MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE IS DATED DECEMBER 4, 1992, between David C. Kroll and Nancy Kroll, his wife (f/k/a Nancy Pagano), whose address is 14517 South Tripp, Midiothian, IL 60448 (referred to below as "Grantor"); and First American Bank, whose address is 201 8. State Street, Hampehire, IL 60140 (referred to below as "Lender").

GRANT OF MORTGAGE. For valuable cone a station, Grantor mortgages, warrants, and conveys to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to the following described real property. Occiter with all existing or subsequently erected or attitude, improvements and fixtures; all essements, rights of way, and appurtenances; all ways, water rights, watercourses and ditch rights (including stock in utilities with ditch or impation rights); and all other rights, royalties, and profits relating to the real property, including without limitation all minerals, oil, gas, geothermal and similar matters, located in Cook County, State of limitation "Real Property"):

The Real Property or its address is commonly known at 14517 South Tripp, Midlothian, iL. 60445. The Real Property tax Identification number is 28-10-218-004.

Grantor presently assigns to Lender all of Grantor's right, titki, and interest in and a leases of the Property and all Rents from the Property. In addition, Grantor grants to Lender a Uniform Commercial Code security Interest in the Personal Property and Rents.

DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following meanings when used in this Morigage. Terms not otherwise defined in this Morigage shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Uniform Commercial Code. All reference, to voice amounts shall mean amounts in lawful money of the United States of America.

Existing Indebtedness. The words "Existing Indebtedness" mean the Indebtedness described below in the Existing Indebtedness section of this Mortgage.

Granfor. The word "Grantor" means David C. Kroll and Nancy Kroll. The Grantor is the mortgage runder this Mortgage.

Quarantor. The word "Guarantor" means and includes without limitation, each and all of the guarantor), sureties, and accommodation parties in connection with the indebtedness.

improvements. The word "improvements" means and includes without limitation all existing and future improvements, fixtures, buildings, structures, mobile homes affixed on the Real Property, facilities, additions and other construction on the Real Property.

indebtedness. The word "Indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under the Note and any amounts expended or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Grantor or expenses incurred by Lender to enforce obligations of Grantor under the Nortgage, logether with interest on such amounts as provided in this Mortgage. The Nen of this Mortgage shall not exceed at any one time \$6,500.00.

Londer. The word "Lender" means First American Bank, its successors and easigns. The Lander is the mortgages under this Mortgage.

Mortgage. The word "Mortgage" hears this Mortgage between Grantor and Lender, and includes without limitation all assignments and security interest provisions relating to the Personal Property and Rents.

Note. The word "Note" means the promissory note or credit agreement dated December 4, 1992, in the original principal amount of \$6,500.00 from Grantor to Lender, together with all renewals of, extensions of, modifications of, refinancings of, consolidations of, and substitutions for the promissory note or agreement. The interest rate on the Note is 8.490%. The Note is payable in 24 monthly payments of \$296.43. The maturity date of this Montgage is December 4, 1994.

Personal Property. The words "Pursonal Property" mean all equipment, flutures, and other articles of personal property now or hereafter extracted to the Real Property; together with all accessions, parts, and additions to, all replacements of, and all substitutions for, any of such property; and together with all proceeds (including without limitation all insurance proceeds and refunde of premiums) from any sale or other disposition of the Property.

Property. The word "Property" means collectively the Real Property and the Personal Property.

Real Property. The words "Real Property" mean the property, interests and rights described above in the "Grant of Mortgage" section.

Related Documents. The words "Related Documents" mean and include without firmitation all promiseory notes, credit agreements, loan agreements, guaranties, security agreements, mortgages, deeds of trust, and all other instruments, agreements and documents, whether now or hereafter existing, executed in connection with the indebtedness.

Rents. The word "Rents" means all present and future rents, revenues, income, lesues, royalties, profits, and other banefits derived from the

Property.

THIS MORTGAGE, INCLUDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND THE SECURITY INTEREST IN THE HENTS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY, IS GIVEN TO SECURE (1) PAYMENT OF THE INDESTIDUESS AND (2) PERFORMANCE OF ALL OBLIGATIONS OF GRANTOR UNDER THIS MORTGAGE AND THE RELATED DOCUMENTS. THIS MORTGAGE IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except an otherwise provided in this Mortgage, Grantor shall pay to Lender all amounts secured by this Mortgage as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grantor's obligations under this Mortgage.

POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that Grantor's possession and use of the Property shall be governed by the following provisions:

Possession and Use. Until in default, Grantor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the Rents from the Property.

Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in tenentable condition and promptly perform all repairs, replacements, and maintenance necessary to preserve its value.

Hazardous Substynoss. The terms "hazardous wrists," "hazardous substance," "disposal," "release," and "threatened release," as used in this Mortgage, shall have the same meanings as set forth in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, as amended, 42 U.S.C. Section 9801, et seq. ("CERCLA"), the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986, Pub. L. No. 99-499 ("SARA"), the Hazardo'ze Materiale Transportation Act, 49 U.S.C. Section 1801, et seq., the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, 49 U.S.C. Section 8901, et seq., of other applicable state or Federal laws, rules, or regulations adopted pursuant to any of the foregoing. The terms "hazardous waste" and "hazardous substance" shall also include, without limitation, petroleum and petroleum by-products or any fraction thereof and sebestos. Grantor represents and warrants to Lender that: (a) During the period of Grantor's ownership of the Property, there has been no use, generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release or threatened release of any hazardous waste or substance by any person on, under, or about the Property; (b) (argintor has no knowledge of, or reason to believe that there has been, except an previously disclosed to and acknowledged by Lender in writing, (i) any use, generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release, or threatened release of any hazardous waste or substance by any prior owners or occupants of the Property or (ii) any actual or threatened litigation or claims of any kind by any person relating to such matters; and (a) Floept as previously disclosed to and acknowledged by Lender in writing, (I) neither Grantor nor any tenant, contractor, agent or other authorized up and the Property shall use, generate, manufacture, store, treat, dispose of, or release any hazardous waste or substance on, under, or about the Property and (ii) any such activity shall be conducted in compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations and ordinances, including without limitation those laws, regulations, and ordinances described above. Grantor authorizes Lender and its agents to enter upon the Property to make such inspections and tests as Lender may deem appropriate to determine compliance of the Property with this section of the Mortgage. Any inspections or tests made by Lender shall be for Lender's purposes only and shall not be construed to create any responsibility on the part of Lender to Grantor or to any other person. The representations and warranties contained herein are based on Granior's due difference in Investigating the Property for hazardous waste. Grantor hereby (a) releases and waives any future claims against Londer for Indems by or contribution in the event Grantor becomes liable for cleanup or other coess under any such laws, and (b) agrees to indemnify and hold harmises conder against any and all claims, losses, liabilities, damages, penalties, and expenses which Lender may directly or indirectly sustain or suffer reacting from a breach of this section of the Mortgage or as a consequence of any use, generation, manufacture, storage, disposal, release or threat and release occurring prior to Grantor's ownership or interest in the Property, whether or not the same was or should have been known to @ant it. The provisions of this section of the Morigage, including the obligation to indemnify, shall survive the payment of the indebtedness and the earliection and reconveyance of the lien of this Mortgage and shall not be affected by Lender's acquisition of any interest in the Property, whether by fractionare or otherwise.

Nulsance, Waste. Gramor shall not cause, conduct or permit any nulsance nor com nit, permit, or suffer any stripping of or waste on or to the Property or any portion of the Property. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing. Grantor will not remove, or grant to any other perty the right to remove, any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), soil, gravel or rock products with any time prior written consent of Lender.

Removal of Improvements. Grantor shall not demolish or remove any Improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Lender. As a condition to the removal of any Improvements, Lender may require Grantor to make arrangements satisfactory to Lender to replace such improvements with improvements of at least equal value.

Lender's Right to Enter. Lender and its agents and representatives may enter upon the Real Property at all reasonable times to atlend to Lender's Interests and to inspect the Property for purposes of Grantor's compliance with the terms and concition of this Morigage.

Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations, now or hereafter in effect, of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may context in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Lender in writing prior to doing so and so long as, in Lender's sole opinion, Lender's interests in the Property are not jeopardisso. Lender may require Grantor to post adequate security or a surety bond, reasonably satisfactory to Lender, to protect Lender's interest.

Duty to Protect. Grantor agrees neither to abandon nor leave unattended the Property. Grantor shall do all other acts, in addition to those acts set forth above in this section, which from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the Property.

DUE ON SALE - CONSENT BY LENDER. Lender may, at its option, declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this Mortgage upon the sale or transfer, without the Lender's prior written consent, of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest in the Real Property. A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of Real Property or any right, title or interest therein; whether legal or equitable; whether voluntary or involuntary; whether by outright sale, deed, installment sale contract, tand contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three (3) years, lease-option contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer of any beneficial interest in or to any land trust holding title to the Real Property, or by any other method of conveyance of Real Property Interest. If any Grantor is a corporation or partnership, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than twenty-five percent (25%) of the voting stock or partnership interests, as the case may be, of Grantor. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender II such exercise is prohibited by federal law or by illinois law.

TAXES AND LIENS. The following provisions relating to the taxes and liens on the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Payment. Grantor shall pay when due (and in all events prior to delinquency) all taxes, payroll taxes, special taxes, assessments, water charges and sewer service charges levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of all fiens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, except for the Edsting indebtedness referred to below, and except as otherwise provided in the following paragraph.

Right To Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith disputs over the obligation to pay, so long as Lender's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. If a lien arises or is filed as a result of nonpayment, Grantor shall within fifteen (15) days after the lien arises or, if a lien is filed, within fifteen (15) days after Grantor has notice of the filing, secure the discharge of the lien, or if requested by Lender, deposit with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Lender in an amount sufficient

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to discharge the iten plus any costs and attorneys' less or other charges that could accrue as a result of a foreclosure or sale under the iten. In any contest, Grantor shall defend itself and Lender and shall satisfy any adverse judgment before enforcement against the Property. Grantor shall name Lender as an additional obliges under any surety bond furnished in the contest processings.

Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Lender satisfactory evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate governmental official to deliver to Lender at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Lender at least titleen (15) days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property, if any mechanic's lien, materialmen's lien, or other lien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials and the cost exceeds \$5,000.00. Grantor will upon request of Lender furnish to Lender advance assurances satisfactory to Lender that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Maintenance of insurance. Grentor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable valus covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to evoid application of any colorurance clause and with a standard mortgages clause in favor of Lender. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reproposely incorptable to Lender. Grantor shall deliver to Lender certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lender and not containing any disclaimer of the insurer's liability for failure to give such notice. Should the Real Property at any time become located in an area designated by the Director of the insurance. Emergency Management Agency as a special flood hazard area, Grantor agrees to obtain and maintain Federal Flood Insurance, to the sales, such insurance is required and is or becomes available, for the term of the loan and for the full unpaid principal balance of the loan, or the major minut of coverage that is available, whichever is less.

Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Lender of any lous or damage to the Property if the estimated cost of repair or replacement exceeds \$1,000.00. Lender may make proof of loss if Grantor fails to do so within fifteen (15) days of the casualty. Whether or not Lender's security is impaired, Lender may, mit its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness, payment of any lien effecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of its Property. If Lender elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the demaged or destroyed improvements in a manner satisfactory to Lender. Lender shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimburse Grantor from the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been disbursed within 180 days after their receipt and which Lender has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used first to pay any amount owing to Lender under this Mortgage, then to prepay accrued interest, and the remainder, if any, shall be applied to the principal balance of the indebtedness. It would have proceeds after payment in full of the indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Grantor.

Unexpired insurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall inurging the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Mortgage at any trustee's sale or other sale held under the proviet he of this Mortgage, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property.

Compliance with Existing Indebtedness. During the period in which are Existing Indebtedness described below is in effect, compliance with the insurance provisions contained in the instrument evidencing such Existing indebtedness shall constitute compliance with the insurance provisions under this Morigage, to the electric compliance with the terms of this Morigage, would constitute a duplication of insurance requirement. If any proceeds from the insurance tecomis payable on loss, the provisions in this fluid sign for division of proceeds shall apply only to that portion of the proceeds not payable to the holder of the Existing Indebtedness.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Grantor falls to comply with any provision of this Mortgage, including any obligation to maintain Existing Indebtedness in good standing as required below, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interests in the Property, Lender on Grantor's behalf may, but shall not be required to, take any action that Lender deems appropriate. Any amount that Lender expends in so doing will bear interest at the rate charged under the Note from the date incurred or paid by Lender to the Catz of repayment by Grantor. All such expenses, at Lender's option, will (a) be payable on demand, (b) be added to the balance of the Note and he exportioned among and be payable with any installment payments to become due during either (i) the term of any applicable insurance policy or (i) the remaining term of the Note, or (c) be treated as a balloon payment which will be due and payable at the Note's maturity. This Mortgage also will encure payment of these amounts. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any namedies to which Lender shall not be construed as curing the default to as to ber Lender from any namedy that i otherwise would have had.

WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE. The following provisions relating to ownership of the Property are a part of this more great.

Title. Grantor warrants that: (a) Grantor holds good and marketable title of report to the Property In tes simple, fire and close of all tiens and encumbrances other than those set forth in the Real Property description or in the Existing Indebtedness section be owner in any title insurance policy, title report, or final title opinion issued in tavor of, and accepted by, Lender in connection with this Mortgage, and (b) Grantor has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Mortgage to Lender.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the lawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of Lender's own choice, and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as Lender may request from time to time to participation.

Compliance With Laws. Grantor warrants that the Property and Grantor's use of the Property complies with all existing applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations of governmental authorities.

EXISTING INDESTEDNESS. The following provisions concerning existing indebteciness (the "Existing Indebtedness") are a part of this Mortgage.

Existing Lien. The lien of this Mortgage securing the Indebtedness may be sucondary and inferior to the lien securing payment of an existing obligation with an account number of 311175295 to Mid America FSB described as: Mortgage loan dated 10-15-91 and recorded 11-01-91 as document 91571945. The existing obligation has a current principal balance of approximately \$81,900,00 and is in the original principal amount of \$82,500.00. The obligation has the following payment terms: monthly installments of principal and interest. Grantor expressly covenants and agrees to pay, or see to the payment of, the Existing Indebtedness and to prevent any default on such indebtedness, any default under the instruments evidencing such indebtedness, or any default under any security documents for such indebtedness.

Default. If the payment of any installment of principal or any interest on the Existing indebtedness is not made within the time required by the note evidencing such indebtedness, or should a default occur under the instrument securing such indebtedness and not be cured during any applicable grace period therein, then, at the option of Lender, the indebtedness secured by this Mortgage shall become immediately due and payable, and this Mortgage shall be in default.

No Modification. Grantor shall not enter imp any agreement with the holder of any mortgage, deed of trust, or other security agreement which has priority over this Mortgage by which that agreement is modified, amended, extended, or renewed without the prior written consent of Lender.

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Grantor shall neither request nor accept any future advances under any such security agreement without the prior written consent of Lender.

CONDEMNATION. The following provisions relating to constemnation of the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Application of Net Proceeds. It all or any part of the Property is condemned by eminent domain proceedings or by any proceeding or purchase in fieu of condemnation, Lender may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the indebtedness or the repair or restoration of the Property. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees incurred by Lender in connection with the condemnation.

Proceedings. If any proceeding in condemnation is filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Lender in writing, and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver or cause to be delivered to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such participation.

IMPOSITION OF TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES BY GOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITIES. The following provisions relating to governmental taxes, fees and charges are a part of this Mortgage:

Current Taxes, Fees and Charges. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute such documents in addition to this Mortgage and take whatever other artion is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's lien on the Real Property. Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all taxes, as described below, together with all expenses incurred in recording, perfecting or continuing this Mortgage, including without limitation all taxes, fees, documentary stamps, and other charges for recording or registering this Mortgage.

Taxes. The following this constitute taxes to which this section applies: (a) a specific tax upon this type of Mortgage or upon all or any part of the Indebtedness secures, by this Mortgage; (b) is specific tax on Grantor which Grantor is authorized or required to deduct from payments on the Indebtedness secured by this type of Mortgage; (c) a tax on this type of Mortgage chargeable against the Lender or the holder of the Note; and (d) a specific tax on all or any porton of the indebtedness or on payments of principal and interest made by Grantor.

Subsequent Taxes. If any tax to which this section applies is enacted subsequent to the date of this Morigage, this event shall have the same effect as an Event of Default (as defined below), and Lender may exercise any or all of its available remedies for an Event of Default as provided below unless Grantor either. (a) pays the tax before it becomes delinquent, or (b) contests the tax as provided above in the Taxes and Liens section and deposits with Lender cash or a whicken corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Lender.

SECURITY AGREEMENT; FINANCING STATEMENT IS. The following provisions relating to this Mortgage as a security agreement are a part of this Mortgage.

Security Agreement. This instrument shall constitute a country agreement to the extent any of the Property constitutes fixtures or other personal property, and Lender shall have all of the rights of a security under the Uniform Commercial Code as amended from time to time.

Security interest. Upon request by Lender, Granior shall exhaust financing statements and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's security interest in the Rents and Personal Property. In addition to recording this Mortgage in the real property records, Lender may, at any time and without further authorization from Grantor, file executed counterparts, copies or reproductions of this Mortgage as a financing statement. Grantor shall reimbures Lender to all expenses incurred in perfecting or continuing this security interest. Upon default, Grantor shall essemble the Personal Property in a manner and a place reasonably convenient to Grantor and Lender and make it available to Lender within three (3) days after receipt of written demand from Let der.

Addresses. The mailing addresses of Grantor (debtor) and Londer (secure (party), from which information concerning the security interest granted by the Mortgage may be obtained (each an required by the Uniform Commercial Code), are se stated on the first page of this Mortgage.

FURTHER ASSURANCES; ATTORNEY-IN-FACT. The following provisions relating to unthe resurances and attorney-in-fact are a part of this Mortgage.

Further Assurances. At any time, and from time to time, upon request of Lender, Granic will make, execute and deliver, or will cause to be made, executed or delivered, to Lender's designee, and when requested by Unider, cause to be filed, recorded, reflied, or rerecorded, as the case may be, at such times and in such offices and places as Lender may drem appropriate, any and all such mortgages, deeds of trust, security deeds, security agreements, financing statements, continuation statements, instruments of further assurance, certificates, and other documents as may, in the sole opinion of Lender, be necessary or desirable in order to effectuate, complete, perfect, continua, or preserve. (a) the obligations of Grantor under the Note, this Mortgage, and the Related Documents, and. (b) the liens and security interests created by this Mortgage on the Property, whether now owned or hereafter acquired by Grantor. Unless and the matters referred to in this paragraph.

Attorney-in-Fact. If Grantor falls to do any of the things referred to in the preceding paragraph, Lender may do no by and in the name of Grantor and at Grantor's expense. For such purposes, Grantor hereby irrevocably appoints Lender as Grantor's attorney-in-fact for the purpose of making, executing, delivering, filing, recording, and doing all other things as may be necessary or desirable, in Lender's sole opinion, to accomplish the matters referred to in the preceding paragraph.

FULL PERFORMANCE. If Grantor pays all the indebtedness when due, and otherwise performs all the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Mortgage, Lender shall execute and deliver to Grantor a suitable satisfaction of this Mortgage and suitable statements of termination of any financing statement on file evidencing Lender's security interest in the Rents and the Personal Property. Grantor will pay, if permitted by applicable law, any reasonable termination fee as determined by Lender from time to time.

DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lender, shall constitute an event of default ("Event of Default") under this Mortgage:

Default on Indebtedness. Failure of Grantor to make any payment when due on the Indebtedness.

Default on Other Payments. Failure of Grantor within the time required by this Mortgage to make any payment for taxas or insurance, or any other payment necessary to prevent filing of or to effect discharge of any lien.

Compilance Default. Fallure to comply with any other term, obligation, covernant or condition contained in this Mortgage, the Note or in any of the Related Documents. If such a fallure is curable and if Grantor has not been given a notice of a breach of the same provision of this Mortgage within the preceding twelve (12) months, it may be cured (and no Event of Default will have occurred) if Grantor, after Lender sends written notice demanding cure of such failure: (a) cures the failure within lifteen (15) days; or (b) if the cure requires more than lifteen (15) days, immediately initiates steps sufficient to cure the failure and thereafter continues and completes all reasonable and necessary steps sufficient to produce compliance as soon as reasonably practical.

Breaches. Any warranty, representation or statement made or furnished to Lender by or on behalf of Grantor under this Morigage, the Note or the Related Documents is, or at the time made or furnished was, false in any material respect.

Insolvency. The Insolvency of Grantor, appointment of a receiver for any part of Grantor's property, any assignment for the benefit of craditors,

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the commencement of any proceeding under any bankruptcy or insolvency laws by or against Grantor, or the dissolution or termination of Grantor's existence as a going business (if Grantor is a business). Except to the extent prohibited by federal law or litinois law, the death of Grantor is an individual) also shall constitute an Event of Default under this Mortgage.

Foreologues, Forfeiture, etc. Commencement of foreologues or forfeiture proceedings, whether by judicial proceeding, self-help, represented or any other method, by any creditor of Grantor or by any governmental agency against any of the Property. Existing Indebtedness. A default shall occur under any Existing Indebtedness or under any instrument on the Property securing any Existing Indebtedness, or commencement of any suit or other action to foreclass any existing lien on the Property.

Events Affecting Quarantor. Any of the preceding events occurs with respect to any Quarantor of any of the indebtedness or such Quarantor dies or becomes incompetent. Lender, at its option, may, but shall not be required to, permit the Quarantor's estate to sesume unconditionally the obligations arising under the guaranty in a manner satisfactory to Lender, and, its doing so, ours the Event of Dafault.

RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON CAPAULT. Upon the cocurrence of any Event of Default and at any time thereafter, Lender, at its option, may exercise any one or more of the following digits and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

Accelerate Indebtedness. Lender, shall have the right at its option without notice to Grantor to declare the entire Indebtedness immediately due and payable, including any prepayment penalty which Grantor would be required to pay.

UCC Remedies. With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property, Lender shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code.

Collect Rents. Lender shall have the right, without motion to Grantor, to take possession of the Property and collect the Rents, including amounts past due and unpaid, and apply the net proceeds, over and above Lender's costs, against the indebtedness. In furtherance of this right, Lender may require any tenant or other user of the Property to make payments of rent or use fees directly to Lender. Payments by tenants or other users to Lender in response to Lender demand shall satisfy the obligations for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper grounds for the demand existed. Lender may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

Mortgages in Possession. Lender shall have the right to be placed as mortgages in possession or to have a receiver appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding foreclosure or sale, and to collect the Rents from the Property and apply the processes, were and above the cost of the receivership, against the indebtedness. The mortgages in possession or receiver may serve without bond if permitted by law. Lender's right to the appointment of a receiver shall extens whether or not the apparent value of the Property exceeds the indebtedness by a substantial amount. Employment by Lender shall not disquality a person from serving as a receiver.

Judicial Foreclosure. Lender may obtain a judicial decree foreclosing Grantor's interest in all or any part of the Property.

Deficiency Judgment. If permitted by applicable law, Lender may obtain a judgment for eny deficiency remaining in the indebtedness due to Lender after application of all amounts received from the exercise of the rights provided in this leading.

Other Remodies. Lender shall have all other rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or the More or available at law or in equity.

Election by Lender to purche any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Mortgage after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect Lender's right to declare a default and exercise its remedies under this Mortgage.

Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. It Lander institutes any suit or action to enforce any of the terms of this Mortgage, Lender shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees, at trial and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Lender that in Lender's opinion are necessary at any time for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the indebtedness payable on demand and shall bear interest from the date of expenditure until repaid at the Note rate. Expenses covered by this paragraph include, without limitation, however subject to any limits under applicable law, Lender's attorneys' fees and Lender's legal expenses whether or not there is a lawsuit, including attorneys' fees for bankruptoy proceedings (including efforts to modify or vacate any automatic stay or injunction), appeals and any anticipated post-judgment collection services, the cost of searching records, obtaining title reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyors' reports, and appraisal feve, and title insurance, to the extent permitted by applicable law. Subject to the limitations and in this Mortgage on transfer of Grantor's Interest, this Mortgage shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors and assigns. If ownership of the Property becomes vested in a person other than Grantor, Lender, without notice to Grantor, may deal with Grantor, resuccessors with reference to this Mortgage and the Indebtedness by way of forbearance or extension without releasing Grantor from the or ligations of this Mortgage or liability under the indebtedness.

Walver of Homestead Exemption. Grantor hereby recesses and walves all rights and benefits of the homestead exemption laws of the State of Illinois as to all indebtedness secured by this Mortgage.

No divisy or omission on the property of Lender in exercising any right shall operate as a waiver of such right or any other right. A waiver by any party of a provision of the Mortgage Shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's right otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. No prior valver by Lender, nor any ocurse of dealing between Lender and Gramfor, shall constitute a waiver of any of Lender's rights or any of Grat for's obligations as to any future transactions.
