  - (c) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Adjustable Rate and r in the event that (i) the Existing Interest Rate was reduced on a Change Date, and (ii) Lender failed or give the Adjustment Notice when required, and (iii) Borrower, consequently, paid any interest in excess of the amount which would have been set forth in such Adjustment Notice ("Excess Payments"), then Lende i most subtract from the unpaid principal balance all Excess Payments, with interest thereon at a rate equal to the sum of the Margin and the Index on the Change Date when the Existing Interest Rate was so reduced, from the date each such Excess Payment was made by Borrower thereby increasing the available funds under the mortgage by the Excess Payment and the interest thereon.
