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Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

if any person liable to pay any tax neglects of refuses to p, iy the same effor demand, the amount (including any interest additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty together with any costs that may accrus in addition thereto) shall be a lien in layer of the Unuse States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to

Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is especifically fixed by law, the fen-imposed by section 6321 shall also at the tine the assessment is made and shall continue until the expirity for the amount so assessed for a judgment against the taxosyer arising out of such liability is satisfied or pecomes uneatorceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. -- The lien Imposed by section 6321 shall not be vaild as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judge ment lian craditor until notice thereat which made this requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.
