Grantor shall produce and maintain policies of fire Insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all Improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgagee clause in favor of Lander. If the Real Property is located in an area designated by the Director of the Federal Emergency Management Agency as a special flood hazard area, Granfor agrees to obtain Federal Flood Insurance to the extent such insurance is required and is available for the term of the foan and for the full unpaid principal balance of the loan. Policios shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Further Assurances. Upon request of Lender, Grantor will make, execute and deliver, or will cause to be made, executed or delivered, to Lender or to Lander's designee, and when requested by Lender, cause to be filed, recorded, refiled, or rerecorded, as the case may be, at such times and in such offices and places as Lender may deem appropriate, any and all such mortgages, deeds of trust, security deeds, security agreements, financing statements, continuation statements, instruments of further assurance, certificates, and other documents as may, in the sole upinion of Lender, be necessary or desirable in order to effectuate, complete, perfect, continue, or preserve. (a) the obligations of Grantor under the Credit Agreement, this Mortgage, and the Related Documents, and. (b) the liens and security interests created by this Mortgage on the Property. Unless prohibited by law or agreed to the contrary by Lender in writing, Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all costs and expenses incurred in connection with the matters referred to in this paragraph.

- 17. FULL PERFORMANCE. If Grantor pays all the Indebtedness when due, terminates the credit line account, and otherwise performs all the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Mortgage, Lender shall execute and deliver to Grantor a suitable satisfaction of this Mortgage. Grantor will pay, if permitted by applicable law, any reasonable termination fee as determined by Lender from time to time
- 18. DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lender, shall constitute an event of detault ("Event of Default") under this Mortgage: (a) Grantor commits traud or makes a material misrepresentation at any time in connection with the credit line account. This can include, for example, a false statement about Grantor's Income, assets, liabilities, or any other aspects of Grantor's financial condition. (b) Grantor does not meet the repayment terms of the credit line account. (c) Grantor's action or inaction adversely affects the collateral for the credit line account or Lender's rights in the collateral. This can include, for example, failure to maintain required insurance, waste or destructive use of the dwelling, failure to pay laxes, death of all persons liable on the account, transfer of title or sale of the dwelling, creation of a lien on the dwelling without Lender's permission, foreclosure by the

holder of another tien, or the use of funds or the dwelling for prohibited purposes.

- 19. GRANTOR'S RIGHT TO CURE. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default (other than fraud or material misrepresentation) and prior to exercising any of the rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or by law, Lender shall give notice as provided in the Mortgage and as required by applicable law. The notice may be combined or sent with any notice required by applicable law and shall specify: (a) the Event of Default; (b) the action required to cure the default; (c) a date not less than thirty (30) days (or any longer period as required by applicable law or eisewhere in this Mortgage) from the date the notice is given to Grantor by which the default must be cured and (d) that failure to cure the default on or before the cate specified in the notice may result in acceleration of the sums secured by this Mortgage and sale of the property. The notice shall further inform Grantor of the right to reinstate after acceleration and the right to assert in a foreclosure proceeding the nonexistence of an event of default or into Grantor to acceleration and sale. However, if Lender has given Grantor a right to cure with respect to a prior Event of Default which occurred within three hundred skty-five (365) days of the present event of Default, Grantor shall not be entitled to receive the right to cure described in this paragraph.
- 20. RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default and at any time thereafter, Lender, at its option, may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

Accelerate Indebtedness. Lender shall have the right at its option to declare the entire Indebtedness immediately due and payable.

Mortgages in Possession. Lender shall have the right to be placed as mortgages in possession or to have a receiver appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding foreclosure or sale, and to collect the Rents from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, against the indebtedness. The mortgages in possession or receiver may serve without bond if permitted by law. Lender's right to the appointment of a receiver shall exist whether or not the apparent value of the Property exceeds the indebtedness by a substantial amount. Employment by Lender shall not disqualify a person from serving as a receiver.

Judicial Foreclosure. Lender may obtain a judicial decree foreclosing Grantor's interest in all or any part of the Property.

Deficiency Judgm . If permitted by applicable law, Lander may obtain a judgment for any deficiency remaining in the Indebtedness due to Lender after application of all amounts received from the exercise of the rights provided in this section.

Other Remedies. Land a shall have all other rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or the LOANLINER® Home Equity Plan Credit Agreement or available at least or in equity.

Sale of the Property. To the extent permitted by applicable law, Grantor hereby waives any and all right to have the property marshalled. In exarcising its rights and remedian, lender shall be free to self all or any part of the Property together or separately, in one sale or by separate sales, it ender shall be entitled to bid of any public sale on all or any portion of the Property.

Notice of Sale. Lender shall give Gir iter masonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Property or of the time after which any private sale or other intender disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least ten (10) days before the time of the self- or disposition.

Walver; Election of Remedies. A walver biy any nerty of a breach of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a warver of or prejudice the party's rights otherwise to demand strict constitute a with that provision or any other provision. Election by Lander to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Mortgage after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect Lerider's right to declare a default and exercise its remedies under this Mortgage.

- Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. If Lender institutes any multimaction to enforce any of the terms of this Mortgage, Lender shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as ett xmilys' fees at trial and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Lender that in Lender's prime in necessary at any time for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the Indebtedness payable or remaind and shall bear interest from the date of expenditure until repair at the Credit Agreement rate. Expenses covered by this paragraph include, without limitation, however subject to any limits under applicable law. Lender's altorneys' fees and legal expenses whether or not there is a lawsuit, including attorneys' fees for bankruptcy proceedings (including efforts to modify or vacate any automatic stuy or injunction), appear and any automatic stuy or injunction), appear and any automatic stuy or injunctions, survey its' reports, and appraisal fees, and little insurance, to the extent permitted by applicable law. Grantor also will pay any court costs, in addition to all oit at 5 ums provided by law.
- 21. NOTICES TO GRANTOR AND OTHER PARTIES. Any notice under this inorgane, including without limitation any notice of default and any notice of sale to Grantor, shall be in writing and shall be effective when actually delivered of, if mailed, shall be deemed effective when deposited in the United States mail first class, registered mail, postage prepaid, directed to the addresses show near the beginning of this Mortgage. Any party may change its address for notices under this Mortgage by giving formal written notice to the other party's address. All copies of notices or foreclosure from the holder of any lient which has priority over this Mortgage shall be sent to Lender's address, as shown near the beginning of this Mortgage. For notice purposes, Grantor agrees to keep center informed at all times of Grantor's current address.
- -22. ASSOCIATION OF UNIT OWNERS. The following provisions apply if the Real Property has bijen submitted to unit ownership law or similar law for the establishment of condominiums or cooperative ownership of the Real Property:

Power of Attorney. Grantor grants an irrevocable power of attorney to Lender to vote in its discrimination on any matter that may come before the association of unit owners. Lender shall have the right to exercise this power of attorney only lifer default by Grantor; however, Lender may cleating to exercise this power as if sees fit.

Insurance. The insurance as required above may be carried by the association of unit owners on Cramor's behalf, and the proceeds of such insurance may be paid to the association of unit owners for the purpose of repairing or reconstructing the Property. If not so used by the association, such proceeds shall be paid to Lender.

Compliance with Regulations of Association. Grantor shall perform all of the obligations imposed on Grantor by the declaration submitting the Real Property to unit ownership, by the bylaws of the association of unit owners, or by any rules or regulations their uniter. If Grantor's interest in the Real Property is a leasehold interest and such property has been submitted to unit ownership, Grantor shall perform all of the obligations imposed on Grantor by the lease of the Real Property from its owner.

23. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS. The following miscellaneous provisions are a part of this Mortgage:

Amendments. This Mortgage, logether with any Related Documents, constitutes the entire understanding and agreement. It is parties as to the matters set forth in this Mortgage. No alteration of or amendment to this Mortgage shall be effective unless given in writing and signed by the party or parties sought to be charged or bound by the alteration or amendment.

Applicable Law. This Mortgage shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois.

Caption Headings. Caption headings in this Mortgage are for convenience purposes only and are not to be used to interpret or define the provisions of this Mortgage.

Grantor's Copy of Documents. Lender agrees to provide Grantor with a conformed copy of both the LOANLINER® Home Equity Plan Crudit Agreement and this Mortgage at the time they are executed or within a reasonable time after this Mortgage is recorded.

Merger. There shall be no marger of the interest or estate created by this Mortgage with any other interest or estate in the Property of any time held by or for the benefit of Lender in any capacity, without the written consent of Lender.

Severability. If a court of competent jurisdiction finds any provision of this Mortgage to be invalid or unenforceable as to any person or circumstance, such finding shall not render that provision invalid or unenforceable as to any other persons or circumstances. If feesible, any such offending provision shall be deemed to be modified to be within the limits of enforceability or validity; however, if the offending provision cannot be so modified, it shall be stricken and all other provisions of this Mortgage in all other respects shall remain valid and enforceable.

Successors and Assigns. Subject to the limitations stated in this Mortgage on transfer of Grantor's interest, this Mortgage shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors and assigns. If ownership of the Property becomes vested in a person other than Grantor, Lender, without notice to Grantor, may deal with Grantor's successors with reference to this Mortgage and the Indebtedness by way of forbearance or extension without releasing Grantor from the obligations of this Mortgage or liability under the Indebtedness.

Time is of the Essence. Time is of the essence in the performance of this Morigage.

Walver of Homestead Exemption. Grantor hereby releases and waives all rights and benefits of the homestead exemption laws of the State of Illinois as to all Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage.

Walvers and Consents. Lender shall not be deemed to have waived any rights under this Mortgage (or under the Related Documents) unless such waiver is in writing and signed by Lender. No delay or omission on the part of Londer in exercising any right shall operate as a waiver of such right or any other right. A waiver by any party of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejuded the party is ught otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. No prior waiver by Lender, nor any course of directions. Whenever Lender and Grantor, shall constitute a waiver of any of Lender's rights or any of Crantor's obligations as to any future transactions.
