

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically lived by law, the fien imposed by section 6321 shall sits of the time (the assessment is made and shall continue on it the flability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the laxipayin arising out of such tability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The Hen Imposed by section 8321 shall not be valid as against any purchased

(1) Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in sub-section (a) shall be filed-

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the ion is situitated; and

(ii) Personal Property-In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lient setuated: except that State law merely confirming to remacting Federal law establishing a national filling system does not constitute a second office for filling as designated by the laws of such State; or

as assignated by the laws of such State; or GRI With Clark Of Distinct Countin the office of the clark of the United States district count for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law dissignated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds of The District Of Columbia in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the item is situated in the District of Columbia. (2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated (A) Reat Property - in the case of real property, at its physical tocation, or

 parsonal Property-in the case of personal property, whether tengible or intengible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the tirle the notice of lien is filed.

Expurposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or pair (art) pip shall be deemed to be the place at which the principle of productive office of the business is located, and the residence if a ary layer whose residence is without the United States shall be unumed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsocian (a) ship in the properties of the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid intenthal sending any other provision of law regarding the form or contint of a notice of tiers.

(p) Refiling Of Notice.—For purposes of this section-

(1) General Rule,—Unless notice of lien is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiting period, such notice of tien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f) after the expiration of such refilling period.

(2) Place For Filing.—A notice of lien refiled during the required refiling period shall be effective only-

(A) if

(i) such notice of lien is refilled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, and the fact of refling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer is residence, if enounce of such iten is also filed in accordance with subsection (i) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refilling Period.—in the case of any notice of tien, the term "required refilling period" means:

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 10 years after the date of the askessment of the tax, and

(B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 10 years after the close of the proceding required refling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lieft.—Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any illen imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unanforceable - The Socretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been july satisfied or has become logally unanforceable; or

[2] Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in remount thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extention of such time), and that is in accordance with such removement and arreliating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and arrelias thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6 00 Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes.—

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding flen, if a notice of lien has been filed pursuent to section (/323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation recurred by such flen may be disclosed to any/person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
