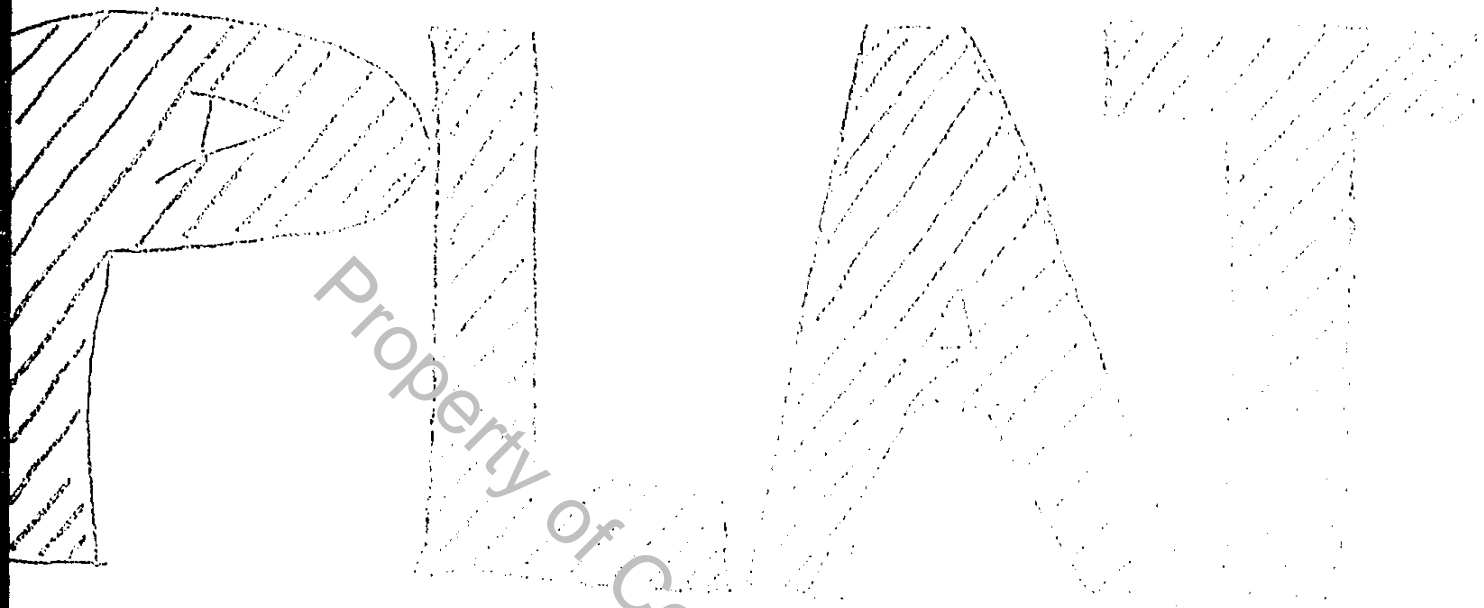

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX CERTAIN TERRITORY
TO THE VILLAGE OF GLENVIEW, COOK COUNTY,
ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, there were filed with the Clerk of the Village of Glenview, a home rule municipality on June 25, 1992, a certain petition to annex to the said Village of Glenview, property hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Glenview have independently determined that said property described in the aforesaid petition is not within the corporate limits of any municipality, that it is contiguous to the present village limits of the Village of Glenview and that all property owners, and electors have signed said petition as required by statute.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Glenview, Cook County, Illinois, that

Section 1: The facts and statements contained in the preamble to this ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this ordinance.

Section 2: The property commonly known as 1130 Longmeadow Drive and is legally described as

Lot 11 in Kempston Countryside, being a subdivision in the east half of the northwest quarter of Section 33, Township 42 North, Range 12 East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois.

be and the same is hereby annexed to the Village of Glenview, Cook County, Illinois, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 24, Section 7-1-8 of the Illinois Revised Statutes.

Section 3: The Clerk of the Village of Glenview is hereby authorized and directed to record with the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County, Illinois, a certified copy of this ordinance, together with an accurate map of the territory annexed, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 4: Every section and provision of this ordinance shall be separable, and the invalidity of any portion of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other portion hereof.

Section 5: This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, and approval according to law.

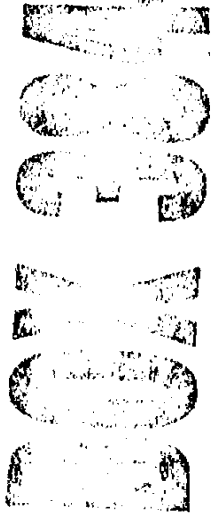


