Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the little imposed by section 5321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so excessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer ensing out of such ilability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.
