

SUBORDINATION AGREEMENT

THIS SUBORDINATION AGREEMENT, made in the City of Chicago, State of Illinois this 22nd day of December, 1992 by The First National Bank of Chicago, a national banking association organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Unites States of America, and doing business and having its principal office in the City of Chicago, County of Cook, and State of Illinois ("Bank").

HIMNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Bank is the owner of a mortgage dated November 13, 1991 and recorded November 25, 1991 among the land records in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County, Illinois as Document Number LR4013522 made by Octavio C. Perdomo and Olga Perdomo, his wife ("Borrowers"), to secure an indebtedness of \$ 200,000.00 ("Mortgage"); and

WHEREAS, Borrowers are the owners of that certain parcel of real estate commonly known as 6619 Navajo -- Lincolnwood, IL 60646 and more specifically described as follows:

PIN#10-33-409-009-0000 and 10-32-409-026-0000; and

WHEREAS, First National Bank of Chicago, its successors and/or assigns ("Mortgagee") has refused to make a loan to the Borrowers of \$ 40,000.00, except upon condition that the Mortgage be subordinate to said mortgage lien of Mortgagee.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars in hand paid by each of the parties lereto to the other, and of other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged and in order to induce Mortgagee to make the loan to Borrowers, it is hereby mutually agreed, as follows:

- That the Bank covenants and consents that the lien of its Mortgage shall be subject and subordinate to the lien of Mortgagee's mortgage dated reflecting and securing the loan made by Mortgagee to Borrowers, in the amount of Forty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars, and to all renewals, extensions or replacements of said mortgage; and
- II. That this Agreement shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.
