MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE IS DAGED JUNE 19, 1991, between Stewart Ridge Community Church of Chicago Illinois, a Religious Coporation of Illinois, whose address is 7939 W. 167th St., Tinley Park, IL. 60477 (referred to below as "Grantor"); and Heritage Brink Tinley Park, whose address is 17500 Oak Park Avenue, Tinley Park, IL. 60477 (referred to below as "Lender").

GRANT OF MORTGAGE. For valuable consideration, Crantor mortgages, warrants, and conveys to Lender all of Grantor's right, site, and interest in and to the following described real property, together with all existing or subsequently erected or affixed buildings, improvements and licens; all easements, rights of way, and appurtenances; all water, water rights, watercourses and disch rights (including stock in utilities with disch or irrigation rights); and all other rights, royalties, and profits relating to the real property, including without limitation all minerals, oil, gas, geothermal and similar matters, located in Cook County, State of Illinois (Inc.) "Real Property"):

Parcel 2: Lot 4 in Turner Subdivision of that part of the North West 1/4 of the North West 1/4 of Section 25, Township 36 North, Range 12 East of the Third Principal Meridian, described as follows: In commencing at the North West Corner of said North West 1/4; thence North 89 Degrees 56 Minutes 22 Seconds East, 550 feet along the North Line of said North West 1/4; thence South 00 Degrees 03 Minutes 38 Seconds East, 290 feet; thence South 33 Degrees 05 Minutes 21 Seconds, West 335 feet to the West line of said North West 1/4; thence North 00 Degrees 00 Minutes 55 Seconds East, 620 feet on last said West line to the Point of Beginning, all in Cook Courty, Illinois.

The Real Property or its address is commonly known as 7939 W. 167th S.L., Tinley Park, il. 60477. The Real Property tax identification number is 27-25-308-046-0000.

Grantor presently assigns to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to all leases of the Property and all Rents from the Property. In addition, Grantor grants to Lender a Uniform Commercial Code security interest in the Personal Property and Rents.

DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following meanings when used in this Montgage. Terms in a otherwise defined in this Montgage shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Uniform Commercial Code. All references to dollar amounts shall mean amounts in tawful money of the United States of America.

Grantor. The word "Grantor" means Stewart Ridge Community Church of Chicago Illinois, a Religious Coporarion of Illinois... The Grantor is the mortgagor under this Mortgage.

Guarantor. The word "Guarantor" means and includes without limitation, each and all of the guarantors, suredes, and connection with the indebtedness.

Improvements. The word "improvements" means and includes without limitation all existing and future improvements, fatures, buildings, structures, mobile homes affixed on the Real Property, facilities, additions and other construction on the Real Property.

Indebtedness. The word "Indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under the Note and any amounts expended or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Grantor or expenses incurred by Lender to enforce obligations of Grantor under this Mongage, together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Mongage.

Lender. The word "Lender" means Heritage Bank Tinley Park, its successors and assigns. The Lender is the mortgagee under this Mortgage.

Mortgage. The word "Mortgage" means this Mortgage between Grantor and Lender, and includes without limitation all assignments and security interest provisions relating to the Personal Property and Rents.

Note. The word "Note" means the promissory note or credit agreement dated June 19, 1991, in the original principal amount of \$280,000.00 from Grantor to Lender, together with all renewals of, extensions of, modifications of, refinancings of, consolidations of, and substitutions for the promissory note or agreement. The interest rate on the Note is 10.000%. The maturity date of this Mortgage is July 5, 1995.

Personal Property. The words "Personal Property" mean all equipment, findures, and other articles of personal property now or hereafter owned by Grantor, and now or hereafter attached or afficied to the Real Property; together with all accessions, parts, and additions to, all replacements of, and all substitutions for, any of such property; and together with all proceeds (including without limitation all insurance proceeds and refunds of premiums) from any sale or other disposition of the Property.

Property. The word "Property" means collectively the Real Property and the Personal Property.

Real Property. The words "Real Property" mean the property, interests and rights described above in the "Grant of Morigage" section.

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Related Documents. The words "Related Documents" mean and include without limitation at promissory notes; credit agreements, loan agreements, guaranties, security agreements, mortgages, deeds of trust, and all other instruments and documents, whether now or hereafter existing, executed in connection with Grantor's Indebtedness to Lender.

Rents. The word-"Rents" means all present and future rents, revenues, income, issues, royalises, profits, and other benefits derived from the Property.

THIS MORTGAGE, INCLUDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND THE SECURITY INTEREST IN THE RENTS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY, IS GIVEN TO SECURE (1) PAYMENT OF THE INDEBTEDNESS AND (2) PERFORMANCE OF ALL OBLIGATIONS OF GRANTOR UNDER THIS MORTGAGE AND THE RELATED DOCUMENTS. THIS MORTGAGE IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except as otherwise provided in this Mongage, Grantor shall pay to Lender all amounts secured by this Mongage as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grantor's obligations under this Mortgage.

POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that Grantor's possession and use of the Property shall be governed by the tollowing provisions:

Possession and Usa. Until in default, Grantor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the Rents from the Property.

Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in tenantable condition and promptly perform all repairs, replacements, and maintenance necessary to presente the value."

Hazardous Substance. The terms "hazardous waste," "hazardous substance," "disposal," "release," and "threatened release," as used in this Mongage, shall have the carrier meanings as set forth in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, as amended, 42 U.S.C. Section 2001, et seq. ("CERCLA"), the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1988, Pub. L. No. 99-489 ("SARA"); the Hazardous Materius Transportation Act, 49 U.S.C. Section 1801, at sec., the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, 49 U.S.C. Section 6901, et seq., or other applicuble state or Federal laws, rules, or regulations adopted pursuant to any of the foregoing. Granfor represents and warrants to Lender that: (a) Suring the period of Gramor's ownership of the Property, there has been no use, generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release or tives exed release of any hazardous waste or substance by any person on, under, or about the Property. (b) Grantor has no knowledge of, or reason to believe that there has been, except as previously disclosed to and acknowledged by Lender in writing, (i) any use, generation, manufacture, sto age, treatment, disposal, release, or threatened release of any hazardous waste or substance by any prior owners or occupants of the Property or (ii) any actual or threatened litigation or claims of any kind by any person relating to such matters. (c) Except as previously disclosed to and acknowledged by Lender in writing. (i) neithor Grantor nor any tenant, contractor, agent or other authorized user of the Property shall use, generally manufacture, store, treat, dispose of, or release any hazardous waste or substance on, under, or about the Property and (ii) any such activity in a be conducted in compliance with all applicable lederal, state, and local laws, regulations and ordinances, including without limitation those laws, regulations, and ordinances described above. Grantor authorizes Lander and its agents to enter upon the Property to make such inspections and tests as Lender may deem appropriate to determine compliance of the Property with this section of the Mortgage. Any inspections of tests made by Lender shall be for Lender's purposes only and shall not be construed to create any responsibility or liability on the part of Lunda to Grantor or to any other person. The representations and warranties contained herein are based on Grantor's due difigence in investigating the Property for hazardous waste. Grantor hereby (a) releases and waives any traine claims against Lender for indemnity or contribution in the event C entor becomes tiable for cleanup or other costs under any such laws, and (b) agrees to indemnity and hold harmless Lender against any and of claims, losses, liabilities, damages, penalties, and expenses which Lender may directly or indirectly sustain or suffer resulting from a breach of any section of the Mortgage or as a consequence of any use, generation, manufacture, storage, disposal, release or threatened release occurring prior to Grantor's ownership or interest in the Property, whether or not the same was or should have been known to Gramor. The provisions of this section of the Mortgage, including the obligation to indemnity, shall survive the payment of the Indebtedness and the satisfaction and reconvergence of the lien of this Mongage and shall not be affected by Lendor's acquisition of any interest in the Property, whether by foreclosure or otherwise.

Mulsance, Waste. Grantor shall not cause, conduct or permit any nuisance nor commit, permit, or suffer any stripping of or waste on or to the Property or any portion of the Property. Specifically without limitation, Grantor will not remove, or gent to any other party the right to remove, any amber, minerals (including oil and gas), soil, gravel or rock products without the prior written consert of lander.

Removal of Improvements. Grantor shall not demolish or remove any improvements from the Real Papers without the prior written consent of Lender. As a condition to the removal of any improvements, Lender may require Grantor to make arranger sents satisfactory to Lender to replace such improvements with improvements of at least equal value.

Lender's Right to Enter. Lender and its agents and representatives may enter upon the Real Property at all representatives to attend to Lander's interests and to inspect the Property for purposes of Grantor's compliance with the terms and conditions of this i fortgage.

Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all lows, ordinances, and regulations, now or hereatter in effect, of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Lender in writing prior to doing so and so long as Lander's interests in the Property are not jeopardized. Lender may require Grantor to post adequate security or a surety bond, reasonably satisfactory to Lender, to protect Lender's interest.

Duty to Protect. Grantor agrees neither to abandon nor leave unattended the Property. Grantor shall do all other acts, in addition to those acts set forth above in this section, which from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the Property.

DUE ON SALE - CONSENT BY LENDER: Lender may, at its option, declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this Mongage upon the sale or transfer, without the Lender's prior written consent, of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest in the Real Property. A "sale or transfer, without the Lender's prior written consent, of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest in the Real Property. A "sale or transfer, without the Lender's prior written consent, of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest in the Real Property. transfer means the conveyance of Real Property or any right, title or interest therein; whether legal or equitable; whether voluntary or involuntary; whether by outright sale, deed, installment sale contract, land contract, contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three (3) years, lease-option contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer of any beneficial interest in or to any land trust holding title to the Real Property, or by any other method of conveyance of Real Property interest. If any Grantor is a corporation or partnership, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than twenty-five percent (25%) of the voting stock or partnership interests, as the case may be, of Grantor. However, this option shall not be 🖏 exercised by Lender if such exercise is prohibited by tederal law or by Illinois law.

TAXES AND LIENS. The following provisions relating to the taxes and liens on the Proporty are a part of this Mortgage.

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Payment. Grantor shall pay when due (and in all events prior to delinquency) all taxes, payroll taxes, special taxes, assessments, water charges 🛂 and sewer service charges levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of all liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, and except as otherwise provided in the following paragraph.

Right To Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to

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Right To Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Lender's interest in the Property is not joopardized. If a lien arises or is filed as a result of noncayment, Grantor shall within litteen (15) days after the lien arises or, if a lien is filed, within litteen (15) days after the sen arises or, if a lien is filed, within litteen (15) days after the notice of the filing, secure the discharge of the lien, or a requested by Lender, deposit with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Lender in an amount sufficient to discharge the lien plus any costs and afformeys' fees or other charges that could accrue as a result of a foredosure or sale under the lien. In any contest, Grantor shall defend itself and Lender and shall satisfy any adverse judgment before enforcement against the Property. Grantor shall name Lender as an additional obligee under any surety bond furnished in the contest proceedings.

Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Lender satisfactory evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate governmental official to deliver to Lender at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Lender at least fitteen (15) days before any work is commenced, any services are lumished, or any materials are supplied to the Property, if any mechanic's lien, materialmen's lien, or other lien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials and the cost exceeds \$7,500.00. Grantor will upon request of Lender lumish to Lender advance assurances satisfactiony to Lender that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Maintenance of unrurance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basic, for the full insurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, an invite a standard mortgagee clause in favor of Lender. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonally acceptable to Lender. Grantor shall deliver to Lender certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage within a cancelled or diminished without a minimum of ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lender.

Application of Proceeds. Cranist shall promptly notify Lender of any loss or damage to the Property of the estimated cost of repair or replacement exceeds \$2,500,001. Linder may make proof of loss if Grantor fails to do so within tifleen [15] days of the casualty. Whether or not Lender's security is impaired, Lender may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness, payment of any lien affecting the Property, or the restoration and replan (I the Property. If Lender elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and replan, Grantor shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed improvements in a manner satisfactory to Lender. Lender shall upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimburse Grantor from the proceeds to the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been disbursed within 180 days after their receipt and which Lender has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used first to pay any amount owing to Lender this Mortgage, then to prepay accrued interest, and the remainder, if any, shall be applied to the principal balance of the Indebtedness. If Conder holds any proceeds after payment in talk of the Indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Grantor.

Unauptred Insurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance's list imme to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Mortgage at any trustee's sale or other sale held under the provisions of this Mortgage, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property.

Grantor's Report on Insurance. Upon request of Lender, however, not more than once a year, Grantor shall furnish to Lender a report on each existing policy of insurance showing: (a) the name of the insurer; (b) for risks insured; (c) the amount of the policy; (d) the properly insured, the then current replacement value of such property, and the manner of Controlling that value; and (e) the expiration date of the policy. Grantor shall upon request of Lander, have an independent appraiser satisfactory to 1 inner determine the cash value replacement cost of the Property.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Grantor fails to comply with any provision of this Mungage, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interests in the Property. Lender on Grantor's behalf may, but shill not be required to, take any action that Lender deems appropriate. Any amount that Lender expends in so doing will bear interest at the rate charged under the Note from the date incurred or paid by Lender to the date of repayment by Grantor. All such expenses, at Lender's option, will (a) we navable on demand. (b) be added to the balance of the Note and be apportioned among and be payable with any installment payments to become during either (i) the term of any applicable insurance policy or (ii) the remaining term of the Note, or (c) be treated as a balloon payment which wall be sue and payable at the Note's maturity. This Montgage also will socure payment of these amounts. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall is in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lender may be entitled on account of the default. Any such action by Lender shall not be construct as curing the default so as to bar Lender from any remedy that it otherwise would have bad.

WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE. The following provisions relating to ownership of the Property are a part of this N ongage.

Title. Grantor warrants that: (a) Grantor holds good and marketable title of record to the Property in fee six ple, tine and clear of all liens and encumbrances other than those set forth in the Real Property description or in any title insurance policy, title report, or final title opinion issued in tavor of, and accepted by, Lender in connection with this Morigage, and (b) Grantor has the full right, power, and a shurtly to execute and deliver this Morigage to Lender.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the little to the Property against the lawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of Lender's own choice, and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as Lender may request from time to time to permit such participation.

Compliance With Laws. Grantor warrants that the Property and Grantor's use of the Property complies with all existing applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations of governmental authorities.

CONDEMNATION. The following provisions relating to condemnation of the Property are a part of this Merigage.

Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned by eminent domain proceedings or by any proceeding or purchase in lieu of condemnation, Lender may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the Indebtedness or the repair or restoration of the Property. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expense and attorneys' less necessarily paid or incurred by Grantor or Lender in connection with the condemnation.

Proceedings. If any proceeding in condemnation is filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Lender in writing, and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver or cause be delivered to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such participation.

IMPOSITION OF TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES BY GOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITIES. The following provisions relating to governmental taxes, legisland charges are a part of this Mongage:

Current Taxes, Fees and Charges. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute such documents in addition to this Mongage and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's lien on the Real Property. Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all

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taxes, as described below, together with all expenses incurred in recording, perfecting or continuing this Mortgage, including without firritation all taxes, fees, documentary stamps, and other charges for recording or registering this Mortgage.

Taxes. The following shall constitute taxes to which this section applies: (a) a specific tax upon this type of Mortgage or open all or any part of the Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage; (b) a specific tax on Grantor which Grantor is authorized or required to deduct from payments on the Indebtedness secured by this type of Mortgage; (c) a tax on this type of Mortgage chargeable against the Lender or the holder of the Note; and (d) a specific tax on all or any portion of the Indebtedness or on payments of principal and interest made by Grantor.

Subsequent Taxes. If any tax to which this section applies is enacted subsequent to the date of this Mortgage, this event shall have the same effect as an Event of Default (as defined below), and Lender may exercise any or all of its available remedies for an Event of Default as provided below unless Grantor either. (a) pays the tax before it becomes definquent, or (b) contests the tax as provided above in the Taxes and Liens section and deposits with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Lender.

SECURITY AGREEMENT; FINANCING STATEMENTS. The following provisions relating to this Mortgage as a security agreement are a part of this Mortgage.

Security Agreement. This instrument shall constitute a security agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes focuses or other personal property, and Lendon shall have all of the rights of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code as amended from time to time.

Security Interest. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute financing statements and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue conder's security interest in the Rents and Personal Property. In addition to recording this Mortgage in the real property records, Lender may, at any time and without further authorization from Grantor, file executed counterparts, copies or reproductions of this Mortgage as a financing recipronal. Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all expenses incurred in perfecting or continuing this security interest. Upon default, Grantor shall recorded the Personal Property in a manner and at a place reasonably convenient to Grantor and Lender and make it available to Lender within three (1) days after receipt of written demand from Lender.

Addresses. The mailing address s of Grantor (debtor) and Lender (secured party), from which information concerning the security interest granted by this Mortgage may be obtained (each as required by the Uniform Commercial Code), are as stated on the first page of this Mortgage.

FURTHER ASSURANCES; ATTORNEY-IN-FACT. The following provisions relating to further assurances and attorney-in-tact are a part of this Hortgage.

Further Assurances. At any time, and from tine to time, upon request of Lender, Grantor will make, execute and deliver, or will cause to be made, executed or delivered, to Lender or to Landar's designee, and when requested by Lender, cause to be filled, recorded, reflied, or rerecorded, as the case may be, at such times and in such offices and places as Lender may deem appropriate, any and all such mortgages, deeds of trust, security deeds, security agreements, fini noing statements, continuation statements, instruments of further assurance, certificates, and other documents as may, in the sole opinion of Lendar, be necessary or dosirable in order to effectuate, complete, perfect, continue, or preserve: (a) the obligations of Grantor under the Note, this Mortgage, and the Related Documents, and (b) the liens and security interests created by this Mortgage as first and prior liens on the Property, whether now owned or hereafter acquired by Grantor. Unless prohibited by law or agreed to the contrary by Lender in writing, Grantor shall reimiture. Lender for all costs and expenses incurred in connection with the matters referred to in this paragraph.

Attorney-in-Fact. If Grantor tails to do any of the things referred to in the preceding paragraph, Lender may do so for and in the name of Grantor and at Grantor's expense. For such purposes, Granter hereby interiors by appoints Lender as Grantor's attorney-in-fact for the purpose of making, executing, delivering, filing, recording, and doing all other things as hay be necessary or desirable, in Lender's sole opinion, to accomplish the matters referred to in the preceding paragraph.

FULL PERFORMANCE. If Grantor pays all the Indebtedness when due, and otherwise per orm: all the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Mortgage, Lender shall execute and deliver to Grantor a suitable satisfaction of this Mortgage, and suitable statements of termination of any financing statement on file evidencing Lender's security interest in the Rents and the Personal Property. Grantor will pay, if permitted by applicable law, any reasonable termination fee as determined by Lender from time to time.

DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lender, shall constitute an event of default ("Event of of fault") under this Mortgage:

Default on Indebtedness. Failure of Grantor to make any payment when due on the Indebtedness.

Default on Other Payments. Failure of Grantor within the time required by this Mortgage to make any plymes t for taxes or insurance, or any other payment necessary to prevent filting of or to effect discharge of any lien.

Compliance Default. Failure to comply with any other term, obligation, covenant or condition contained is: this Mo. or ge, the Note or in any of the Related Documents. If such a failure is curable and if Grantor has not been given a notice of a breach of the same provision of this Mortgage within the preceding twelve (12) months, it may be cured (and no Event of Default will have occurred) if Grantor, after Letter sends written notice demanding cure of such failure: (a) cures the failure within fifteen (15) days; or (b) if the cure requires more than fifteen (15) days, immediately initiates steps sufficient to cure the failure and thereafter continues and completes all reasonable and necessary steps sufficient to produce compliance as soon as reasonably practical.

Breaches. Any warranty, representation or statement made or turnished to Lender by or on bohalf of Grantor under this Mortgage, the Note or the Related Documents is, or at the time made or turnished was, take in any material respect.

Insolvency. The insolvency of Grantor, appointment of a receiver for any part of Grantor's property, any assignment for the benefit of creditors, the commencement of any proceeding under any bankruptcy or insolvency taws by or against Grantor, or the dissolution or termination of Grantor's existence as a going business (if Grantor is a business). Except to the extent prohibited by federal law or tilinois law, the death of Grantor (it Grantor is an individual) also shall constitute an Event of Default under this Mortgage.

Foreclosure, etc. Commencement of foreclosure, whether by judicial proceeding, self-help, repossession or any other method, by any creditor of Grantor against any of the Property. However, this subsection shall not apply in the event of a good faith dispute by Grantor as to the validity or reasonableness of the claim which is the basis of the foreclosure, provided that Grantor gives Lender written notice of such claim and turnishes of reserves or a surety bond for the claim satisfactory to Lender.

Breach of Other Agreement. Any breach by Grantor under the terms of any other agreement between Grantor and Lender that is not remedied within any grace period provided therein, including without limitation any agreement concerning any indebtedness or other obligation of Grantor to Lender, whether existing now or later.

Events Affecting Guaranter. Any of the preceding events occurs with respect to any Guaranter of any of the Indebtedness or such Guaranter dies or becomes incompetent. Lender, at its option, may, but shall not be required to, permit the Guaranter's estate to assume unconditionally the obligations arising under the guaranty in a manner satisfactory to Lender, and, in doing so, cure the Event of Default.

Insecurity. Lender reasonably deems itself insecure.

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RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default and at any time thereafter, Lender, at its option, may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

Accelerate Indebtedness. Lender shall have the right at its option without notice to Grantor to declare the entire Indebtedness immediately due and payable, including any prepayment penalty which Grantor would be required to pay.

UCC Remedies. With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property, Lender shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code.

Collect Rents. Lender shall have the right, without notice to Grantor, to take possession of the Property and collect the Rents, including amounts past due and unpaid, and apply the net proceeds, over and above Lender's costs, against the Indebtedness. In furtherance of this right, Lender may require any tenant or other user of the Property to make payments of rent or use less directly to Lender. If the Rents are collected by Lender, then Grantor irrevocably designates Lender as Grantor's attorney-in-fact to endorse instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by tenants or other users to Lender in response to Lender's demand shall satisfy the obligations for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper grounds for the demand existed. Lender may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

Mortgages in Possession. Lender shall have the right to be placed as mortgages in possession or to have a receiver appointed to take possession of raio; any part of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding foreclosure or sale, and to collect the Rents from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, against the indebtedness. The mortgages in possession or receiver may serve without bond if permitted by law. Lender's right to the appointment of a receiver shall exist whether or not the opportunity value of the Property exceeds the Indebtedness by a substantial amount. Employment by Lender shall not disquality a person from serving rai a receiver.

Judicial Foreclosure. Ler on may obtain a judicial decree foreclosing Grantor's interest in all or any part of the Property.

Deficiency Judgment. If permitted by applicable law, Lender may obtain a judgment for any deficiency remaining in the indebtedness due to Lender after application of all amount received from the exercise of the rights provided in this section.

Other Remedies. Lender shall have all our enights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or the Note or available at law or in equity.

Sale of the Property. To the extent permated by applicable law, Grantor hereby waives any and all right to have the property marshalled. In exercising its rights and remedies, Lender shall be to sell all or any part of the Property together or separately, in one sale or by separate sales. Lender shall be entitled to bid at any purity sale on all or any portion of the Property.

Notice of Sale. Lender shall give Grantor reasonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Property or of the time after which any private sale or other intended disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least ten (10) days before the time of the sale or disposition.

Walver; Election of Remedies. A waiver by any party of a pre-schill's provision of this Mongage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's rights otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. Election by Lender to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to party that each on party and party of Granton under this Mongage after failure of Granton to perform shall not affect Lender's right to declar remedies and exercise its remedies under this Mongage.

Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. If Lender institutes any suit or abidin to enforce inviolitie terms of this Mortgage, Lender shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees at trial unit, o'n any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Lender that in Lender's opinion are necessary at any time for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the indebtedness payable on demand and shall bear transform the date of expenditure until repaid at the Note rate. Expenses covered by this paragraph include, without limitation, however subject to any limits under applicable law, Lender's attorneys' less and legal expenses whether or not there is a lawsuit, including alterneys' less for barran proceedings (including efforts to modify or vacate any automatic stay or injunction), appeals and any anticipated post-judgment collection survives, the cost of searching records, obtaining site reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyors' reports, and appraisal fees, and title instrument, to the entert permitted by applicable law. Grantor also will pay any court costs, in addition to all other sums provided by law.

NOTICES TO GRANTOR AND OTHER PARTIES. Any notice under this Mortgage, including without writation any notice of default and any notice of sale to Grantor, shall be in writing and shall be effective when actually delivered or, if mailed, shall be deemed continue when deposited in the United States mail first class, registered mail, postage prepaid, directed to the addresses shown near the beginning of this Acrtgage. Any party may change its address for notices under this Mortgage by giving formal written notice to the other parties, specifying that the purples of the notice is to change the party's address. All copies of notices of foreclosure from the holder of any lien which has priority over this Mortgage give be sent to Lender's address, as shown near the beginning of this Mortgage. For notice purposes, Grantor agrees to keep Lender informed at all times of Crantor's current address.

MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS. The following miscellaneous provisions are a part of this Mortgage:

Amendments. This Montgage, together with any Related Documents, constitutes the entire understanding and agreement of the parties as to the matters set forth in this Montgage. No alteration of or amendment to this Montgage shall be effective unless given in writing and signed by the party or parties sought to be charged or bound by the alteration or amendment.

Annual Reports. If the Property is used for purposes other than Grantor's residence, Grantor shall lurnish to Lender, upon request, a certified statement of net operating income received from the Property during Grantor's previous fiscal year in such form and detail as Lender shall require. "Net operating income" shall mean all cash receipts from the Property less all cash expenditures made in connection with the operation of the Property.

Applicable Law. This Mortgage has been delivered to Lender and accepted by Lender in the State of Illinois. Subject to the provisions on arbitration, this Mortgage shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois.

Caption Headings. Caption headings in this Mortgage are for convenience purposes only and are not to be used to interpret or define the provisions of this Mortgage.

Merger. There shall be no merger of the interest or estate created by this Mortgage with any other interest or estate in the Property at any shall by or for the benefit of Lender in any capacity, without the written consent of Lender.

Multiple Parties; Corporate Authority. All obligations of Grantor under this Mortgage shall be joint and several, and all references to Grantor shall mean each and every Grantor. This means that each of the persons signing below is responsible for all obligations in this Mortgage. Whatevery one or more of the Grantors are corporations or partnerships, it is not necessary for Lender to inquire into the powers of any of the Grantors and of the officers, directors, partners, or agents acting or purposing to act on their behalf, and any Indebtedness made or created in refance upon the professed exercise of such powers shall be guaranteed under this Mortgage.

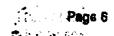
Severability. It a court of competent jurisdiction finds any provision of this Mortgage to be invalid or unenforceable as to any person or circumstance, such finding shall not render that provision invalid or unenforceable as to any other persons or circumstances. It leasible, any such

Time is of the Essence. Time is of the essence in the performance of this Mortgage.

Waiver of Homestead Exemption. Grantor hereby releases and waives all rights and benefits of the homestead exemption laws of the State of Minois as to all Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage.

Walver of Right of Redemption. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OF THE PROVISIONS TO THE CONTRARY CONTAINED IN THIS MORTGAGE, GRANTOR HEREBY WAIVES, TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED UNDER ILL. REV. STAT., CH. 110 SECTION 15-1601(D) OR ANY SIMILAR LAW EXISTING AFTER THE DATE OF THIS MORTGAGE, ANY AND ALL RIGHTS OF REDEMPTION ON BEHALF OF GRANTOR AND ON BEHALF OF ANY OTHER PERSONS PERMITTED TO REDEEM THE PROPERTY.

Watvers and Consents. Lender shall not be deemed to have waived any rights under this Mortgage (or under the Related Documents) unless such waiver in a writing and signed by Lender. No delay or omission on the part of Lender in exercising any right shall operate as a waiver of such right or any other right. A waiver by any party of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's right otherwise to dermant's stict compliance with that provision or any other provision. No prior waiver by Lender, nor any course of dealing between Lender and Grantor, whether a waiver of any of Lender's rights or any of Grantor's obligations as to any future transactions. Whenever consent by Lender is ruguilled in this Mortgage, the granting of such consent by Lender in any instance shall not constitute continuing consent to subsequent instances where with consent is required.
