

#### Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

#### Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or retures to play the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto; shall be a tien in favor of the United States upon all property and cights to property, whether rest or personal, belonging to such person

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date in specifically fixed by law, the tien imposed by section 6325 shall arise at the time the assessmen, is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount au issessoid (or a judgment against the taxpayor arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unerforceable by issaed of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The iten imposed by section (32), chall not be valid as applied any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanics tenor, or judgment lien creditor until rotate the red which meets the requirements of subsection (high see filled by the Secretary.

#### m Place For Filling Notice; Form.-

(t) Place For Filling - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed-

(A) Under State Lews

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(II) Ferannal Property in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental auddination), as designated by the laws of such State in which the property subject to the lien is equated; except that State law merely conforming to reenecting Federal law establishing a national filing as designanted by the laws of such State, or july from Clock Of District Countin the office of the

july from Clock Of District Countin the office of the clerk of the United States district count for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the

requirements of subparagraph (A), or (C) With Recorder Of Deads Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deads of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is allusted in the District of Columbia. (2) Situs Of Property Subject To Uen - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shaff-be deemed to be shalled (A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(A) Personal Property in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpeyer at the tim, include of the felfod.

If it purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or portrainth shall be desired to be the place at which the pincipal or equitive office of the business is located, and the residence of a Luchywe whose residence is without the United States shall be of amed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - he form and contact of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shalf be cleed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid in hydratanding any other provision of law regarding the form or come it of a hollos of tien.

Note: See section 6323(b) for protection for certain interests even though notice of lien imposed by section 5321 is filed with respect to:

- 1. Sacurities
- 2. Motor vehicles
- 3. Personal property purchaself at refall
- 4. Personal property purchased in casual sale
- 5. Personal property subjected to possessory lien.
  6. Real property tax and special assessment liens.
- Residential property subject to a mechanic's lien for certain repairs and improvements
- B. Attorney's liens
- 9. Certain insurance contracts
- 10. Passbook loans

(g) Refiling Of Notice.—For purposes of this section-

(1) General Rule, —Unless notice of flow is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refling period, such notice of flori shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f) after the expiration of even refliling period.

(2) Place For Filling.—A notice of lies retries! during the required refilling period shall be effective only-

(A) If-

(i) such notice of lien is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, and the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the system required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refling of notice of ten under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received Written Information (in the marrier prescribed in regulations Issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the tabbayor's residence. If is notice of both lien is also filled in accordance with subsectic (if) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refilling Period.—In the case of any notice of ken, the term "required refiling period" magnet

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the explication of 10 years after the date of the assessment of the lax and

(b) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 10 years after the close of the proceding required refilling period for such notice of lien.

#### Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien, —Subject to such requisitions as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall result a contificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days effect the day on which:

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Seoretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed togethor with all interes; in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accopted There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by film a bond that is conditioned upon it or layment of the amount assessed, together with all interval in expect thereof, within the time prizonted by less (including any by choice of such time), and that is in accordance with soon inquire sens relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond, and winter these thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

## Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Fleturns and Return Information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes.—

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien, if a notice of tien has been filled pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by fuch lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in such property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
