Policies shall be written by such insurance compenies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor shell deliver to Lender certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a sliputation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lender. The Real Property is located in an area designated by the Director of the Federal Emergency Management Agency as a special flood hazard area. Grantor agrees to obtain and maintain Federal Flood insurance to the extent such insurance is required and is available for the term of the loan and for the full unpaid principal betance of the loan or the maximum limit of coverage that is available, whichever is less.

SECURITY AGREEMENT; FINANCING STATEMENTS. The following provisions relating to this Moltgage as a security agreement are a part of this Moltgage.
