Improvements. The word "improvements" means and includes without limitation all existing and future improvements, fixtures, buildings, structures, mobile homes affixed on the Real Property, facilities, additions and other construction on the Real Property.

Indebtedness. The word "Indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under the Credit Agreement and any amounts expended or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Grantor or expenses incurred by Lender to enforce obligations of Grantor under this Mortgage, together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Mortgage. Specifically, without limitation, this Mortgage secures a revolving line of credit, which obligates Lender to make advances to Grantor so long as Grantor complies with all the terms of the Credit Agreement. Mortgage. The word "Mortgage" means this Mortgage between Grantor and Lender.

Personal Property. Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Granic shall promptly compty with all laws, ordinances, and regulations of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Granic may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Granic has notified Lender in writing prior to doing so and so long as Lender's interests in the Property are not jeopathized. Lender may require Granic to post adequate security or a surety bond, reasonably satisfactory to Lender, to protect Lender's interest.

Duty to Protect. Grantor agrees neither to abandon nor leave unritiended the Property. Grantor shall do all other acts, in addition to those acts set forth above in this section, which from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the Property.

- 5. COMPLIANCE WITH LEASE. Lender, at Lender's option, may require Grantor to execute and deliver to Lender, in a form acceptable to Lender, an assignment of any rights, claims or defenses which Grantor may have against parties who supply labor, materials or services in connection with improvements made to the Property.
- 7. DUS ON SALE CONSENT BY LENDER. - 8. TRANSFER OF PROPERTY. The following provisions relating to the transfer of the Reat Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Notice of Transfer. Grantor shall give notice to Lender, as provided in this Mortgage, prior to any sale or transfer of all or part of the Property or any rights in the Real Property. Any person to whom all or part of the Real Property is sold or transferred also shall be obligated to give notice to Lender, as provided in this Mortgage, promptly after such transfer.

Advances After Transfer. All amounts advanced under the LOANLINER® Home Equity Plan Credit Agreement, up to the Credit Limit, are secured by this Mortgage, whether advanced before or after sale or transfer of the Real Property, except any amounts which may be advanced by Lender more than five (5) days after notice to Lender, as provided in this Mortgage, that such transfer or sale has occurred. 9. TAXES AND LIENS. The following provisions relating to the taxes and tiens on the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Payment. Grantor shall pay when due (and in all events prior to delinquency) all taxes, payroll taxes, special taxes, assessments, water charges and sewer service charges tovied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services randered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of all liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, except for the Existing Indebtedness referred to below, and except as otherwise provided in the following paragraph.

Right To Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Lender's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. 10. PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Morlgage.

Maintenance of Insurance. Granter shall produce and maintain policies of his insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the foll insurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any companiance clause, and with a standard mortgaged clause in favor of Londor. A Granter halfs to comply with any provision of this Mortgage, including any obligation to maintain Existing indebtedness in good standing as required below, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interests in the Property, Lender on Granter's behalf may, upon notice to Granter, but shalf not be required to, take any action that Lender downs appropriate. Any amount that Lender expends in so doing will bear interest at the rate charged under the Crodit Agreement from the date incurred or paid by Lender to the date of repayment by Granter. All such expenses, at Lender's option, will rate be payable on demand, or (b) be added to the balance of the crodit line. This Mortgage also will secure payment of the security. - 12. WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE. The following provisions relating to exmership of the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Title. Granter warrants that: (a) Granter holds good and marketable little of record to the Property (including a leasehold interest, if any), from and clear of all liens and encumbrances except these of record, and (b) Granter has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this kiterigage to London.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Granter warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the lawful claims of all parsons. In the event any action or proceeding, is commenced that questions Granter's title or the interest of Londer under this Mortgage, Granter shall defend the action at Granter's expense. Granter shall neither request nor accept any future advances under any such security agreement without the prior written consent of Lender.

14. CONDEMNATION. The following provisions relating to condumnation of the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned, Lender may at its election acquire that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the indebtedness under the LOANLINER® Home Equity Plan, subject to the terms of any mortgage or deed of trust with a lien which has priority over this Mortgage. Proceedings. Further Assurances. Upon request of Lender, Grantor will make, execute and deliver, or will cause to be made, executed or delivered, to Lender or to Lender's designee, and when requested by Lender, cause to be filed, recorded, refiled, or rerecorded, as the case may be, at such times and places as Lender may deem appropriate, any and all such mortgages, deeds of trust, security deeds, security agreements, financing statements, continuation statements, instruments of further assurance, curtificates, and other decuments as may, in the sole opinion of Lender, be necessary or desirable in order to effectuate, complete, perfect, continue, or preserve. (a) the obligations of Grantor under the Credit Agreement, this Mortgage, and the Related Documents, and. (b) the liens and socially interests created by this Mortgage on the Property. Unless prohibited by law or agreed to the contrary by Lender in writing, Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all costs and expenses incurred in connection with the matters referred to in this paragraph.

- 17. FULL PERFORMANCE. If Grantor pays all the Indebtedness when due, terminates the credit line account, and otherwise performs all the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Mortgage, Lender shall execute and deliver to Grantor a suitable satisfaction of this Mortgage. Grantor will pay, if permitted by applicable law, any reasonable termination fee as determined by Lender from time to time.
- 18. DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lendor, shall constitute an event of default ("Event of Default") under this Mortgage: (a) Grantor commits fraud or makes a material misrepresentation at any time in connection with the credit line account. This can include, for example, a false statement about Grantor's income, assets, liabilities, or any other aspects of Grantor's financial condition. This can include, for example, failure to maintain required insurance, waste or destructive use of the dwelling, failure to pay taxes, death of all persons liable on the account, transfer of title or sale of the dwelling, creation of a lien on the dwelling without Lender's permission, foreclosure by the

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holder of another lien, or the use of funds or the dwelling for prohibited purposes

- 19. GRANTOR'S RIGHT TO CURE. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default (other than fraud or material misrepresentation) and prior to exercising any of the rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or by law, Lender shall give notice as provided in the Mortgage and as required by applicable law. The notice may be combined or sent with any notice required by applicable law and shall specify: (a) the Event of Default; (b) the action required to cure the default; (c) a date not less than thirty (30) days (or any longer period as required by applicable law or elemente in this Mortgage) from the date the notice is given to Grantor by which the default must be cured and (d) that failure to cure the default on or before the date specified in the notice may result in acceleration of the sums secured by this Mortgage and sale of the property. The notice shall further inform Grantor of the right to reinstate after acceleration and the right to assert in a forectosure proceeding the nonexistence of an event of default which occurred within three hundred sixty—five (365) days of the present event of Default, Grantor shall not be entitled to receive the right to cure described in this paragraph.
- 20. RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default and at any time thereafter, Lander, at its oction, may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by taw:

Accelerate Indebtedness. Lender shall have the right at its option to declare the entire Indebtedness immediately due and payinble

Mortgages in Possession. Lander shall have the right to be placed as mortgages in possession or to have a receiver appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding forectosure or sale, and to collect the Rents from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, against the Indebtedness. The mortgages in possession or receiver that exist whother or not the apparent value of the Property exceeds the indebtedness by a substantial amount. Employment by Lender shall not dequality a person from serving as a receiver.

Judicial Foreclosure: Lender may obtain a judicial decree foreclosing Grantor's interest in all or any part of the Property.

Deficiency Judgm.e.m. If permitted by applicable law, Lender may obtain a judgment for any deficiency remaining in the Indebtedness due to Lender after application of all amounts received from the exercise of the rights provided in this section.

Other Remedies. Lenger shall have all other rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or the LOANLINER® Home Equity Plan Credit Agreement or available of the 3 in equity.

Sale of the Property. To the extent permitted by applicable law, Grantor hereby waives any and all right to have the property marchalled. In exercising its rights and remoded, Londer shall be free to sell all or any part of the Property together or separately, in one sale or by separate sales. Lender shall be entitled to bir at any public sale on all or any portion of the Property.

Notice of Bala. Lender shall give Grant's reasonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Property or of the time after which any private sale or other Intended disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least (or (10) days before the time of the sale or disposition.

Walver; Election of Remedies. A waiver (y e in party of a breach of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's rights otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. Election by Lender to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expanditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Mortgage after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect be iden't right to declare a default and exercise its remedies under this Mortgage.

Altorneys' Fees; Expenses. If Lender institutes any straic action to entorce any of the terms of this Mortgage, Lender shall be entitled to receiver such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as actor less foos at triat and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Lender that in Lender's riph on are necessary at any time for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the Indebtodness payable on demand and shall bear interest from the date of expenditure until regald at the Cradit Agreement rate. Expenses covered by this paragraph include, without limitation, however subject to any limits under applicable law, Lender's attorneys' fees and legal expenses whether or not there is a lawsuit, including alterneys' fees for bankruptcy proceedings (including efforts to modify or vacate any automatic stay or injunction), appeas and any anticipated post-judgment collection services, the cost of searching records, obtaining title reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyers' reports, and appraisal fees, and title insurance, to the extent permitted by applicable law. Grantor also will pay any court costs, in addition to all other sums provided by law.

- 21. NOTICES TO GRANTOR AND OTHER PARTIES. Any notice under this Military, including without kimitation any notice of default and any notice of sale to Grantor, shall be in writing and shall be effective when actually delivered or if mailed, shall be deemed effective when deposited in the United States mail first class, registered mail, postage prepaid, directed to the addresses shown hear the beginning of this Mortgage. Any party may change its address for notices under this Mortgage by giving formal written notice to the other parties, specifying that the purpose of the notice is to change the party's address. All copies of notices of foreclosure from the holder of any lien which has priority over this Mortgage shall be sent to Lender's address, as shown near the beginning of this Mortgage. For notice purposes, Grantor agrees to the plant's informed at all times of Grantor's current address.
- 22. ASSOCIATION OF UNIT OWNERS. The following provisions apply if the Real Property has been submitted to unit ownership law or similar law for the establishment of condominiums or cooperative ownership of the Real Property:

Power of Attorney. Grantor grants an irrevocable power of attorney to Lender to vote in its aix retion on any matter that may come before the association of unit owners. Lender shall have the right to exercise this power of attorney only effor default by Grantor; however, Lender may decline to exercise this power as it sees fit.

Insurance. The insurance as required above may be carried by the association of unit owners on Grantor's behalf, and the proceeds of such insurance may be paid to the association of unit owners for the purpose of repairing or reconstruction the Property. If not so used by the association, such proceeds shall be paid to Lender.

Compilance with Regulations of Association. Grantor shall perform all of the obligations imposed on Gran or by the declaration submitting the Real Property to unit ownership, by the bylaws of the association of unit owners, or by any rules or regulations their under. If Crantor's interest in the Real Property is a teasehold interest and such property has been submitted to unit ownership, Grantor shear parform all of the obligations imposed on Grantor by the lease of the Real Property from its owner.

23. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS. The following miscellaneous provisions are a part of this Mortgage:

Amendments. This Mortgage, logether with any Related Documents, constitutes the entire understanding and agreement of the parties as to the matters set forth in this Mortgage. No alteration of or amendment to this Mortgage shall be effective unless given in whiting and signed by the party or parties sought to be charged or bound by the alteration or amendment.

Applicable Law. This Mortgage shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois.

Caption Headings. Caption headings in this Mortgage are for convenience purposes only and are not to be used to interpret or define the provisions of this Mortgage.

Grantor's Copy of Documents. Lender agrees to provide Grantor with a conformed copy of both the LOANLINER® Home Equity Plan Credit Agreement and this Mortgage at the time they are executed or within a reasonable time after this Mortgage is recorded.

Merger. There shall be no merger of the interest or estate created by this Mortgage with any other interest or estate in the Property at any time held by or for the benefit of Lender in any capacity, without the written consent of Lender.

Severability. If a court of competent jurisdiction finds any provision of this Mortgage to be invalid or unenforceable as to any person or circumstances, such finding shall not render that provision invalid or unenforceable as to any other persons or circumstances. If feasible, any such offending provision shall be deemed to be modified to be within the limits of enforceability or validity; however, if the offending provision cannot be so modified, it shall be stricken and all other provisions of this Mortgage in all other respects shall remain valid and enforceable.

Successors and Assigns. Subject to the limitations stated in this Mortgage on transfer of Grantor's Interest, this Mortgage shall be binding upon and Inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors and assigns. If ownership of the Property becomes vested in a person other than Grantor, Lender, without notice to Grantor, may deal with Grantor's successors with reference to this Mortgage and the Indebtedness by way of forbearance or extension without releasing Grantor from the obligations of this Mortgage or Hability under the Indebtedness.

Time is of the Essence. Time is of the essence in the performance of this Mortgage.

Watver of Homestead Exemption. Granfor hereby releases and waives all rights and benefits of the homestead exemption laws of the State of Illinois as to all Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage.

Walvers and Consents. Lender shall not be deemed to have waived any rights under this Mortgage (or under the Related Documents) unless such walver is in writing and signed by Lender. No delay or omission on the part of Lender in exercising any right shall operate as a waiver of such right or any other right. A waiver by any party of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's right otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. No prior waiver by Lender, nor any course of dealing between Lender and Grantor, shall constitute a waiver of any of Lender's rights or any of Grantor's obligations as to any future transactions. Whenever consent by Lender is required in this Mortgage, the granting of such consent by Lender in any instance shall not constitute continuing consent to
