1. PAYMENT OF PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST; PREPAYMENT AND LATE CHARGES. Borrower shall promptly pay when due the principal of and interest on the debt evidenced by the Note and any prepayment and late charges due under the Note.

2. FUNDS FOR TAXES AND INSURANCE. 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- 6. OCCUPANCY, PRESERVATION, MAINTENANCE AND PROTECTION OF THE PROPERTY; BORROWER'S LOAN APPLICATION: LEASEHOLDS. Borrower shall occupy, establish, and use the Froperty as Borrower's principal residence within minty days after the execution of this Security Instrument and shall continue to occupy the Property as Borrower's principal residence for at least one year after the date of occupancy, unless Lender otherwise agrees in writing, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld, or unless extenuating circumstances exist which are beyond Sorrower's control. Borrower shall not destroy, damage or impair the Property, allow the Property to deteriorate, or commit waste on the Property. Borrower shall be in default if any forfeiture action or proceeding, whether civil or criminal, is begun that in Lender's good faith judgment could result in forfeiture of the Property or otherwise materially impair the lien prested by this Security Instrument Lander's security interest. Any forbearance by Lender in exercising any right or remedy shall not be a waiver of or practude the exercise of any right or remedy.
- 12. SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS SOUND; JOINT AND SEVERAL LIABILITY; CO-SIGNERS. The covenants and agreements of this Security Instrument shall bind and benefit the successors and assigns of Lender and Borrower, subject to the provisions of paragraph 17. Borrower's covenants and agreements shall be joint and several. Any Borrower who co-signs this Security Instrument but does not execute the Note: (a) is co-signing this Security Instrument only to mortgage, grant and convey that Borrower's interest in the Property under the terms of this Security Instrument; (b) is not personally obligated to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument; and (c) agrees that Lender and any other Borrower may agree to extend, modify, formant or make any accommodations with regard to the terms of this Security Instrument or the Note without that Borrower's sent.

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- 13. LOAN CHARGES, If the loan secured by this Security Instrument is subject to a law which sets maximum loan charges. and that law is finally interpreted so that the interest or other loan charges collected or to be collected is commenties with the loan exceed the permitted limits, then: (a) any such loan charge shall be reduced by the amount necessary to reduce the charge to the permitted limit; and (b) any sums already collected from Borrower which exceeded permitted limits will be refunded to Borrower. Lender may choose to make this refund by reducing the principal owed under the Note or by making a direct payment to Borrower. If a refund reduces principal, the reduction will be treated as a partial prepayment without any prepayment charge under the Note.
- 14. NOTICES. Any notice to horrower provided for in this Security Instrument shall be given by delivering it or by mailing it by first class mail unless applicable law requires use of another method. The notice shall be directed to the Property Address or any other address Borrower designates by notice to Lender. Any notice to Lender shall be given by first class mail to Lender's address stated herein or any other address Lender designates by notice to Sorrower. Any notice provided for in this Security Instrument shall be deemed to have been given to Borrower or Lender when given as provided in this paragraph.
- 16. GOVERNING LAW; SEVERABILITY. This Security Instrument shall be governed by federal law and the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. In the event that any provision or clause of this Security Instrument or the Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Security Instrument or the Mote which can be given effect without the conflicting provision. To this end the provisions of this Security Instrument and the Note are declared to be goverable.
  - 16. BORROWER'S OP/. Borrower shall be given one conformed copy of the Note and of this Security Instrument.
- 17. TRANSFER OF THE PROPERTY OR A BENEFICIAL INTEREST IN BORROWER. If all or any part of the Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred ( or if a beneticial interest in Borrower is sold or transferred and Sorrower is not a natural person } without Lander's prior written consent, Lender may, at its option, require immediate payment in full of all sums accuract by this Security instrument.
