4. That Daniel W. Weil is the Commissionar of the General manufacturing of Buildings of the City of Chicago, and as such, and through reports of inspectors of the Department of Buildings of said City of Chicago, he or the undersigned has knowledge of the facts stated in this Complaint.

That this proceeding Is brought pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago, and of Chapter 24, Section 11-31-1, 11-31-2, and 11-13-15 of the Illinois Revised statutes, as amended.

Wherefore, plaintiff prays for a fine against the defendants, other than the defendants whose only interest in the property is by virtue of security interests or liens therein, in the said amount indicated on the heading of the Complaint for each day said violations have existed and/or exist, except as to violations of Section 39-13 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, for which violations plaintiff prays for a fine against all defendants.

#### COUNT 11

As a second and further cause of action the plaintiff, City of Chicago, A Municipal Corporation:

- Realleges the allegations of paragraphs one through five of Count I as paragraphs one through five of Count II and further alleges:
- That the levying of a fine is not an adequate remedy for the abatement of 6. a nuisance, and that it is necessary that a temporary and permanent injuction issue and a receiver be appointed to bring the subject property into compliance with the Municipal Code of Chicago.
- That Daniel W. Well, the Commissioneer of the Department of Builldings, City of Chicago, has determined said building to be dangerous and unsafe or uncompleted and abandoned.

#### WHEREFORE, PLAINTIFF PRAYS:

- For a temporary and permanent injunction requiring the defendants to correct the said violations and to restrain future violations permanently.
- For the appointment of receiver, if necessary, to correct the condition alleged in the Complaint with the full powers of receivership including the right to issue and sell receivers certificates.
- For an order of the plaintiff to demolish said premises and a judgement against defendants and a lien of the subject property for the cost of demoliting in accordance with Section 11-31-1 of Chapter 24 of the Illinois Revised Statutes, as amended, or for an order for plaintiff to demolish said premises under the police power to protect the public health and safety.
