

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects of refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty together with any costs that may accrue in addition therate) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all properly and rights to property, whather real or personal, belonging to

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessthen is made and shell-continue until the liability for the amount so exceeded for a judgment against the text payer arising out of such liability transitistics or becomes unemores. able by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And

Judgment Lien Creditors.—The ilen Imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanics lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (I) has been filed by the Secretary.

O Place For Filling Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subection (a) shall be filed.
