THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH, THAT THE UNDERSIGNED,Karol Czerwien and Anna Czerwien, husband and wife
of the City of Chicago County of Cook State of Illinois,
hereinafter referred to as the Mortgagor, does hereby mortgage and warrant to**Preferred Savings and Loan Association**

a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Illinois, hereinafter referred to as the Mortgagee, the following real estate situated in the County of Cook in the State of Illinois, to wit:

The above described property consists of Lots 14 and 15 in Block 1 in Clear Park, a subdivision of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 20, Township 38 North, Range 13, East of the Third Principal Meridian in Cook County, Illinois. The property is bounded on the North by 63rd Street, on the South by 62nd Street, on the East by 1/2 of 10th Avenue, and on the West by 1/2 of 11th Avenue. The property contains approximately 10,000 square feet.

TOGETHER with all buildings, improvements, fixtures or appurtenances now or hereafter erected thereon, including all apparatus, equipment, fixtures or articles, whether in single units or rented, controlled, used to supply heat, gas, air conditioning, water, light, power, refrigeration, ventilation or other services and any other thing now or hereafter thereon or thereon the furnishing of which by lessors to lessees is customary or appurtenant, including screens, Venetian blinds, window shades, storm doors and windows, floor coverings, screen doors, in-a-door beds, awnings, stoves and water heaters, fall of which are declared to be a part of and real estate whether physically attached thereto or not, together with all assignments to the Mortgagee of all leases and easements of said premises and the furnishings and equipment therein. Such rents, issues and profits shall be applied first to the payment of all costs and expenses of acting under such assignment, including taxes and assessments, and second to the payment of any indebtedness then due and or incurred hereunder.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all of said property with said appurtenances, apparatus, fixtures and other equipment unto said Mortgagee forever, for the uses herein set forth, free from all rights and benefits under the Homestead Exemption Laws of the State of Illinois, which said rights and benefits said Mortgagor does hereby release and waive.

TO SECURE (1) The payment of a note and the performance of the obligations herein contained, executed and delivered concurrently herewith by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagee in the principal sum of

One Hundred Fifty Thousand and no/100--- Dollars 150,000.00

which is payable as provided in said note, and (2) any additional advances made by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor or his successors in title for any purpose at any time before the release and cancellation of this mortgage, such additional advance shall be evidenced by a Note or other agreement executed by the Mortgagor or his successors in title as being secured by this mortgage; provided that, nothing herein contained shall be deemed as limiting the amounts that shall be secured hereby when advanced to protect the security.

Upon payment of the obligation hereby secured, and performance of all obligations under this mortgage and the note secured by it, said note shall be marked paid and delivered to the maker or his assignee, together with this mortgage duly canceled and any other instrument or instruments necessary to clear the title to the property herein described on account of the indebtedness hereby secured and executed in due and legal form by the Mortgagee by its duly authorized officers and under its corporate seal. A reasonable fee shall be paid by the Mortgagors or their successors in interest for the cancellation and release.



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THE COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS REFERRED TO ON PAGE 1 (the reverse side of this mortgage):

A. THE MORTGAGOR COVENANTS:

(1) To pay all taxes, and assessments levied or assessed upon said property or any part thereof under any existing or future law in accordance with the terms of the Note of even date herewith; (2) To keep the improvements now or hereafter upon said premises insured against such damage or liability, as the Mortgagor may require in such companies, and in such form, as shall be approved by the Mortgagor. All such insurance policies shall contain proper mortgage clauses and the policies shall be retained by the Mortgagor until the loan is fully repaid; (3) In the event such insurance policies are canceled for any reason whatsoever and no new insurance policies are presented to the Mortgagor on or before the date of termination of the notice of cancellation, then the Mortgagor shall have the right to declare the total indebtedness due and payable immediately and the Mortgagor shall have the right to commence foreclosure proceedings as provided in paragraph No. 14; (4) To promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvement now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or destroyed; (5) To operate said premises and keep them in good condition and repair in accordance with the building, fire, zoning, health and sanitation laws and ordinances of the Municipality and any other governmental board, authority or agency having jurisdiction over the mortgaged premises; (6) Not to suffer or permit any unlawful use of or any nuisance to exist on said property nor to diminish nor impair its value by any act or omission to act; (7) Not to suffer or permit, without the written permission or consent of the Mortgagor being first had and obtained, (a) any use of said property for a purpose other than that for which the same is now used, (b) any alterations, additions to, demolition or removal of any of the improvements, apparatus, fixtures or equipment now or hereafter upon said property, (c) a sale, assignment or transfer of any right, title or interest in and to said property or any portion thereof, or any of the improvements, apparatus, fixtures or equipment which may be found in or upon said property; (d) the Mortgagor will not suffer or permit any change in the nature or character of the operation of said premises which will increase the intensity of the use thereof, save and except upon the written approval and consent of the Mortgagor, and further, will not suffer or permit to be changed or altered the exterior and interior structural arrangements including (but not in the exclusion) of offices, walls, rooms, and halls without first obtaining the written consent of the Mortgagor; (8) The Mortgagor shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.

B. THE MORTGAGOR FURTHER COVENANTS:

(1) That, in case of his failure to perform any of his covenants herein, the Mortgagor may do on his behalf everything so covenanted, that said Mortgagor may also do any act or may deem necessary to protect the loan of this mortgage, and that he will immediately repay any money paid or disbursed by the Mortgagor, for any and all above purposes, and such amount shall be added to the unpaid balance of the aforesaid Note as of the first day of the then current month and thereafter additional installments accrued by this mortgage and may be included in any decree foreclosing this mortgage, and he shall not offset the rate of said premium, if not otherwise held by him, in any amount that shall not be obligated upon the Mortgagor to insure into the validity of any loss, circumstance or claim in advancing monies in that behalf as above authorized, but nothing herein contained shall be construed as requiring the Mortgagor to advance any monies for any purpose nor to do any act hereunder; that the Mortgagor shall not incur personal liability because of anything it may do or omit to do hereunder;

(2) That it is the intent hereof to secure payment of said Note whether the entire amount shall have been advanced to the Mortgagor at the date hereof or at a later date, and to secure any other amount or amounts that may be added to the mortgage indebtedness under the terms of this mortgage;

(3) That if the Mortgagor shall secure, and assign to said Mortgagor, disability insurance and life insurance in a company acceptable to said Mortgagor, and in a form acceptable to it, the Mortgagor has the right to advance the first annual premium for such insurance and each payment to the unpaid balance of the loan as of the first day of the then current month, and it shall become additional indebtedness secured by the Mortgage;

(4) That in the event of the holder of the redemption in the real estate hereinabove described becomes vested in any person other than the undersigned, or any of them, then, the holder so named hereby may increase the annual rate of interest to be paid thereunder by not more than an additional five percent (5%) above the rate then specified. Whenever the holder of said note elects to increase the rate of interest in accordance with this provision, it shall give written notice to the rate of interest, the effective date of such increase and the increased amount of the monthly installments to be paid by the undersigned to the Mortgagor, or his successor in title, not less than fifteen (15) days prior to the effective date of such increase. Such notice shall be given by the mailing thereof by Registered Mail or Certified Mail, postage prepaid, addressed to the last known address of the Mortgagor, or his successor in title, as recorded upon the books of the Mortgagor, but if no such address is so recorded, then to the address of the real estate above described. It is further provided that in the event of an increase in the interest rate, as set forth in this paragraph, the Mortgagor, or his successor in title, may pay the unpaid balance of the note secured hereby within the period of ninety (90) days from the date of said notice, with interest at the rate in effect prior thereto, to the date of payment without penalty;

(5) That in the event the ownership of any property or any part thereof becomes vested in a person other than the Mortgagor, the Mortgagor may, without notice to the Mortgagor, deal with such successor or successors in interest with reference to this mortgage and the debt thereby secured in the same manner as with the Mortgagor, and may forgo to sue or may extend time for payment of the debt secured hereby without discharging or in any way affecting the liability of the Mortgagor hereunder or again, the debt hereby secured; or, in the event, the Mortgagor may accelerate all installments payments due and demand full payment upon the sale or transfer of the mortgaged property in any case where the transfer is made without the written permission or consent of the Mortgagor;

(6) That time is of the essence hereof and, if default is made in performance of any covenant herein contained or in case of default in making any payment under said Note or any extension or modification thereof, or if proceedings be instituted to enforce any other lien or charge upon any of said property, or upon the filing of a proceeding in bankruptcy, by or against the Mortgagor, or if the Mortgagor shall make an assignment for the benefit of his creditors or if his property be placed under control of or in custody of any court, or if the Mortgagor abandon any of said property, then and in any of said events, the Mortgagor, is hereby authorized and empowered, at its option, and without affecting the lien hereby created or the priority of said lien or any right of the Mortgagor hereunder, to declare, without notice, all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable, whether or not such default be remedied by the Mortgagor, and to go toward the payment of said mortgage indebtedness any indebtedness of the Mortgagor to the Mortgagor, and said Mortgagor may also immediately proceed to foreclose this mortgage;

(7) That upon the commencement of any foreclosure proceeding, whether the Court in which such bill is filed may, at any time, either before or after sale, and without notice to the Mortgagor, or any party claiming under him, and without regard to the solvency of the Mortgagor or the then value of said premises, or whether the same wholly then be occupied by the owner of the right of redemption, a hundred, appoint a receiver (who may be the Mortgagor or its agent) with power to manage, rent and collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and the statutory action of redemption, and such rents, issues and profits when collected may be applied before as well as after the Master's sale, towards the payment of the indebtedness, costs, laws, insurance or other items necessary for the protection and preservation of the property, including the expenses of such service, as far as any deficiency, derive, whether there be a decree therefore in personam or not, and if a receiver shall be appointed, he shall remain in possession until the expiration of the full period allowed by statute for redemption, whether there be redemption of and until the issuance of deed in case of sale, but no deed be issued until expiration of the statutory period during which it may be issued, and no lease of said premises shall be valid by the appointment or entry in possession of a receiver but he may elect to terminate any lease junior to the lien hereof, and upon foreclosure of said premises there shall be allowed and included as an additional indebtedness in the decree of sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgagor for attorney's fees, Mortgagor's fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for exhibits attached to pleadings, documentary and expert evidence, stenographer's fees, Master's fees and commissions, court costs, publication, costs and costs which may be estimated as to and include items to be expended after the entry of the decree of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches, examinations and reports, surveyor's fees, and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Mortgagor may reasonably deem necessary either to prove or to evidence to bidders at any sale held pursuant to such decree the true title to or value of said premises and all amounts so aforementioned, together with interest thereon at the rate of 2% per annum in addition to the interest shown on the aforesaid Note, shall become additional indebtedness of and be immediately due and payable by the Mortgagor in connection with (a) any proceeding, including institute of bankruptcy proceedings to which either party hereto shall be a party, by reason of this mortgage or the note hereby secured, or (b) preparations for the commencement of any suit for the foreclosure hereof after the accrual of the right to foreclose, whether or not actually commenced, or (c) preparations for the service of an intervention in any threatened or contemplated suit or proceeding which might affect the premises or the security hereof, whether or not actually commenced. In the event of a forced sale of said premises there shall first be paid out of the proceeds thereof all of the aforesaid items, then the entire indebtedness whether due and payable by the terms hereof or not, and the interest due thereon up to the time of such sale, and the overplus, if any, shall be paid to the Mortgagor, and the purchaser shall not be obliged to see to the application of the purchase money;

(8) In case the mortgaged property or any part thereof is damaged, or destroyed by fire or any other cause or taken by condemnation, then the Mortgagor is hereby empowered to receive any compensation which may be paid. Any moneys so received shall be applied by the Mortgagor as it may elect, to the immediate reduction or payment in full of the indebtedness secured hereby, or to the repair and restoration of the property. In the event the Mortgagor makes inspections and disbursements during the repair and restoration of the property, the Mortgagor may make a charge not to exceed 2% of the amount of such disbursements;

(9) That each right, power and remedy herein conferred upon the Mortgagor is cumulative of every other right or remedy of the Mortgagor, whether herein or by law conferred, and may be enforced concurrently therewith; that no waiver by the Mortgagor of performance of any covenant herein or in said note contained shall thereafter in any manner affect the right of Mortgagor to require or enforce performance of the same or any other of said covenants; that whenever the word "herein" refers to the masculine gender, as used herein, shall include the feminine, and the singular number, as used herein, shall include the plural, and that all rights and obligations under this mortgage shall extend to and be binding on the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of the Mortgagor and Mortgagor.
