

Excerpts From internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable panalty (dowther with any costs that may accrus in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all prope and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to auch person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien mosed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so executed for a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unanforceable by reason of tapes of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The Hen Imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lisner, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.
