Together with and including all buildings, all fixtures including but not limited to all plumbing, heating, lighting, ventilating, refrigerating, inclnerating, air conditioning reparatus and elevators (the sortgagor hereby declaring that it is intended that the items hereing enumerated wheth de deemed to have been permanently installed as part of the realty) and all improvements now or hereafter existing thereon; the hereditaments and appurtenances and all other rights thereunto belonging, or in anywise apperializing, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, all rights of redemption, and the rents, is wes and profits of the above described property (provided, however, that the mortgagor shall be entitled to the present of said property and to collect, and retain the rents, issues and profits until default hereunder). To have and to hold the same unto the mortgages and the succesors in interest of the mortgages in fee simple or such other estate, if any, as is stated herein.

The mortgagor hereby releases and waives all rights under and by virtue of the homestead exemption laws of the State of Illinois.

The mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully seized and possessed of and has the right to well and convey said property, that the same is free from all encumbrances except as hereinabove recited; and that he hereby binds himself and his successors in interest to warrant and defend the title aforesaid thereto and every part thereof against the claims of all persons whomsoever.

STYLER-SOPKO in behalf of PLAZA BANK, and (ii) the repayment of any future advance, with interest thereon, made by mortgagee prior to release of this mortgage, which advance is evidenced by a promissory note or guaranty of a promissory

note stating that it is secured horsely. Said notes and/or quaranties are herein called the "Indebtedness Hereby Secured". At no time shall the principal amount of the indebtedness hereby secured, not including the same advanced in accordance herewith to protect the security of this Hortgage, exceed the original amount of the Note, glus One Hillion 181,000,000,000 Bollars.

- 1. The mortgagor covenante and agrees as follows:
 - a. He will promptly pay the indebtedness hereby secured.
- b. He will pay all taxes, assumments, water raths and other governmental or municipal charges, fines, or impositions, for which provision has not been made horoinbeform, and will promptly deliver the official receipts thereion to the mortgages.
- c. He will per such expenses and fees as any be incurred in the protection and maintenance of said property, including the fees of any attorney employed by the sortgages for the collection of any or all of the indebtedness needby securous, or foreclosure by mortgages's sale, or court proceedings, or in any other litigation or proceeding affecting said property. Attorneys' fees reasonably incurred in any other way shall also be paid by the mortgages.
- d. For better security of the indebtedness hereby secures, upon the request of the sortgages, its successors or assigns, he shall exects and deliver a supplemental mortgage or mortgages covering any additions, improvements, or betterments and to the property herebrahove described and all property acquired by him after the date hereof (all in form satisfictors to mortgages). Furthermore, should mortgager fail to cure any default in the payment of a prior or infertor encumbrance on the property described by this instrument, mortgager hereby agrees to permit mortgages to cure ruch default, but nortgages is not obligated to do so; and such advances shall become part of the indebtedness secured by this instrument, subject to the same terms and conditions.
- e. The rights created by this conveyance shall reasin in full force and effect during any postponement or extension of the time of the payment of the indebtedness hereby secured.
- f. He will continuously maintain hazard insurance, of such type or types and in such assumts as the mortgages may from time to time require on the improvements now or hereaffer on eald property, and will pay promptly when due any premiums thereof. All insurance shall be carried in competites acceptable to mortgages and the policies and remember thereof shall be held by mortgages and have attached the mto lose payable clauses in favor of and in form acceptable to the mortgages. In event of lose, mortgager will give lamediate notice in writing to mortgages, and mortgages may make proof of lose if not made promptly by mortgager, and each insurance company concerned is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for such lose directly to mortgages instead of mortgager and mortgages jointly, and the insurance proceeds, or any part thereof, may be applied by mortgages at its option either to the reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured or to the restoration or repair of the property damaged or destroyed. In event of foreclosure of this mortgage, or other transfer of title to said property in extinguishment of the indebtedness hereby secured, all right, title and interest of the mortgager in and to any insurance policies then in force shall pass to the purchaser or mortgages or, at the option of the sortgages, may he surrendered for a refund.
- g. He will keep all buildings and other improvements on said property in good repair and condition; will permit, commit or suffer no waste, impairment, deterioration of said property or any part thereof; in the event of failure of the mortgagor to keep the buildings on said premises and those precised on said premises, or improvements thereon, in good repair, the mortgagen may make such repairs as in its discretion it may deem necessary for the proper preservation thereof; and the full amount of each and every payment shall be immediately due and payable; and shall be secured by the lien of this mortgage.

- h. He will not voluntarily create or permit to be created against the property subject to this mortgage any lien or liens interior or superior to the lien of this mortgage without the written consent of the mortgages; and further, that he will keep and maintain the same free from the claim of all persons supplying labor or materials for construction of any and all buildings or improvements now being erected or to be orected on said premises.
- i. He will not rent or assign any part of the rent of said mortgaged property or demolish, or remove, or substantially alter any building without the written consent of the sortgages.
- j. All awards of damages in connection with any condemnation for public use of or injury to any of the property subject to this mortgage are horeby assigned and shall be paid to mortgagee, who may apply the same to payment of the installments last due under said note, and mortgagee is hereby authorized, in the name of the mortgager, to execute and deliver valid acquittances thereof and to appeal from any such award.
 - k. The mortgager shall have the right to inspect the mortgaged premises at any reasonable time.
- I. He has not used hazardous materials, including, without limitation, any flammable explosives, radioactive materials, hazardous materials, hazardous waster, hazardous or toxic substances or related materials defined in any federal, state or local quovernmental haw, ordinance, rule or regulation, on, from or affecting the premises in any marner which violates federal, state or local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations or policies governing the use, storage, treatment, transportation, manufacture, refinement, handling, production or disposal of hazardous saterials and that, to the best of his knowledge, no prior owner of the premises or any tenant, subtenant, occupant, prior tenant, prior subtenant or prior occupant has used hazardous materials on, from or affecting the precises in any manner which violates federal, state or local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations or policies occupant the use, storage, treatment, transportation, manufacture, refinement, handling, production or disposal of hazardous materials.
- a. He has never received any notice of any violations of federal, state or local laws, ordinances, rules, regulations or policies governing the use, storage, treateon; transportation, manufacture, rufinement, handling, production or disposal of hazardous materials and, to the best of his knowledge, there have been no actions commenced or threatened by any party for noncompliance.
- n. He shall deliver to mortgages the Disclosure Document in according with Section 4 of the Illineia Responsible Property Transfer Act (hereinafter called "Act") on or before the date Lereof, if required to do so under the Act.
- o. He shall keep or cause the premises to be kept free of hazardous material, and, without limiting the foregoing, he shall not cause or permit the premises to be used to generate, amplicative, rufine, transport, treat, store, handle, dispose of, transfer, produce or process hazardous materials, except in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations, nor shall be cause or porail, as a result of any intentional or unintentional act or paission on his part, or on the part of any tenant, subtenant or occupant, a release of hazardous materials onto the premises or unto any other property.
 - p. He shall:
- (1) conduct and complete all investigations, studies, sampling and testing, and all reasolut, removal and other actions necessary to clean up and remove all hazardous materials, on, under, from or affecting the premises in accordance with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances, rules, requiations and policies, to the reasonable satisfaction of mortgages, and in accordance with the orders and directives of all federal, state and local governmental authorities; and
- (2) defend, indeanify and hold harmless sortgages, its saployees, agents, officers and directors, from and against any claims, demands, penalties, fines, liabilities, settlements, damages, cost or exponses of

whatever kind or nature, known or unknown, contingent or otherwise, arising out of, or in any way related to:
(A) the presence, disposal, release or threatened release of any hazardous meterials on, over, under, from, or
affecting the presises or the soil, water, vegetation, buildings, personal property; persons or animals
thereon; (B) any personal injury (including prompful death) or property damage (real or personal) arising out
of or related to such basardous materials; (C) any lawsuit brought or threatened, settlement reached or
government order relating to such hazardous materials; and/or (C) any violation of laws, orders, regulations,
requirements or demands of government authorities, or any policies or requirements of mortgages, which are
based upon or in any way related to such hazardous materials including, without limitation, reasonable
attorneys' and consultants' fees, investigation and laboratory fees, court costs and litigation expense.

- 2. Default in any of the movements or conditions of this instrument or of the note or loan agreement socured hereby shall terminate the mortgagor's right to possession, use and unjoyaunt of the property, at the option of the mortgagor or his assigns tit being agreed that the mortgagor shall have such right until default. Upon any such default, the mortgagor shall become the owner of all of the rents and profits accruing after default as security for the incentedness secured hereby, with the right to enter upon said property for the purpose of collecting such remission profits. This instrument shall operate as an assignment of any rentals on said property to that extent.
- 3. The sortgagor covenants and agrees that if he shall fall to pay the indebtedness bereby secured of any part thereof when due, or shall fall to perform any covenant or accessent of this instrument or any note or quaranty secured hereby, the entire indebtedness hereby secured shall insediately become due, payable and collectible without notice, at the opt on of the sortgages or assigns, regardless of the saturity, and the sortgages or his assigns say before or arrar entry sell said property without appraisement (the sortgages having maived and assigned to the sortgages all rights of appraisement pursuant to the laws of the State of Illinois governing the disposition of said property.
- 4. The proceeds of any sale of said property in accordance with the preceding paragraph shall be applied first to pay the costs and expenses of said sale, the expenses incurred by the mortgages for the purpose of protecting and maintaining said property, and reasonable attermays' fees; secondly, to pay the indebtedness hereby secured; and thirdly, to pay any surplus or excess to the persons-legality entitled thereto.
- 5. In the event said property is sold at a judicial foreclosure sale, and the proceeds are not sufficient to pay the indebtedness hereby secured, the mortgages will be untitled to a deficiency judgment for the amount of the deficiency without regard to appraisement.

In the event the mortgagor fails to pay any federal, state or local tax assessment, income tax or other tax lien, charge, fee or other expense charged against the property, the mortgagee is hereby suthorized at his option to pay the same.
