Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax hapteds or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest additional amount addition to tax, or assessable penalty together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto, shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The iten imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a accurity interest, mechanic's tranor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirenents of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary

(1) Place For Filing . The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed-

(A) Under State Laws

(I) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situtated, and

(ii) Personal Property-in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other government of aubdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated, except that State the merely conforming to reenacting Federal law establishing a national system does not constitute a second office for filling as designated by the taws of such State; or

(B) With Clark Of District Court-In the office of the clark of the United States district yours for the judicial district. In which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Ot Deeds Of The District Of Co-lumbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lion is altusted in the
