

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any percentiable to pay any tax is out at contrast and a rethe same after demand, the amount including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable senaity. together with any costs that may occupa in addition thereto) shall be a flen in favor of the United States open all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, helps you

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the heteroment is made and strail continue until the hability for the amount no assessed for a judginout against the taxwayer arising out of such habitaly is catistied or becomes unenforceable by reason of tapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors - The flen imposer, holder of a security interest, mechanic's liener, or judgment lian creator until notice thereof which meets the repuirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary

m Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subeastion (a) shall be filled-(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of reet property, in one attice within the State (or the county, or other governmental supplivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is equiated; and

(ii) Personal Property in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intengible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the ilen is situated; except that State taw morely conforming to reenacting Federal law establishing a national filling system does not constitute a second office for filling as designated by the laws of such State, or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court in the affice of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subpragraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Debus Of The District Of Co-

tambia . In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lion is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Saus Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of ragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated. (A) Peut Property - In the case of real property, at its physical

Fo. purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or parts with a shall be doesned to be the place at which the principal objective office of the publicise is located, and the residence of a Pixe ever whose residence is without the United States shall be do med to be in the Olstrict of Columbia.
(3) Form - The form and content of the notice reterred to

in subsection (a) shall be p ascribed by the Sacretary. Such notice shall be voted no withstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

(9) Refiling Of Notice.—For purposes of this

(1) General Rule. - unless notice of tien is refuled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required retiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is tiled (in accordance with subsection (i) atter the expiration of such relifting period.

(2) Place For Filing. -- A notice of then related during the required refiling period shall be effective only-

(i) such notice of lien is relited in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(b) in the case of real property, and the fact of refiling is antered and recorded in an Index to the extent required by subscriben (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a retiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secreta concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if natica of such flen is also filed in accordance to subsection (f) in the State in which such residence. located.

(3) Required Refiling Period.—in 9 case of any notice of lien, the term "required reliting parts mirans.

(A) the one year period enting 30 days after the expiration of 10 years after the data of the assessment of th tax, and

(B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 10 years after the close of the preceding required refiling period for such notice of flen.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Of Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien.—Subject to such regu-tations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary and issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, togethor with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is lumished to the Se contary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon tile payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that in in accordance with such equir ments relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and an colles thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(8) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes.--

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien,-if. a notice of lien has been tiled pursuant to section 6323(1), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such than may be disclosed to any person who furnishes established written evidence that no has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
