

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees of the Village of Hill-side. Cook County, Illinois, after due investigation and consideration, has determined that the nature and extent of the public use and the public interest to be subserved is such as to warrant the vacation of part of a certain public alley described in the following Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, said alley has never been used as a public alicy:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HILLSIDE, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, that:

SECTION 1: All that part of the Easterly and Westerly 16 foot alley in Hillside Gradens Subdivision, being a subdivision of that part lying South of the Southerly line of the right of way of Chicago, Aurora and Elgin Failroad Company of the West half of the Southwest quarter. South of Indian Boundary Line, of Section 9, Township 39 North, Range 12, East of the Third Principal Meridian. lying Southerly of the South rl line of Lot 30. and East of the East line of Wolf Road and West of the Southerl extension of the East line of Lot 304, together with that part o the North and South 16 foot alley in said Hillside Gardens Sut division lying South of a line 24 feet South of and parallel wit the South line of Lot 250 in said Hillside Garden Subdivision in Cook County, Illinois, indicated by the words "AREA HEREBY VACATED" on the Plat of Vacation hereto attached marked Exhibit "A", which plat for greater certainty, is hereby made a part of this Ordinance, be and the same is hereby vacated and closed in

as much as the same is no longer required to public use and the public interest will be served by such vacation.

SECTION 2: There is hereby reserved to the Village of Hillside and to the public service utility companies, such public service facilities as are now located in the public alley hereby vacated.

SECTION 3: There is hereby reserved to the Village of Hillside, the Illinois Bell Telephone Company, the Northern Illinois Gas Company, the Commonwealth Edison Company, and to all Public Service Companies, such public rights of way and easements as are necessary and desirable for continuing public services, and for the use, inspection, maintenance, renewal construction or removal of public service facilities on, under and above the public alley hereby vacated.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force and effect from and after its passage and approval, provided that within thirty (30) days after its passage and approval, the Village Clerk of the Village of Hillside shall file or cause to be filed for record in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County, Illinois, a certified copy of this Ordinance properly executed and acknowledged, together with the plat attached hereto, showing the vacation provided for herein.
