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Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

if any person liable to bay any tax neglects or refuses to liay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest Monal amount, addition to tak, or assessable penelty together with any coats that may accrue in accilion thefets, shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether that or personal, or langing to sych parson

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed at law the lien imposed by Section 6021 shall arise at the time the assess-ment is made and shall continue until the Papility for the amount so assessed for a judgment against the taxpayer ansing out of such hability) is satisfied or becomes unenforce-

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority St. Against Certain Persons.
