

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refused to pay the same after demand, the amount including any interest, additional amount, adoition to tax, or essentiable penalty, together with any costs that may across in addition thereto; shall be a fiel in layer of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unloss enother date is specifically fixed by for the hon Imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the inscessment is made and shall continue until the fability for the amount so assessed for a property against out of such labelity) is satisfied or becomes unenferceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's; Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The Ben imposed by Section 6321 shall not be velled as against any purchaser, holder of a security Interest, mechanic's know, or judgment flare creditor ustill indice thereof which means the rentiferments of subsection (f) has been filled by the Societary.

(g) Refiling Of Notice.—For purposes of this section.

(1) General Rule.—Unless notice of tion is related in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required reliting period, such notice of tion shall be treated as tibed on the date on which it is find (in accordance with subsection (f) after the expiration of such reliting period.

(3) Required Refiling Period.—in the case of any notice of lien, the term "required rathing period" means:

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 10 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and

(B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 10 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien.—Subject to such requiations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of refease of any flort imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.

(t) Liability Satisfied or Unenforcehle. The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legality unenforceable; or
