- 3. PURPOSE. This Mortgage and the Obligations described herein are exact and incurred for BUSINESS purposes.
- 4. FUTURE ADVANCES. This Mortgage secures the repayment of all advances that Lender may extend to Borrower or Grantor under the promissory notes and other agreements evidencing the revolving credit loans described in palier enh 2. The Mortgage secures not only existing indebtedness, but also secures future advances, with inferest thereon, whether such advances are obtigation or to be made at the option of Lender to the comme extent as if such inture advances were made on the date of the execution of this Mortgage, and eithough this may be no indebtedness outstanding at the time any advance is made. Grantor shall not commit or permit such actions to be taken in the future. The term "Hazardous Materials" shall mean any hazardous waste toxic substances or any other substance, material, or waste which is or becomes regulated by any governmental authority including, but roll immediate, (ii) polychlorinated biphenyls; (iii) those substances materials or wastes designated in a hazardous substance pursuant to Section 311 of the Clean Water Act or listed pursuant to Section 307 of the Clean Water Act or any amendments or replacements to these statutes; (v) those substances, materials or wastes defined as a "hazardous waste" pursuant to Gection 1004 of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act or any amendments or replacements to that statute; and (vi) those substances, materials or wastes defined as a "hazardous substance" pursuant to Section 101 of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act, or any amendments or replacements to that statute or any other similar statute, rule, regulation or ordinance now or hereafter in effect;
 - (c) Grantor has the right and is duly authorized to execute and perform its Obligations under this Mortgage and these actions do not and shall not conflict with the provisions of any statute, regulation, ordinance, rule of law, contract or other agreement which may be binding on Grantor at any time.
 - (d) No action or proceeding is or shall be pending or threatened which might materially affect the Property;
 - (e) Grantor has not violated and shall not violate any statute, regulation, ordinance, rule of law, contract or other agreement which might materially affect the Property findluding, but not limited to, those governing Hazardous Materials) or Lender's rights or interest in the Property pursuant to this Mortgage.

- 9. INQUIRES AND NOTIFICATION FO THIRD PARTIES. Grantor hereby authorizes Lender to contact any third party and make any inquiry pertaining to Grantor's financial condition or the Property. In addition, Lender is authorized to provide oral or written notice of its interest in the Property to sny third party.

If Grantor receives at any time any written communication asserting a default by Grantor under an Agreement or purporting to terminate or cancel any Agreement, Grantor shall promptly forward a copy of such communication (and any subsequent communications relating thereto) to Larider.

12. USE AND MAINTENANCE OF PROPERTY. Grantor shall take all actions and make any repairs needed to maintain the Property in good condition. Grantor shall not commit or permit any waste to be committed with respect to the Property. Grantor shall use the Property solely in compliance with applicable law and insurance policies. Grantor shall not make any sherations, additions or improvements to the Property without Lender's prior written consent. Without limiting the foregoing, all alterations, additions and improvements made to the Property shall be subject to the interest belonging to Lender, shall not be removed without Lender's prior written consent, and shall be made at Grantor's sole expense.

13. LOSS OR DAMAGE. Grantor shall bear the entire risk of any loss, theft, destruction or damage (cumulatively "Loss or Damage") to the Property or any portion thereof from any case whatsoever. In the event of any Loss or Damage, Grantor shall, at the option of Lender, repair the affected Property to its previous condition or pay or cause to be paid to Lender the decrease in the fair market value of the affected Property.

14. INSURANCE. Grantor shalt keep the Property insured for its full value against all hazards including loss or damage caused by fire, collision, theft, food (if applicable) or other casualty. Grantor may obtain insurance on the Property from such companies as are acceptable to Lender in its sole discretion. The insurance policies shall require the insurance company to provide Lender with at least thirty (30) days' written notice before such policies are attered or cancelled in any manner. The insurance policies shall name Lender as a mortgagee and provide that no act or omission of Grantor or any other person shall affect the right of Lender to be paid the insurance proceeds pertaining to the loss or damage of the Property. At Lender's option, Lender may apply the insurance proceeds to the repair of the Property or require the Insurance proceeds to be paid to Lender. In the event Grantor fails to acquire or maintain insurance, Let Mer (after providing notice as may be required by law) may in its discretion procure appropriate insurance coverage upon the Property and the insurance cost shall be an advance payable and bearing interest as described in Paragraph 27 and secured hereby. Grantor shall furnish Lender with evidence of insurance indicating the required coverage. Lender may act as attorney-in-fact for Grantor in making and settling claims under insurance policies, cancelling any policy or endorsing Grantor's name on any draft or negotiable instrument drawn by any insurer. All such insurance policies shall be constantly assigned. Indeed, entirely to Lender for further securing the Obligations. In the event of loss, Grantor shall immediately give Lender and Grantor. Let on shall have the right, at its sole option, to apply such monies toward the Obligations or toward the cost of rebuilding and restoring the Property. Ally amount applied against the Obligations shall be applied in the inverse order of the due dates thereof. In any event Grantor shall be obligated to rebuild and restore the Property.

15. 18. CONDEMNATION. Grantor shall immediately privide Lender with written notice of any actual or threatened condemnation or emining to obtain proceeding pertaining to the Property. All monles payable to Grantor from such condemnation or taking are hereby assigned to Lender and shall be applied first to the payment of Lender's attorneys' fees, legaling proceeding appraisal fees) in connection with the condemnation or eminent domain proceedings and then, at the option of Lender's the payment of the Obligations or the restoration or repair of the Property. In any event Grantor shall be obligated to restore or repair the Property.

17. LENDER'S RIGHT TO COMMENCE OR DEFEND LEGAL ACT. DNS. Grantor shall immediately provide Lender with written notice of any actual or threatened action, suit, or other proceeding affecting the Property. Gruntor hereby appoints Lender as its attorney-in-fact to cummence, intervene in, and defend such actions, suits, or other legal proceedings and to compromise or as the any claim or controversy pertaining thereto. Lender shall not be liable to Grantor for any action, error, mistake, omission or delay pertaining to the actions described in this paragraph or any damages resulting therefrom. Nothing contained herein will prevent Lender from taking the actions described in this paragraph in its own name. Grantor shall cooperate and assist Lender in any action hereunder.

18. INDEMNIFICATION. Lender shall not assume or be responsible for the part amance of any of Grantor's Obligations with respect to the Property under any discurratances. Grantor shall immediately provide Lander and its charehot an, directors, officers, employees and agents with written notice of and indemnity and hold Lender harmless from all claims, damages, flabilities (including), stormeys' fees and legal expenses), causes of action, actions, suits and other legal proceedings (cumulatively 'Claims') pertaining to the Property (including), but not limited to, those involving Hazardous Materials), connection the request of Lender, shall hire legal counses acceptable to Lender to de roll Lender from such Claims, and pay the costs incurred in connection therewith. In the alternative, Lender shall be entitled to employ its own legal couns, to defend such Claims at Grantor's cost. Grantor's obligation to indemnify Lender shall survive the termination, release or foreclosure of this Mortga je.

19. TAXES AND ASSESSMENTS. Grantor shall pay all taxes and assessments relating to Full Property when due. Upon the request of Lender, Grantor shall deposit with Lender each month one-twelfth (1/12) of the estimated annual insurance premium, Fully and assessments pertaining to the Property as estimated by Lender. So long as there is no default, these amounts shall be applied to the payment of Lanes, assessments and insurance as required on the Property. In the event of default, Lender shall have the right, at its sole option, to apply the funds so likely to pay any taxes or against the Obligations. Any funds applied against the Obligations shall be applied in the reverse order of the due date thereof.

20. INSPECTION OF PROPERTY, BOOKS, RECORDS AND REPORTS. Addit onally, Grantor shall report, in a form satisfactory to Lender, such information as Lender may request regarding Grantor's financial condition of the Property. The information shall be for such periods, shall reflect Grantor's records at such time, and shall be rendered with such frequency is I ender may designifie. All information furnished by Grantor to Lender shall be true, accurate and complete in all respects.

21. ESTOPPEL CERTIFICATES. Within ten (10) days after any request by Lender, Grantor shall deliver to Lender, or any intended transferred of Lender's rights with respect to the Obligations, a signed and acknowledged statement specifying (a) the outstanding balance or the Obligations: and (b) whether Grantor possesses any claims, defenses, set-offs or counterclaims with respect to the Obligations and. If so, the nature of such claims, detenses, set-offs or counterclaims. Grantor will be conclusively bound by any representation that Lender may make to the intended transferse with respect to these matters in the event that Grantor fails to provide the requested statement in a timety manner.

22. DEFAULT. Grantor shall be in default under this Mortgage in the event that Grantor, Borrower or any guarantor of any Obligation.

(a) fails to pay any Obligation to Lender when due;

(b) fails to perform any Obligation or breaches any warranty or covenant to Lender contained in this Mortgage or any other present or future, written or oral, agreement:

 (c) allows the Property to be damaged, destroyed, lost or stolen in any material respect;
 (d) seeks to revoke, terminate or otherwise limit its liability under any guaranty to Lender;
 (e) allow goods to be used on, transported or stored on the Property, the possession, transported. esion, transportation, or use of which, is illegal; or

(f) causes Lender to deem itself insecure in good faith for any reason.

23. RIGHTS OF LENDER ON DEFAULT. If there is a default under this Mortgage, Lender shall be entitled to exercise one or more of the following es without notice or demand (except as required by law):

(a) to declare the Obligations immediately due and payable in full;(b) to collect the outstanding Obligations with or without resorting to judicial process;

(c) to require Grantor to deliver and make available to Lender any personal property constituting the Property at a place reasonably convenient to

Grantor and Lender; (d) to collect all of the rents, issues, and profits from the Property from the date of default and thereafter:

(e) to apply for and obtain the appointment of a receiver for the Property without regard to Grantor's financial condition (r solvency, the adequacy of the Property to secure the payment or performance of the Obligations, or the existence of any waste to the Property;
(f) to foreclose this Mortgage;
(g) to set-off Grantor's Obligations against any amounts due to Lender including, but not limited to, monies, instruments, and deposit accounts

maintained with Lender; and (h) to exercise all other rights available to Lender under any other written agreement or applicable law.

Lender's rights are cumulative and may be exercised together, separately, and in any order. In the event that Lender institutes an action seeking the recovery of any of the Property by way of a prejudgment remedy in an action against Grantor. Grantor walves the poeting of any bond which might otherwise be required.

 - 25. SATISFACTION. Upon the payment in full of the Obligations, this Mortgage shall be satisfied of record by Lender
- 26. APPLICATION OF FORECLOSURE PROCEEDS. - 36. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Mortgage violates the I'm of is unenforceable, the rest of the Mortgage shall continue to be valid and enforceable.
- 37. APPLICABLE LAW. This Moragage shall be governed by the laws of the ritate where the Property is located. Grantor consents to the jurisdiction and venue of any court located in such state.
