Right To Contest. Application of Proceeds. Granter shall promptly notify Lender of any loss or damagn to the Property if the estimated cost of repair or replacement exceeds \$1,000.00. Lender may make proof of loss if Granter fails to do so within titteen (15) days of the casualty. Whether or not Lender's security is impaired, Lender may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the indobtedness, payment of any fien affecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property. If such a failure is curable and if Granter has not been given a notice of a breach of the same provision of this Mortgage within the proceding twolve (12) months, it may be cured (and no Event of Default will have occurred) if Granter, after Lender sends written notice

Insolvency.
