

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321, Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or reluser to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest additional amount, addition to tax, or essessable penuity abactions mount, adultion tax, or assessment period together with any costs that may accrue in addition there is shall be a lionun favor of the United States upon all properly and rights to properly, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unioss another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the emount so assessed (or a judgment against the laxpayer arising out of such flability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of tapso of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The Hon Imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (i) has been filed by the Secretary.

O Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filling . The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed-

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subclyision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situtated; and
(ii) Personal Property-in the case of personal

property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the Stale (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; except that State law merely-conforming to reenacting Federal law establishing a national filing system does not constitute a second office for filing as designated by the laws of such State; or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court-in the office of the clerk of the United States (1997) Sound for the Judicial district in which the property subject to flen is altuated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which moots the

requirements of subparagraph (A), or (C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Co-Pumble - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.

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(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), properly shall be deemed to be situated-(A) Roal Property - In the case of real property, at its physical

(H) Personal Property in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of flen is illed.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation. or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located, and the residence of a texpayer whose residence is without the United \$'a us shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Torm - The form and content of the notice referred to in subjection (a), shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid netwithstanding any other provision of law regarding it e ir im or content of a notice of liames

(g) Refiling Of Notice — For purposes of this section:

(1) General Rule .- Unless notice of then is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f) after the expiration of such rollling period. 100

(2) Place For Filing.—A notice of then retiled during the required refilling period shall be offective only-
