ORDER

This matter comes to be heard on the motion of the Petitioner-Appellee, CONNIE MARIE JONES, for clarification of this Court's order of June 18, 1992. The Appellee vigorously and persistently espouses the position that the Court's order is improper. The Court views the order as being totally fair, practical and serves the function of providing abundant security at no further cost to the parties. The Court does find that the request for clarification to be well taken and to that effect will enter the following order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that DEL JONES is to transfer his one-half interest in the real estate to the escrow account and that DEL JONES be enjoined from conveying, transferring or assigning his half interest in the real estate and that he is also enjoined from dissipating that property.

In the motion of CONNIE MARIE JONES for clarification, there is a request that because of "this Court's apparent willingness to circumvent the mandate of Rule 305," the Court should stay the enforcement of the judgment in favor of the Intervenors, waive bond and permit CONNIE MARIE JONES one-half interest in the escrow account to stand in lieu of a bond. The Intervenors have filed an objection to the motion.


