- 1. Mortgagers shall (1) prominty sepair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for then not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (5) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured; by a lies or charge on the premises experier to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Trustee or to hulders of the note; (4) complete within a reasonable time any buildings now or at any time in process of exection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance.
- 2. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insulvency of Moting a at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the premiers or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and the Trustee heree ider may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, bessess and profits of said premiers during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a verticine, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagors, except for the intervention of such receiver, or if he entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be precessary or are usual in such cases of a receiver, on the necessary of the precessary for the protection, possession, control, management and operator of the premises during the whole of said period.
