Property or any portion of the Property. Specifically without limitation, Grantor will not remove, or grant to any other party the right to remove, any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), soil, gravel or rock products without the prior written consent of Lender.

Removal of Improvemer ta. Grantor shall not demolish or remove any improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Lander. As a condition to the comoval of any improvements, Lender may require Grantor to make arrangements satisfactory to Lander to replace such improvements with imploy/ments of at least equal value.

Lender's Right to Enter. Lender and its agents and representatives may enter upon the Real Property at all reasonable times to attend to Lender's interests and to inepect the Fronerty for purposes of Grantor's compliance with the terms and conditions of this Mortgage.

Compliance with Governmental mequirementa. Grantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations, now or hereafter in effect, of all governmental authorities ar pilosole to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may comest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Lender in writing prior to doing so and so long as Lander's interests in the Property are not jeopardized. Lender may require Grantor to post adequate security or a surety bond, reasonably satisfactory to Lander, to protect Lender's interest.

Duty to Protect. Grantor egrees neither to abandon on leave unattended the Property. Grantor shall do all other acts, in addition to those acts set forth above in this section, which from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the Property.

DUE ON SALE - CONSENT BY LENDER. Lender may, at it is of tion, declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this upon the sale or transfer, without the Lender's prior written consent, of all or the Real Property, or any interest in the Real Property. A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of Real Property or any right, title or interiest therein; whether legal or equitable; whether voluntary or involuntary; whether by outright sale, deed, installment sale contract, iand contract, contact for oned, leasehold interest with a term greater than three (3) years, lease-option contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer of any beneficial interest it or to any land trust holding title to the Real Property, or by any other method of conveyance of Real Property interest. If any Grantor is a corporation or extremship, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than twenty-five percent (25%) of the voting stock or partnership interests, as no lease may be, of Grantor. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if such exercise is prohibited by federal law or by litinois law.

TAXES AND LIENS. The following provisions relating to the taxes and liens on the property are a part of this Mortgage.

Payment. Grantor shall pay when due (and in all events prior to delinquency) p. taxes, payroll taxes, special taxes, assessments, water charges and sewer service charges levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property are of all liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, except for the Existing Indebtedness referred to below, and except as otherwise provided in the following paragraph.

Right To Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in confection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Lender's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. If a lien arises or is filed and incompayment, Grantor shall within fifteen (15) days after the lien arises or, if a lien is filed, within fifteen (15) days after Grantor has nother start, the filing, secure the discharge of the lien, or if requested by Lender, deposit with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Lender in an amount sufficient of decharge the lien plus any costs and attorneys' less or other charges that could accrue as a result of a foreclosure or sale under the lien. In any costs, Grantor shall defend itself and Lender and shall satisfy any adverse judgment before enfor ament against the Property. Grantor shall name Lender as an additional obligee under any surety bond furnished in the contest proceedings.

Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand turnsih to Lender satisfactory evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate governmental official to deliver to Lender at any time a written statement of the law as and assessments against the Property.

Notice of Construction. Gramor shall notify Lender at least fifteen (15) days before any work is commenced, any narrices are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property, if any mechanic's iten, materialmen's iten, or other iten could be asserted or natural of the work, services, or materials and the cost exceeds \$1,500.00. Grantor will upon request of Lender turnish to Lender advance assurance satisfactory to Lander that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any colonarance clause, and with a standard mortgages clause in favor of Lender. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor shall deliver to Lender certificates of coverage from each insurar containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lender.

Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Lender of any loss or damage to the Property if the estimated cost of repair or replacement exceeds \$1,500,00. Lender may make proof of loss if Grantor falls to do so within fifteen (15) days of the casualty. Whether or not Lander's security is impaired, Lender may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness, payment of any lien affecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Lender elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed improvements in a manner satisfactory to Lender. Lender shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimbures Grantor from the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been disbursed within 180 days after their receipt and which Lender has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used first to pay any amount owing to Lender under this Mortgage, then to prepay accrued interest, and the remainder, if any, shall be paid to Grantor.

Unexpired insurence at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall inure to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Mortgage at any trustee's sale or other sale held under the provisions of this Mortgage, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property.

Compliance with Existing Indebtedness. During the period in which any Existing Indebtedness described below is in effect, compliance with the insurance provisions contained in the instrument evidencing such Existing Indebtedness shall constitute compliance with the insurance provisions under the Mortgage, to the extent compliance with the terms of this Mortgage would constitute a duplication of insurance requirement. It any proceeds from the insurance become payable on lose, the provisions in this Mortgage for division of proceeds shall apply only to that portion of the proceeds not payable to the holder of the Existing Indebtedness.

Granter's Report on Insurance. Upon request of Lander, however not more than once a year, Granter shall furnish to Lender a report on each existing policy of insurance showing: (a) the name of the insurer; (b) the risks insured; (c) the amount of the policy; (d) the properly insured, the then current replacement value of such properly, and the manner of determining that value; and (e) the expiration date of the policy. Granter shall, upon request of Lender, have an independent apprecial assistanced to Lender determine the cash value replacement cost of the Property.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. It Grantor tells to compty with any provision of this Mortgage, including any obligation to maintain Existing Indebtedness in good standing as required below, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interests in the Property, Lender on Grantor's behalf may, but shall not be required to, take any action that Lender deems appropriate. Any amount that Lender expends in so doing will be ar interest at the rate charged under the Credit Agreement from the date incurred or paid by Lender to the date of repayment. All such expenses, at Lender's option, will (a) be payable on demand, (b) be added to the balance of the credit line and be apportioned among and be payable with any installment payments to become due during either. (i) the term of any applicable insurance policy or. (ii) the remaining term of the Credit Agreement, or. (c) be treated as a balloon payment which will be due and payable at the Credit Agreement's maturity. This Mortgage also will secure payment of these amounts. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Londer may be entitled on account of the default. Any such action by Lender shall not be construed as curing the default so as to ber Lender from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

#### WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE. The following provisions relating to ownership of the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Title. Grantor warrants that: (a) Grantor holds good and markutable title of record to the Property in fee simple, free and clear of all liens and encumbrances other than those set forth in the Real Property description or in the Existing Indebtedness section below or in any title insurance policy, title report, or final title opinion issued in lavor of, and accepted by, Lander in connection with this Mortgage, and (b) Grantor has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Mortgage to Lander.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Granter warrants and will torover detend the title to the Property against the lewful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Granter's title or the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, Granter shall defend the action at Granter's expense. Granter may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of Lender's own choice, and Granter will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as Lender may request from time to time to permit such participation.

Compliance With Lews. Grantor warrants that the Property and Grantor's use of the Property complies with all existing applicable laws, ordinances, and Lautitions of governmental authorities.

#### EXISTING INDESTEDNES: The following provisions concerning existing indebtedness (the "Existing indebtedness") are a part of this Mortgage.

Application of Net Proceeds. If all or arr part of the Property is condemned by eminent domain proceedings or by any proceeding or purchase in lieu of condemnation, Lender may at it. \*\*e\*\* or require that all or any portion of the not proceeds of the sward be applied to the indebtedness or the repair or restoration of the Property. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees necessarily paid or incurred by Grantor or Lender in connection with the condemnation.

Proceedings. If any proceeding in condomnation is filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Lender in writing, and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and pot in the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver or cause to be delivered to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such participation.

Current Taxes, Fees and Charges. Upon request by Lender Grantor shall execute such documents in addition to this Mortgage and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's ilen on the Real Property. Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all taxes, as described below, together with all expenses incurred in recording perfecting or continuing this Mortgage, including without limitation all taxes, fees, documentary stamps, and other charges for recording or regimering this Mortgage.

Taxes. The following shall constitute taxes to which this section applies: (r) a specific tax upon this type of Mortgage or upon all or any part of the Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage; (b) a specific tax on Grantor which Grantor is authorized or required to deduct from payments on the Indebtedness secured by this type of Mortgage; (c) a tax on this type of Mortgage chargeable against the Lender or the holder of the Credit Agreement; and (d) a specific tax on all or any portion of the Indebtedness or on payments of principal and interest made by Grantor.

Subsequent Taxes. If any tax to which this section applies is enacted subsequent in the date of this Mortgage, this event shall have the same effect as an Event of Default (as defined below), and Lender may exercise any or all of its worldable remedies for an Event of Default as provided below unless Grantor either. Security Agreement. This instrument shall constitute a security agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes fixtures or other personal property, and Lender shall have all of the rights of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code to amended from time to time.

Security interest. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute financing statements and take whatever line action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's security interest in the Rents and Personal Property. Addresses. The mailing addresses of Grantor (debtor) and Lender (secured party), from which information concrete the security interest granted by this Mortgage may be obtained (each as required by the Uniform Commercial Code), are as stated on the first page of this Mortgage.

FURTHER ASSURANCES; ATTORNEY-IN-FACT. The following provisions relating to turther assurances and attorney-in-fact are a part of this Mortoscie.

Further Assurances. At any time, and from time to time, upon request of Lender, Grantor will make, execute and deliver, or will cause to be made, executed or delivered, to Lender or to Lender's designes, and when requested by Lender, cause to be filed, recorded, refilled, or rerecorded, as the case may be, at such times and in such offices and places as Lender may deem appropriate, any and all such mortgages, deeds of trust, security deeds, security agreements, financing statements, continuation statements, instruments of further assurance, certificates, and other documents as may, in the sole opinion of Lender, be necessary or desirable in order to effectuate, complete, perfect, continue, or preserve (a) the obligations of Grantor under the Credit Agreement, this Mortgage, and the Related Documents, and (b) the liens and socurity interests created by this Mortgage on the Property, whether now owned or hereafter acquired by Grantor. DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lender, shall constitute an event of default ("Event of Default") under this Mortgage: (a) Grantor commits fraud or makes a material misrepresentation at any time in connection with the credit line account. This can include, for example, a false statement about Grantor's income, assets, liabilities, or any other aspects of Grantor's financial condition. (b) Grantor does not meet the replayment terms of the credit line account. (c) Grantor's action or inaction adversely affects the collateral for the credit line account or Lander's rights in a collateral. Lender shall have the right to be placed as mortgages in possession or to have a receiver appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding foreclosure or sale, and to collect the Rents from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, against the indebtodness. The mortgages in possession or receiver may serve without bond if permitted by law. Lender's right to the appointment of a receiver shall exist whether or not the apparent value of the Property exceeds the incebtedness by a substantial amount. Employment by Lender shall not disquality a person from serving as a receiver.

Judicial Foresteaurs. Lender may obtain a judicial decree forestesing Grantor's interest in all or any part of the Property.

Deficiency Judgm At. If permitted by applicable law, Lender may obtain a judgment for any deficiency remaining in the indebtedness due to Lender after application of all amounts received from the exercise of the rights provided in this section.

Other Remedies. Under shall have all other rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or the Credit Agreement or svallable at law or in equity.

Walver; Election of Remedies. A walver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a walver of or prejudice the party's rights otherwise to demand strict compliance with that prevision or any other provision. Election by Lender to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an action to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Mortgage after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect tunour's right to declare a default and exercise its remedies under this Mortgage.

Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. If Lender institutes any suit or action to entorce any of the terms of this Mortgage, Lender shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge responsible as into mays' fees at trial and on any appeal. Grantor size will pay any court costs, in addition to all other sums provided by law.

Whenever consent by Lender is required in this Mortgage, the granting of such consent by Lender in any instance shall not constitute continuing consent to subsequent instances where such consent is required.
