THIS INDENTURE, Made December 13, 1990, between American National Bank and Trust Company of Chicago, not personally but as Trustee under the provisions of a Deed or Deeds in trust duly recorded and delivered to said Company in pursuance of a Trust Agreement dated December 12, 1990 and known as trust number 113130-04, herein referred to as "First Party," and Michael Supera

herein referred to as TRUSTEE, witnesseth: THAT, WHEREAS First Party has concurrently herewith executed an instalment note bearing even date herewith in the Principal Sum of Two Hundred Sixty Thousand and no/100 ***** (\$260,000.00)****Dollars, made payable to BEARER and delivered, in and by which said Note the First Party promises to pay out of that portion of the trust estate subject to said Trust Agreement and hereinafter specifically described, the said principal sum in instalments as follows: Two Hundred Sixty Thousand and no/100 ***** (\$260,000.00) DOLLARS

on the _____ of _____ 19____, and _____ Dollars on the _____ day of _____ 19____, with a final payment of the balance due on the 30th day of January 1991, with interest on the principal balance

from time to time unpaid at the rate of ten (10%) per cent per annum payable on January 30, 1991; each of said instalments of principal bearing interest after maturity at the rate of seven per cent per annum, and all of said principal and interest being made payable at such banking house or trust company in Chicago, Illinois

Illinois, as the holders of the note may, from time to time, in writing appoint, and in absence of such appointment, then at the office of Michael Supera 2001 N. Halsted in said City.

NOW, THEREFORE, First Party to secure the payment of the said principal sum of money and said interest in accordance with the terms, provisions and limitations of this trust deed, and also in consideration of the sum of _____ Dollar in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, render, release, alien and convey unto the Trustee its successors and assigns, the following described Real Estate situated, lying and being in the COUNTY OF Cook AND STATE OF ILLINOIS, to wit:

2. The Trustee or the holders of the note hereby secured making any payment hereby authorized relating to taxes or assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof.

3. At the option of the holders of the note and without notice to First Party, its successors or assigns, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this trust deed shall, notwithstanding anything in the note or in this trust deed to the contrary, become due and payable (a) immediately in the case of default in making payment of any installment of principal or interest on the note, or (b) in the event of the failure of First Party or its successors or assigns to do any of the things specifically set forth in paragraph one hereof and such default shall continue for three days, said option to be exercised at any time after the expiration of said three day period.

4. When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by acceleration or otherwise, holders of the note or Trustee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof, in any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, they shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Trustee or holders of the note for attorney's fees, Trustee's fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, guarantee policies, Taxation certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Trustee or holders of the note may deem to be reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned shall become an such additional indebtedness secured hereby and immediately due and payable, with interest thereon at the rate of seven per cent per annum, when paid or incurred by Trustee or holders of the note in connection with (a) any proceeding, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, to which either of them shall be a party, either as plaintiff, claimant or defendant, by reason of this trust deed or any indebtedness hereby secured; or (b) preparations for the commencement of any suit for the foreclosure hereof after accrual of such right to foreclose whether or not actually commenced; or (c) preparations for the defense of any threatened suit or proceeding which might affect the premises or the security hereof, whether or not actually commenced.

5. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the note; fourth, any surplus to First Party, its legal representatives or assigns, as their rights may appear.

6. Upon, or at any time after the filing of a bill to foreclose this trust deed, the court in which such bill is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency at the time of application for such receiver, of the person or persons, if any, liable for the payment of the indebtedness secured hereby, and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and the Trustee hereunder may be appointed as such receiver. Such receiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclosure suit and, in case of a sale and a deficiency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further time when First Party, its successors or assigns, except for the intervention of such receiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection, possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The court from time to time may authorize the receiver to apply the net income in his hands in payment in whole or in part of: (1) The indebtedness secured hereby, or (2) any decree foreclosing this trust deed, or any tax, special assessment or other lien which may be or become superior to the lien hereof or of such decree provided such application is made prior to foreclosure sale; (3) the deficiency in case of a sale and deficiency.

7. Trustee or the holders of the note shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.

8. Trustee has no duty to examine the title, location, existence, or condition of the premises, nor shall Trustee be obligated to record this trust deed or to exercise any power herein given unless expressly obligated by the terms hereof, nor be liable for any acts or omissions hereunder, except in case of its own gross negligence or misconduct or that of the agents or employees of Trustee, and it may require indemnities satisfactory to it before exercising any power herein given.

9. Trustee shall release this trust deed and the lien thereof by proper instrument upon presentation of satisfactory evidence that all indebtedness secured by this trust deed has been fully paid; and Trustee may execute and deliver a release hereof to and at the request of any person who shall, either before or after maturity thereof, produce and exhibit to Trustee the note representing that all indebtedness hereby secured has been paid, which representation Trustee may accept as true without inquiry. Where a release is requested of a successor trustee, such successor trustee may accept as the genuine note herein described any note which bears a certificate of identification purporting to be executed by a prior trustee hereunder or which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the note and which purports to be executed on behalf of First Party; and where the release is requested of the original trustee and it has never executed a certificate on any instrument identifying same as the note described herein, it may accept the genuine note herein described any note which may be presented and which conforms in substance with the description herein contained of the note and which purports to be executed on behalf of First Party.

10. Trustee may resign by instrument in writing filed in the office of the Recorder or Registrar of Titles in which this instrument shall have been recorded or filed. In case of the resignation, inability or refusal of Trustee, the then Recorder of Deeds of the county in which the premises are situated shall be Successor in Trust. Any Successor in Trust hereunder shall have the identical title, powers and authority as are herein given Trustee, and any Trustee or successor shall be entitled to reasonable compensation for all acts performed hereunder.

THIS TRUST DEED is executed by the American National Bank and Trust Company of Chicago, not personally but as Trustee as aforesaid in the exercise of the power and authority conferred upon and vested in it as such Trustee and it is expressly understood and agreed that nothing herein or in said note contained shall be construed as creating any liability on the said First Party or on said American National Bank and Trust Company of Chicago personally to pay the said note or any interest that may accrue thereon, or any indebtedness accruing hereunder, or to perform any covenant either express or implied herein contained, all such liability, if any, being expressly waived by Trustee and by every person now or hereafter claiming any right or equity hereunder, and that so far as the First Party and its successors and said American National Bank and Trust Company of Chicago personally are concerned, the legal holder or holders of said note and the owner or owners of any indebtedness accruing hereunder shall look solely to the premises hereby conveyed for the payment thereof by the enforcement of the lien hereby created, in the manner herein and in said note provided or by action to enforce the personal liability of the guarantor, if any.
