WHEREPS. Mortgager has concurrently herewith executed and delivered to Mortgages a Mortgage Note bearing even date herewith ("Note") in the principal sum of NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY FIVE THOUSAND AND NC/100 DOLLARS (\$975,000.00) made payable to Mortgages in and by which Note Mortgagor promises to pay the said principal sum and interest thereon at the rate and in installments as provided in the Note, with a final payment of the balance due on the first day of August, 1997, if not sooner paid, all of said principal and interest being payable at such place as the holder or holders of the Note ("Holders") may, from time to time, in writing appoint and in the absence of such appointment, then at the office of Mortgages, 30 North Michigan Avenue, Chicago, Illinois 60602.

NOW, THEREFORE, Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment of both principal and interest, in accordance with the terms and provisions of the Note and in accordance with the terms, provisions and limitations of this Mortgage, and to secure the performance of the covenants and agreements herein and in the Note contained, to be performed by Mortgagor, does by these presents MORTGAGE, GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL and CONVEY unto Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, its estate in fee simple, forever, in the real estate situated in the City of Hanover Park, County of Cook, State of 1) inois ("Premises") as more fully described on the attached Exhibit A, which is incorporated herein by this reference and made e part hereof.

TOGETHER with all buildings, improvements, tanaments, easements, fixtures and appurtenances thereto pertaining or belonging, and all rents, issues and profits thereof for so long and during all such times as Mortgagor may be entitled observed (which are pledged primarily and on a parity with said real estate and not secondarily), and including but not limited to Mortgagor's interest in all shades, awnings, venetian blinks, screens, screen doors, storm doors and windows, stoves and ranges, curtain fixtures, partitions, attached floor covering, now or hereafter therein or thereon and all fixtures, apparatus, equipment or articles now or hereafter therein or thereon used to supply heat, gas, air cooling, air conditioning, water, light,

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power, sanitation, sprinkler protection, waste removal, articles used or useful in connection with the operation of said refrigeration (whether single units or centrally controlled) and ventilation including (without restricting the foregoing), all other fixtures, apparatus, equipment, furniture, furnishings, and articles used or useful in connection with the operation of said real estate now or hereafter located upon said Premises, it being understood that the enumeration of any specific articles of property shall in no way result in or be held to exclude any items of property not specifically mentioned. All of the land, estate and property hereinabove described, real, personal and mixed, whether affixed or annexed or not (except where otherwise hereinabove specified) and all rights hereby conveyed and mortgaged are intended so to be as a unit and are hereby understood, agreed and declared to form a part and parcel of the real estate and to be appropriated to the use of the real estate, and shall for the purposes of this Mortgage be deemed to be real estate and conveyed and mortgaged hereby. As to any of the property aforesaid which (notwithstanding the aforesaid declaration and agreement) does not so form a part and parcel of the real estate, this Mortgage is hereby deemed to be, as well, a Security Agreement under the Illinois Uniform Commercial Code ("Code") for the purpose of creating hereby a security interest in such property, which Mortgagor hereby grants to Mortgage as Secured Party (as said term is defined in the Code), securing said indebtedness and obligations.

Mortgagor represents and covenants that it is lawfully seized of the Premises that the same are unencumbered, and that it has good right, full power and lawful authority to convey and mortgage the same, and that it will warrant and forever defend said Premises and the quie' and peaceful possession of the same, subject to the rights of tenants, against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the Premises unto the said Mortgages, its successors and assigns, forever, for the purposes and uses herein set forth, together with the right to possession of the Premises, subject to the rights of tenants after the occurrence of an Event of Default (as defined in Section 13 hereof).

THIS MORTGAGE IS GIVEN TO SECURE: (a) payment of the indebtedness evidenced by the Note (together with any and all amendments or supplements thereto, extensions thereof and notes which may be taken in whole or partial renewal, substitution or extension thereof, or, which may evidence any of the indebtedness secured hereby); (b) payment by Mortgagor to Mortgagee as herein provided of all sums expended or advanced by Mortgagee pursuant to any term or provision of this Mortgage; (c) performance of each and every one of the covenants, conditions and agreements contained in this Mortgage and the Note; (d) performance of each and every one of the covenants, conditions and agreements contained in that certain Assignment of Leases and Rents of each date herewith from the Partnership to Mortgagee; and (e) performance under any other instrument given at any time to secure the payment of any other indebtedness to the Mortgagee. The foregoing documents, and any other documents evidencing and securing the loan reflected herein, are referred to collectively herein as the "Loan Documents".

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT:

Maintenance, Repair and Restoration of Improvements, Payment of Prior Liens, Etc.

1. Mortgagor shall (a) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the Premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (b) keep the Premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanics' liens or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof, except that Mortgagor shall have

the right to contest in good faith and with reasonable diligence the validity of any such lien or claim upon furnishing (i) to the title company which has issued the loan policy of title insurance to Mortgagee insuring the lien of this Mortgage such security or indemnity as it may require to issue an endorsement thereto insuring against loss or damage on account of any such lien; or (ii) to Mortgagee such other security with respect to such claims as may be reasonably acceptable to Mortgagee; (c) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the Premises on a parity with or superior to the lien hereof, and upon request, exhibit satisfactory evidence to Mortgagee of the discharge of such lien; (d) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings or any other improvements now or at any time in the process of construction upon the Premises; (e) comply with all applicable requirements of law, municipal ordinances or restrictions of record with respect to the Premises and the use and development thereof, including but not limited to those relating to zoning, building, environmental protection, health, fire and lafety; (f) make no material alterations or structural changes to the Premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance without the prior written consent of Mortgagee, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld or delayed; (g) suffer or permit no change in the general nature of the occupancy of the Premises, without Mortgagee's prior written consent, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld or delayed; (h) initiate or acquiesce in no zoning variation or reclassification, without Mortgagee's written consent; (i) pay each item of indebtedness secured by this Mortgage when due according to the terms hereof or of the kote; and (j) duly perform and observe all of the covenants, terms provisions and agreements herein or in the Loan Documents on the part of Mortgagor to be performed and observed.

Payment of Taxes and Assessments

2. Mortgagor shall pay before any penalty or interest attaches all general taxes, and chall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and all other charges or liens of any nature against the Premises when due, and shall furnish to Mortgagee duplicate receipts of payment therefor. If any special assessment is permitted by applicable law to be paid in installments, Mortgagor shall have the right to pay such assessment in installments, so long as all such installments are paid prior to the due data thereof. If Mortgagor elects to contest such taxes, then to prevent default hereunder, Mortgagor shall pay them in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute.

Tax Deposits

3. Upon the occurrence of an Event of Default, Mortgagor covenants and agrees to deposit at such place as Mortgage may from time to time in writing appoint, and in the absence of such appointment, then at the office of Mortgage in Chicago.

Illinois, a sum equal to one-twelfth (1/12th) of the last total annual taxes and assessments for the last ascertainable year (general and special) on the Premises, unless said taxes are based upon assessments which exclude the improvements or any part thereof now constructed, or to be constructed, in which event the amount of such deposits shall be based upon Mortgagee's reasonable estimate as to the amount of taxes and assessments to be levied and assessed. Mortgagor, concurrently with the first with Mortgagee an amount which, together with the aggregate of the monthly deposits to be made hereunder, will also deposit with Mortgagee an amount which, together with the aggregate of the monthly deposits to be made hereunder shall be sufficient to pay in full the total annual taxes and assessments so ascertainable or so estimated by Mortgagee, as the case may be, to become due and payable with respect to the Premises for the current calendar year, as of two months prior to the due date of such taxes and assessments. Such deposits are to be held without any allowance for interest and are to be used for the payment of taxes and assessments (general and special) on the Premises next

due and payable when they become due. If the funds so deposited are insufficient to pay any such taxes or assessments (general and special) for any year when the same shall become due and payable, Mortgagor shall within ten (10) days after receipt of demand therefor, deposit such additional funds as may be necessary to pay such taxes and assessments (general and special) in full. If the funds so deposited exceed the amount required to pay such taxes and assessments (general and special) for any year, the excess shall be applied to the next subsequent deposit or deposits. Said deposits need not be kept separate and apart from any other funds of Mortgagee; provided, however, if the Note and/or the Mortgage is assigned to a third party, such funds shall be maintained in a segregated account.

Insurance

4. Mortgagor shall keep or cause all buildings and improvements, fixtures and articles of personal property, if any, now or hereafter situated on the Premises insured against loss or damage by fire, tornado, windstorm and extended coverage perils and such other hazards as may reasonably be required by Mortgagee including, without limitation: (a) all-risk fire and extended coverage insurance, with vandalism and malicious mischief endorsements, for the full replacement value of the Premises, with acreed amount endorsement; (b) if there are tenants under leases at the Premises, rent and rental value insurance for the same perils described in (a) above payable at a rate per month bases upon existing leases; (c) broad form boiler and sprinkler leakage insurance in an amount reasonably satisfactory to Mortgage if and so long as the Premises shall contain a boiler and sprinkler system, respectively; (d) if the Premises are located in a flood hazard district, flood insurance in the maximum amount obtainable up to the amount of the indebtedness hereby secured: 4nd (e) such other insurance as Mortgagee may from time to time reasonably require, provided the same is generally required in the real estate industry. Mortgagor also shall at all times maintain comprehensive public liability, property damage and worker's compensation insurance, if applicable, covering the Premises and any employees thereof, with such limits for personal injury cleath and property damage as Mortgagee may reasonably require. All policies of insurance to be furnished hereunder shall be with companies with a Best's rating of A or better and shall be in form, amounts and deductibles reasonably satisfactory to Mortgagee, with Mortgagee clauses attached to all such policies in favor of and in form satisfactory to Mortgagee, including a provision requiring that the coverage evidenced thereby shall not be terminated or materially modified without thirty (30) days' prior written notice to Mortgagee and shall contain endorsements that no act or negligence of the insured or any occupant and no occupancy or use of the Premises for purposes more hazardous than permitted by the terms of the policies will affect the validity or enforceability of such policies as against Mortgagee. Mortgagor shall daliver certificates evidencing all such required insurance, including additional coverages and renewals, together with evidence of payment of premiums thereon, to Mortgages, and in the case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal certificates not less than ten (10) days prior to their respective dates of expiration.

Mortgagee's Interest In and Use of Deposits
5. Upon the occurrence of an Event of a Default in any of the provisions contained in this Mortgage or in the Note or the other Loan Documents, Mortgagee may at its option, without being required to do so, apply any moneys at the time on deposit pursuant to any provision of this Mortgage, as any one or more of the same may be applicable, on any of Mortgagor's obligations herein or in the Note or the other Loan Documents contained, in such order and manner as Mortgagee may elect. When the indebtedness secured hereby has been fully paid, any remaining deposits shall be paid to Mortgagor or to the then owner or

owners of the Premises. Such deposits are hereby pledged as additional security for the indebtedness hereunder and shall be held to be irrevocably applied by Mortgagee for the purposes for which made hereunder and shall not be subject to the direction or control of Mortgagor; provided, however, that Mortgagee shall not be liable for any failure to apply to the payment of taxes, assessments or insurance premiums any amount so deposited unless Mortgagor, while not in default hereunder, shall have requested Mortgagee in writing to make application of such funds to the payment of the particular taxes or assessments or the payment of the particular insurance premiums as the case may be for payment of which they were deposited, accompanied by the bills for such taxes, assessments or insurance premiums. Mortgagee shall not be liable for any act or omission taken in good faith or pursuant to the instructions of any party authorized to act on behalf of Mortgagor.

Adjustment of Losses with Insurer and Application of Proceeds of Insurance

The Mortgagor shall give the Mortgagee prompt notice of any damage to or destruction of the Premises. In case of loss, Mortgagee (or after entry of decree of foreclosure, purchaser at the sale, or the decree creditor, as the case may be) is hereby authorized either (a) to settle and adjust any claim under those insurance policies maintained by Mortgagor pursuant to Section 4 hereof without consent of Mortgagor, or (b) to allow Mortgagor to agree with the insurance company or companies on the amount to be paid upon the loss; rrovided, however, that so long as no Event of Default has occurred under the Note, this Mortgage or any of the other Loan Documents, Mortgagor shall have the right to settle and adjust any such claim with the consent of Mortgages. Except as otherwise provided in the previous sentence of this Section 6, such insurance proceeds may, at the option of Mortgagee, either be applied in payment or reduction of the indebtedness secured hereby, whether due or not, or be held by Mortgagee and used to reimburse Mortgagor for the cost of the rebuilding or restoration of buildings or improvements on said Premises. So long as no Event of Leinult has occurred under the Note, this Mortgage or any of the other Loan Documents, Mortgagor shall have the right (subject to the provisions of this Section) to utilize the proceeds to restore or rebuild the Premises. The buildings and improvements shall be so rescored or rebuilt as to be of at least equal value and substantially the same character as prior to such damage or destruction. If the net proceeds of insurance are insufficient to so restore or recalld the buildings and improvements, the additional costs to replace, repair, rebuild or restore shall be paid by Mortgagor. Such proceeds shall be held by Mortgagee and shall be made available to Mortgagor, from time to time, upon Mortgagee being furnished with satisfactory evidence of the estimated cost of completion thereof and with such architect's certificates, waivers of lier, contractors' sworn statements and other evidence of cost and of payments as Mortgagee may reasonably require and approve. The estimated cost of the work exceeds ten percent (10%) of the original principal amount of the indebtedness secured hereby, Mortgagee shall also be furnished with all plans and specifications for such rebuilding or restoration as the Mortgagee may reasonably require and approve. No payment made prior to the final completion of the work shall exceed ninety percent (90%) of the value of the work performed, from time to time, and at all times the undisbursed balance of said proceeds remaining in the hands of Mortgagee shall be at least sufficient to pay for the cost of completion of the work free and clear of

In case of loss after foreclosure proceedings have been instituted, the proceeds of any such insurance policy or policies, if not applied as aforesaid in rebuilding or restoring the buildings or improvements, shall be applied in payment or reduction of the indebtedness secured hereby or in payment or

reduction of the amount due in accordance with any decree of foreclosure that may be entered in any such proceedings, and the balance, if any, shall be paid to the owner of the equity of redemption if it shall then be entitled to the same or as the court may direct. In the case of the foreclosure of this Mortgage, the court in its decree may provide that the mortgagee's clause attached to each of said insurance policies may be cancelled and that the decree creditor may cause a new loss clause to be attached to each of said policies making the loss thereunder payable to said decree creditor; and any such foreclosure decree may further provide that in case of one or more redemptions under said decree, pursuant to the statute in such case made and provided, then, and in every such case, each successive redemptor may cause the preceding loss clause attached to each insurance policy to be cancelled and a new loss clause to be attached thereto, making the loss thereunder payable to such redemptor. In the event of foreclosure sale, Mortgages is hereby authorized, without the consent of Mortgagor, to assign any and all insurance policies to the purchaser at the sale, or to take such other steps as Mortgagee may deem advisable, to cause the interest of such purchaser to be protected by any of the said insurance policies.

Stamp Tax

7. If, by the laws of the United States of America, or of any state or political subdivision having jurisdiction over Mortgagor, any tax is due or becomes due in respect of the issuance of the Note or recording of this Mortgage, Mortgagor covenants and agrees to pay such tax in the manner required by any such law. Mortgagor further covenants to hold harmless and agrees to indemnify Mortgacee, its successors or assigns, against any liability incurred by reason of the imposition of any tax on the issuance of the Note or recording of this Mortgage.

Indemnity

8. Mortgagor hereby agrees that no liability shall be asserted or enforced against Mortgage in the lawful exercise of the rights and powers granted to Mortgagee in this Mortgage, and Mortgagor hereby expressly waives and releases any such liability. Except for the gross neglicence or wilfull misconduct of Mortgagee, Mortgagor shall indemnify and save Mortgagee harmless from and against any and all liabilities, obligations, losses, damages, claims, costs and expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees and court costs) of whatever lind or nature which may be imposed on, incurred by or asserted against Mortgagee at any time by any third party which relate to or arise from: making of the loan evidenced by the Note and secured by this Mortgage; any suit or proceeding (including probate and bankruptcy proceedings), or the threat thereof, in or to which Mortgagee may or does become a party, either as plaintic or as a defendant, by reason of this Mortgage or for the purpose of protecting the lien of this Mortgage; the offer for sale or sale of all or any portion of the Premises; and/or the ownership leasing, use, operation or maintenance of the Premises. All costs provided for herein and paid for by Mortgages shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest at the Default Rate (as defined in Section 29 hereof).

Effect of Extensions of Time
9. If the payment of the debt secured hereby or any part thereof be extended or varied or if any part of the security granted to secure such indebtedness be released, all persons now or at any time hereafter liable therefor, or interested in the Premises, or having an interest in Mortgagor or in the beneficiary of Mortgagor, shall be held to assent to such extension, variation or release, and their liability and the lien and all provisions hereof shall continue in full force, the right of recourse against all such persons being expressly reserved by Mortgagee, notwithstanding such extension, variation or release.

Any person, firm or corporation taking a junior mortgage or other lien upon the Premises or any interest therein, shall take the said lien subject to the rights of the Mortgagee to amend, modify and supplement this Mortgage, or the Note and to extend the maturity of the debt secured hereby, in each and every case without obtaining the consent of the holder of such junior lien and without the lien of this Mortgage losing its priority over the rights of any such junior lien. Nothing in this Section contained shall be construed as waiving any provisions contained herein which provides, among other things, that it shall constitute an Event of Default if the Premises are sold, conveyed or encumbered.

Effect of Changes in Laws Regarding Taxation

laws of the state in which the Premises are located deducting from the value of land any lien thereon he for the purpose of taxatica, or imposing upon Mortgages the payment of the whole or any part of the taxes or assessments or charges or liens herein required to be paid by Mortgagor, or changing in any way the laws relating to the taxation of mortgages or debts secured by mortgages or the Mortgagee's interest in the Premises, or the manner of collection of taxes, so as to affect this Mortgage or the debt secured hereby or the holders thereof, then, and in any such event, Mortgagor, upon demand by Mortgagee, shall pay such taxes or assessments, or reimburse Mortgagee therefor; provided, however, that if in the opinion of counsel for Mortgagee (a) it might be unlawful to require Mortgagor to make such payment or (b) the making of such payment might result in the imposition of interest beyond the maximum amount permitted by law, then and in such event, Mortgagee may elect, by notice in writing given to Mortgagor, to declare all of the indebtedness secured hereby to be and become due and payable ninety (90) days from the giving of such notice.

Mortgagee's Performance of Defaulted Acts and Expenses Incurred by Mortgagee

11. Upon the occurrence of an Fvent of Default, Mortgagea may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act required herein or in the Note or any of the other Loan Documents required of Mortgagor in any form and manner deercd expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payment, of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or refeiture affecting the Premises or consent to any tax or resessment or cure any default of Mortgagor in any lease of the Premises. Upon the occurrence of an Event of Default, Mortgagee may, but shall not be required to, complete construction, furnishing and equipping of any buildings or other improvements now or at any time hereafter on the Premises, and rent, operate and manage the Premises and such buildings and improvements and pay operating costs and expenses, including management fees, of every kind and nature in connection therewith, so that the Premises and such buildings and improvements shall be operational and usable for their intended purposes. All monies paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including reasonable attorneys' fees, and any other monies advanced by Mortgagee in regard to any tax referred to in Section 7 above or to protect the Premises or the lien hereof, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby, and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the Default Rate. In addition to the foregoing, any costs, expenses and fees, including attorneys' fees, incurred by Mortgagee in connection with (a) sustaining the lien of this Mortgage or its priority, (b) protecting and enforcing any of Mortgagee's rights hereunder, (c) recovering any indebtedness secured hereby, (d) any litigation or proceedings affecting repayment of the Note, this Mortgage, the Premises or any guarantor or co-maker of the Note or this Mortgage, including

without limitation, bankruptcy and probate proceedings, or (e) preparing for the commencement, defense or participation in any threatened litigation or proceedings, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby, and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the Default Rate. The interest accruing under this Section shall be immediately due and payable by Mortgagor to Mortgagee, and shall be additional indebtedness evidenced by the Note and secured by this Mortgage. Inaction of Mortgagee shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to it on account of any default on the part of Mortgagor. Should the proceeds of the Note or any part thereof, or any amount paid out or advanced by Mortgagee hereunder, or pursuant to any agreement executed by Mortgagee hereunder, or pursuant to any agreement executed by Mortgagee hereunder, or pursuant to any agreement executed by Mortgagee in connection with the loan evidenced by the Note, be used directly or indirectly to pay off, discharge or satisfy, in whole or in part, any lien or encumbrance upon the Premises or any part thereof, then as additional security hereunder, Mortgagee shall be subregated to any and all liens and equities, owned or claimed by any owner or holder of said outstanding liens, charges and indebtedness, however remote, regardless of whether said liens, charges and indebtedness are acquired by assignment or have been released of record by the holder thereof upon payment.

Notwithstanding anything contained herein to the contrary, in no event shall the indebtedness secured by this Mortgage exceed an amount equal to TWO MILLION AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$2,000,000.00).

Mortgagee's Reliance on Tax Bills and Claims for Liens
12. Mortgagee in making any payment hereby authorized: (a) relating to taxes and assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof; or (b) for the purchase, discharge, compromise or settlement of any other prior lien, may do so without inquiry as to the validity or amount of any claim for lien which may be asserted; provided that if no Event of Default exists hereunder. Mortgagee shall give Mortgagor ten (10) days' prior notice thereof.

Acceleration of Indebtedness in Event of Default Any one of the following events shall constitute an Event of Default under this Mortgage: if (a) default shall be made in the due and punctual payment of the Note, or any installment due in accordance with the terms chereof, either of principal or interest which has not been curve within five (5) days after the due date; or (b) Mortgagor or any Guarantor shall file a petition in voluntary bankruptcy or under Chapter 7 or Chapter 11 or Chapter 13 of the Federal Bankruptcy Code or any similar law, state or federal, whether now or hereafter existing, or an answer admitting insolvency or inability to pay to debts, or fail to obtain a vacation or stay of involuntary proceedings within sixty (60) days, as hereinafter provided; or (c) any order for relief of the Mortgagor or any Guarantor shall be entered under Title 11 of the United States Code, or a trustee or a receiver shall be appointed for Mortgagor or any Guarantor or for all of the property or the major part thereof of Mortgagor or any Guarantor in any involuntary proceeding, or any court shall have taken jurisdiction of the property of Mortgagor or any Guarantor or the major part thereof in any involuntary proceeding for the reorganization, dissolution, liquidation or winding up of Mortgagor or any Guarantor, and such trustee or receiver shall not be discharged or such jurisdiction relinquished or vacated or stayed on appeal or otherwise stayed within sixty (60) days; or (d) Mortgagor or any Guarantor shall make an assignment for the benefit of creditors, or shall admit in writing its inability to pay its debts generally as they become due, or shall consent to the appointment of a receiver or trustee or liquidator of all of its property or the major part thereof; or (e) default shall be made in the due observance or performance of any other of the covenants, agreements or conditions hereinbefore or hereinafter

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contained, required to be kept or performed or observed by Mortgagor or any Guarantor and the same shall continue for twenty-one (21) days after notice from Mortgages; or (f) default shall be made in the due observance or performance of any covenant, agreement or condition required to be kept or observed by Mortgagor in the Note or any Guarantor thereof or in any other instrument given at any time to secure the payment of the Note or any other indebtedness due to the Mortgagee, after the expiration of the applicable cure periods, if any; or (g) the existence of any material inaccuracy or untruth at the time made in any material representation, covenant or warranty contained in this Mortgage or in any other statement or certification as to facts delivered to Mortgagee by Mortgagor or any guarantor; then and in every such case the whole of said principal sum hereby secured shall, at once at the option of Mortgagea, become immediately due and payable, together with accrued interest thereon, without notice to Mortgagor; provided, however, that if a default under subsections (e) and (f) of this Section 13 be such that it cannot be corrected within twenty-one (21) days, Mortgagor shall not be in default if corrective action is initiated by Mortgagor within such period and diligently pursued until completion, with such default to be, in all events, cured within ninety (90) days.

Foreclosure: Expense of Litigation
14. When the indebtedness hereby secured, or any part thereof, shall become due, whether by acceleration or otherwise, Mortgagee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof for such indebtedness or part thereof and/or exercise any right, power or remedy provided in this Mortgage or any of the other Loan Documents. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof or enforce any other remedy of Mortgages under this Mortgage or the Note, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale or other judgment or decree all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgagee for attorneys' fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs, and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, title insurance policies and similar document assurances with respect to title and value as Mortgagee may deem reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or co evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true conditions of the title to or the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned, and such expenses and fees as may be incurred in the protection of the Premises and the maintenance of the lien of this Mortgage, including the reasonable fees of any attorney employed by Mortgagee in any litigation or proceeding effecting this Mortgage, the Note or the Premises, including problet and bankruptcy proceedings, or in preparations for the communicament or defense of any proceeding or threatened suit or proceeding, shall be immediately due and payable by Mortgagor, with interest thereon at the Default Rate and shall be secured by this Mortgage.

Application of Proceeds of Foreclosure Sale
15. The proceeds of any foreclosure (or partial foreclosure) sale of the Premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: first, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding Section hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the Note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, to the principal remaining unpaid on the Note; fourth, to interest remaining unpaid on the Note; and lastly, any overplus to Mortgagor, its successors or assigns, as their rights may appear.

Appointment of Receiver

Upon, or at any time after the filing of a complaint to foreclose this Mortgage, the court in which such complaint is filed may appoint a receiver of the Premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagor at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the Premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and Mo: tgages hereunder or any Holders may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power: (a) to collect the rents, issues and profits of the Premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagor, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits; (b) to extend or modify any then existing leases and to make new leases, which extensions, modifications and new leases may provide for terms to expire, or for options to lussees to extend or renew terms to expire, beyond the maturity date of the indebterness hereunder and beyond the date of the issuance of a deed or deeds to a purchaser or purchasers at a foreclosure sale, it being understood and agreed that any such leases, and the options or other such provisions to be contained therein, shall be binding upon Mortgagor and all persons whose interests in the Premises are subject to the lien hereof and upon the purchaser or purchasers at any foreclosure sale, notwithstanding any redemption from sale, discharge of the mortgage indebtedness, satisfaction of any foreclosure decree, or issuance of any certificate of sale or deed to any purchaser; and (c) all other powers which may be naces very or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the Premises during the whole of maid period. The court from time to time may authorize the receiver co apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of: (i) the indebtedness secured hereby, or by any decree foreclosing this Mortgage, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree, provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (ii) if this is a leasehold mortgage, all rents due or which may become due under the underlying lease; and (iii) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.

Assignment of Rents and Leases
17. To further secure the indebtedness secured hereby, Mortgagor hereby sells, assigns and transfers un wortgages all the rents, issues and profits now due and which may hereafter become due under or by virtue of any lease, whether written or verbal, or any letting of, or of any agreement for the use or occupancy of the Premises or any part thereof, which may been heretofore or may be hereafter made or agreed to or which may be made or agreed to by Mortgagee under the powers herein granted, it being the intention hereby to establish an absorbet transfer and assignment of all such leases and agreements, and all the avails thereunder, to Mortgages. Mortgagor hereby irrevocably appoints Mortgagee its true and lawful attorney in its name and stead (with or without taking possession of the Premises as provided in Section 19 hereof) to rent, lease or let all or any portion of the Premises to any party or parties at such rental and upon such terms as Mortgages shall, in its discretion, determine, and to collect all of said avails, rents, issues and profits arising from or accruing at any time hereafter, and all now due or that may hereafter become due under each and every of the leases and agreements, written or oral, or other tenancy existing, or which may hereafter exist on the Premises, with the same rights and powers and subject to the same immunities, exoneration of liability and rights of recourse and indemnity as Mortgagee would have upon taking possession pursuant to the provisions of Section 19 hereof. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Section 17, so long as no Event of

Default shall exist under the Note, Mortgage or any other Loan Documents, Mortgagor shall have the right and license to collect, use and enjoy all rents and other sums due or to become due under and by virtue of any lease as they respectively become due, but not more than thirty (30) days in advance.

Mortgagor represents and agrees that no rent has been or will be paid by any person in possession of any portion of the Premises for more than one installment in advance without Mortgagee's prior written consent and that the payment of none of the rents to accrue for any portion of the said Premises has been or will be waived, released, reduced, discounted or otherwise discharged or compromised by Mortgagor. Mortgagor waives any rights of set off against any person in possession of any portion of the Premises. If any lease provides for the abatement of rent during repair of the Premises demised thereunder by reason of fire or other casualty, Mortgagor shall furnish to Mortgagee rental insurance, the policies to be in amount and form and written by such insurance companies as shall be satisfactory to Mortgagee. Mortgagor agrees that it will not assign any of the rents or profits of the Premises, except to a purchaser or grantee of (b) Premises.

Nothing herein contained shall be construed as constituting Mortgagee a mortgagee in possession in the absence of the taking of actual possession of the Premises by Mortgagee pursuant to Section 19 hereof. In the exercise of the powers herein granted Mortgagee, no liability shall be asserted or enforced against Mortgagee, all such liability being expressly waived and released by Mortgagor.

Mortgagor further agrees to assign and transfer to Mortgagee all future leases upon all or any part of the Premises and to execute and deliver, at the request of Mortgagee, all such further assurances and assignments in the Premises as Mortgages shall from time to time require.

Although it is the intention of the parties that the assignment contained in this Section 17 shall be a present assignment, it is expressly understood and agreed, anything herein contained to the contrary notwith canding, that is the contrary notwith contained to the contrary notwind the contained to the contrary notwith contained to the contra shall not exercise any of the rights or povers conferred upon it by this section until an Event of Default whall exist under this Mortgage or the Note.

Observance of Lease Assignment

18. In the event Mortgagor, as additional security for the payment of the indebtedness described in and secure hereby, has sold, transferred and assigned, or may hereafter sell, transfer and assign, to Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, and interest of Mortgagor as lessor in any lease or leases, Fortgagor expressly covenants and agrees that if Mortgagor shall suffer or permit to occur any material breach or default under the provisions of any assignment of any lease or leases of the Premises given as additional security for the payment of the indebtedness secured hereby, then and in any such event, such breach or default shall constitute a default hereunder unless cured within twenty-one (21) days after notice from Mortgagee, and at the option of Mortgagee, and without notice to Mortgagor, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this Mortgage shall, notwithstanding anything in the Note or in this Mortgage to the contrary, become due and payable as in the case of other defaults; provided, however, that Mortgagor shall not be in default if corrective action is initiated by Mortgagor within such period and diligently pursued to completion, so long as the corrective action is completed within ninety (90) days from the date that Mortgagor receives notice of such default.

Mortgagee's Right of Possession in Case of Default 19. In any case in which, under the provisions of this Mortgage, Mortgagee has a right to institute foreclosure proceedings, whether before or after the whole principal sum secured hereby is declared to be immediately due as aforesaid, or whether before or after the institution of legal proceedings to foreclose the lien hereof or before or after sale thereunder, Mortgager shall forthwith, upon demand of Mortgagee, surrender to Mortgagee and Mortgagee shall be entitled to take actual possession of the Premises personally or by its agents or attorneys, subject to the rights of existing tenants. event Mortgagee in its discretion may, with or without force and with process of law, enter upon and take and maintain possession of all or any part of said Premises, together with all documents, books, records, papers and accounts of Mortgagor or then owner of the Premises relating thereto, and may exclude Mortgagor and its employees, agents or servants wholly therefrom, and may as attorney in fact or agent of Mortgagor, or in its own name as Mortgagee and under the powers herein granted, hold, operate, manage and control the Premises and conduct the business, if any, thereof, either personally or by its agents, and with full power to use such accourse, legal or equitable, as in its discretion or in the discretion of its successors or assigns may be deemed proper or necessary to enforce the payment or security of the avails, rents, issues, and profits of the Premises, including actions for the recovery of rent, actions in forcible detainer and actions in distres, for rent, and with full power: (a) to cancel or terminate any lease or sublease for any cause or on any ground which would entitle Mortgager to cancel the same; (b) to elect to disaffirm any large or sublease which is then subordinate to the lien hareof; (c) to extend or modify any then existing leases and to make new leases, which extensions, modifications and new leases, may provide for terms to expire, or for options to lessees to extend or renew terms to expire, beyond the maturity date of the indebtedness hereunder and beyond the date of the issuance of a deed or greds to a purchaser or purchasers at a foreclosure sale, it being understood and agreed that any such leases, and the options or other such provisions to be contained therein, shall be binding upon Mortgagor and all persons whose interests in the Premiser are subject to the lien hereof and upon the purchaser or purchasers at any foreclosure sale, notwithstanding any redemption from sale, discharge of the mortgage indebtedness, satisfaction of any foreclosure decree, or issuance of any certificate of sale or deed to any purchaser; (d) to enter into any management, leasing or brokering agreements covering the Premises; (e) to make all necessary or proper repairs, decorating, renewals, replacements, alterations, additions, betterments and improvements to the Premises as to it may seem judicious; (f) to insure and reinsure the same and all risks incidental to Mortgagee's possession, operation and all management thereof; and (g) to receive all of such available rents issues and profits; hereby granting full power and authority to exercise each of the rights, privileges and powers herein granted at any and all times hereafter, without notice to Mortgagor.

Mortgagee shall not be obligated to perform or discharge, nor does it hereby undertake to perform or discharge, any obligation, duty or liability under any leases. Except for Mortgagee's gross negligence or wilfull misconduct, Mortgager shall and does hereby agree to indemnify and hold Mortgagee harmless of and from any and all liability, loss or damage which Mortgagee may or might incur under said leases or under or by reason of the assignment thereof and of and from any and all claims and demands whatsoever which may be asserted against Mortgagee by reason of any alleged obligations or undertakings on its part to perform or discharge any of the terms, covenants or agreements contained in said leases. Should Mortgagee incur any such liability, loss or damage under said leases or under or by reason of the assignment thereof, or in the defense of any claims or demands, the amount thereof, including costs, expenses and

reasonable attorneys' fees, together with interest at the Default Rate, shall be secured hereby, and Mortgagor shall reimburse Mortgagee therefor immediately upon demand.

Application of Income Received by Mortgagee

- 20. Mortgagee, in the exercise of the rights and powers hereinabove conferred upon it, shall have full power to use and apply the avails, rents, issues and profits of the Premises to the payment of or on account of the following, in such order as Mortgagee may determine:
 - (a) to the payment of the operating expenses of the Premises, including cost of management and leasing thereof (which shall include reasonable compensation to Mortgagee and its agent or agents, if management be delegated to an agent or agents, and shall also include lease commissions and other compensation and expenses of seeking and procuring terants and entering into leases), established claims for damages, if any, and premiums on insurance hereinabove authorized;
 - (1) to the payment of taxes and special assessments now due or which may hereafter become due on the Premises; and, if this is a leasehold mortgage, of all rents due or which may become hereafter due under the underlying lease;
 - (c) to the payment of all maintenance, repairs, decorating, renevals, replacements, alterations, additions, betterments, and inprovements of the Premises, and of placing the Premises in such condition as will, in the reasonable judgment of Mortgagee, make it readily rentable;
 - (d) to the payment of any indebtedness secured hereby or any deficiency which may result from any foreclosure sale.

Mortgagee's Right of Inspection

21. Mortgagee and/or its representatives shall have the right to inspect the Premises at all reasonable times upon reasonable prior notice and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.

Condemnation

22. Mortgagor hereby assigns, transfers and sets over unto Mortgagee the entire proceeds of any award or any claim for damages for any of the Premises taken or damaged under the power of eminent domain or by condemnation; provided, fowever, that so long as no Event of Default has occurred under the Note, this Mortgage or the other Loan Documents, Mortgagor shall have the right to settle any award or claim for damages with the consent of Mortgagee. Mortgagee may elect to apply the proceeds of the award upon or in reduction of the indebtedness secured hereby, whether due or not, or to require Mortgagor to restore or rebuild, in which event the proceeds shall be held by Mortgages and used to reimburse Mortgagor for the cost of the rebuilding or restoring of buildings or improvements on said Premises, in accordance with plans and specifications to be submitted to and approved by Mortgagee. In the event Mortgagor is required or authorized by Mortgagee's election as aforesaid to rebuild or restore, the proceeds of the award shall be paid out in the same manner as is provided in Section 6 hereof for the payment of insurance proceeds toward the cost of rebuilding or restoration. If the amount of such award is insufficient to cover the cost of rebuilding or restoration, Mortgagor shall pay such cost in excess of the award, before being entitled to reimbursement out of the award. Any surplus which may remain out of said award after payment of such cost or rebuilding or restoration shall, at the option of Mortgagee, be applied on account of the indebtedness secured hereby or be paid to any other party entitled thereto. Notwithstanding the foregoing, provided that

there is no occurrence of an Event of Default under the Note, this Mortgage or any of the other Loan Documents, Mortgagor shall have the right (subject to the provisions of this Section) to utilize the award to restore the Premises.

Release upon Payment and Discharge of Mortgagor's Obligations 23. If Mortgagor shall fully pay all principal and interest on the Note and all other indebtedness secured hereby, then this Mortgage shall be null and void. Mortgagee shall release this Mortgage and the lien thereof by proper instrument upon payment and discharge of all indebtedness secured hereby.

Giving of Notices

24. Any notice or demand which either party nerecome, desire or be required to give to the other party shall be in writing, and shall be deemed given (i) if and when personally delivered, or (ii) upon receipt if sent by United States certified mail, postage prepaid, or (iii) on the next business day if sent by a nationally recognized overnight courier, for morning selivery, addressed to a party at its address set forth below, or at such other place as such party may have designated for itself by notice in writing in accordance herewith:

Waiver of Defense
25. No action for the enforcement of the lien or any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the Note.

Waiver of Right of Redemption and other Rights
26. To the full extent permitted by law, Mortgagor agrees that it will not at any time or in any manner whatsoever take any

advantage of any stay, exemption or extension law or any socalled "Moratorium Law" now or at any time hereafter in force,
nor take any advantage of any law now or hereafter in force,
nor take any advantage of any law now or hereafter in force
providing for the valuation or appraisement of the Premises, or
any part thereof, prior to any sale thereof to be made pursuant
to any provisions herein contained, or to any decree, judgment or
order of any court of competent jurisdiction; or after such sale
claim or exercise any rights under any statute now or hereafter
in force to redeem the property so sold, or any part thereof, or
relating to the marshalling thereof, upon foreclosure sale or
other enforcement hereof. To the full extent permitted by law,
Mortgagor hereby expressly waives any and all rights it may have
to require that the Premises be sold as separate tracts or units
in the event of foreclosure. To the full extent permitted by
law, Mortgagor hereby expressly waives any and all rights of
redemption under the Illinois Mortgage Foreclosure Act (the

Transfer of Title

27. In determining whether or not to make the loan secured hereby, Mortgagee examined the cridit-worthiness of Mortgagor or Mortgagor's beneficiary, if applicable, or Guarantor, if any, found the same to be acceptable and raied and continues to rely upon same as the means of repayment of the Note. Mortgagee also evaluated the background and experience of Mortgagor or Mortgagor's beneficiary and the Guarantor, if any, in owning and operating property such as the Premises, found the same acceptable and relied and continues to rely upon same as the means of maintaining the value of the Premises which is Mortgagee's security for the Note. Mortgagor and Mortgagor's beneficiary and the Guarantor, if any, are well experienced in borrowing money and owning and operating property such as the Premises, were ably represented by a licensed attorney at law in the negotiation and documentation of the loan secured hereby and bargained at arm's length and without duress of any kind for all of the terms and conditions of the loan, including this provision. Mortgagor and Mortgagor's beneficiary recognize that Mortgagee is entitled to keep its loan portfolio at current interest rates by either making new loans at such rates or collecting assumption fees and/or increasing the interest rate on a loan, the security for which is purchased by a party other than the original Mortgagor and Mortgagor's beneficiary, if applicable. Mortgagor and Mortgagor's beneficiary of Mortgagor, if applicable, further recognize that any secondary or junior financing placed upon the Premises, or the beneficiary in Mortgagor (a) may divert funds which would otherwise be used to pay the Note secured hereby; (b) could result in acceleration and foreclosure by any such junior encumbrance which would force Mortgagee to take measures and incur expenses to protect its security; (c) would detract from the value of the Premises should Mortgagee come into possession thereof with the intention of selling same; and (d) would impair Mortgagee's right to accept a dee

foreclosure by Mortgages would be necessary to clear the title to the Premises.

In accordance with the foregoing and for the purposes of (i) protecting Mortgagee's security, both of repayment and of value of the Premises; (ii) giving Mortgagee the full benefit of its bargain and contract with Mortgagor and Mortgagor's beneficiary, if applicable; (iii) allowing Mortgagee to raise the interest rate and collect assumption fees; and (iv) keeping the Premises and the beneficial interest free of subordinate financing liens, Mortgagor, Mortgagor's beneficiary, if applicable, and any Guarantor agree that if this paragraph be deemed a restraint on alienation, that it is a reasonable one, and that, eny sale, conveyance, assignment, further encumbrance or other transfer of title to the Premises, the beneficial interest in the Mortgagor or any interest in the Premises or said beneficial interest (whether voluntary or by operation of law), including without limitation, the entering into of an installment agreement for the sale of the Premises or the beneficial interest in Mortgagor, the placement or granting of liens on all or any part of the Premises or said beneficial interest or the placement or granting or security agreements which would be or create a lien on the personal property utilized in the operation of the Premises, or the placement or granting of a mortgage commonly known as a "wrap around" mortgage or an improvement loan, without Mortgagee's prior written consent shall be a default hereunder; provided, however, that such consent shall not be unreasonably withheld as it relates to equipment mases, chattel mortgages, conditional sales contracts or other refinancing which would be or create a lien on the personal property. For the purpose of, and without limiting the generality of, the preceding sentence, the occurrence at any time of any of the following events shall be deemed to be an unpermitted transfer of title to the Premises and, therefore, a default hereunder:

- (a) any sale, conveyance, assignment or other transfer of, or the grant of a security interest in, all or any part of the title to the Premises or the beneficial interest in, or power of direction under, the trust agreement with Mortgagor, if applicable; or
- (b) any sale, conveyance, assignment or other transfer of, or the grant of a security interest in, any shares of stock of Mortgagor (if a corporation) or of the corporation which is the beneficiary or one of the beneficiaries under the trust agreement with Mortgagor, if applicable, or of any corporation directly or indirectly controlling such beneficiary corporation; or
- (c) any sale, conveyance, assignment or other transfer of, or the grant of a security interest in, any general partnership interest of the limited partnership or the general partnership (the "Partnership") which is the Mortgagor or the beneficiary or one of the beneficiaries under the trust agreement with Mortgagor, other than any such sale, conveyance or assignment resulting from the death of a partner of the Partnership; or
- (d) any sale, conveyance, assignment or other transfer of, or the grant of a security interest in, any share of any corporation directly or indirectly controlling any such Partnership.

Any consent by Mortgagee, or any waiver by Mortgagee of a default under this Section 27 shall not constitute a consent to, or waiver of any right, remedy or power of Mortgagee upon a subsequent default under this Section 27. Mortgagor acknowledges that any agreements, liens, charges or encumbrances created in

violation of the provisions of this Section 27 shall be void and of no force or effect.

In the event Mortgagee gives its written consent to the sale or transfer, whether by operation of law, voluntarily, or otherwise, of all or any part of the Premises, Mortgages shall be authorized and empowered to deal with the vendes or transferse with regard to the Premises, the indebtedness secured hereby, and any of the terms or conditions hereof as fully and to the same extent as it might with Mortgagor, without in any way releasing or discharging Mortgagor from any of its covenants hereunder, and without waiving Mortgagee's right of acceleration as provided herein.

Furnishing of Financial Statements to Mortgagee

Mortgagee's Lien for Service Charge and Expenses

32. At all times, regardless of whether any loan proceeds have been disbursed, this Mortgage secures (in addition to any loan proceeds disbursed from time to time) the payment of the loan commissions aggregating NINE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$9,750.00) of which FOUR THOUSAND EIGHT
