THE COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS REFERRED TO ON THE REVERSE SIDE OF THIS TRUST DEED:

- 1. Mortgagors shall (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any heildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become demaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said prevaless in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises experies to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Trustee or to holders of the note; (4) complete within a reasonable time any buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinances.
- 2. Mortgagors shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the promises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to Trustee or to holders of the note duplicate receipts therefor.
