

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any lax neglects of refuses to pa the same alter perhand, the amount (including any interest additional amount, addition to tall or assessable penalty together with any costs that may accive in addition thereto) shall be a lien in tayon of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether rule or personal, delonging to

Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the luminoposed by section 6321 whell arise at the time the usesssment is made and shall continue until the implify for the Amount so assossed (or a judgment against the tuxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unentercoable by reason of tappe of time

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Cértain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.-The lien Imposed by section 5321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the require-ments of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(1) Place For Filing . The notice referred to in subsection (a) stinli be filed-(A) Under State Lews

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the ben is titutated; and

(ii) Personal Property in the case of personal property, whether tangible or Intangible, in one office. within the State for the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; except that State law merely conforming to reenacting Federal law establishing a national filing system does not constitute a second office for filing as designated by the laws of such State; or (8) With Clerk Of District Countin the office of the

clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the

requirements of subparagraph (A), or (C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Co-Jumble - In the office of the Recorder of Doede of the Dietrict of Columbia. If the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.
