ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS

THIS ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS IS DATED MARCH 4, 1892, between DENNIS M. CARRABINE and LORI A. CARRABINE, HIS WIFE, AS JOINT TENANTS, whose address is 1110 OLIVE ROAD, HOMEWOOD, IL 60430 (referred to below as "Grantor"); and FIRST NATIONAL BANK, whose address is 100 FIRST NATIONAL PLAZA, CHICAGO HEIGHTS, IL 60411 (referred to below as "Lender").

ASSIGNMENT. For valuable consideration, Grantor assigns and conveys to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and Interest in and to the Rents from the following described Property located in COOK County, State of Illinois:

LOT 7 IN BLOCK 2 IN EASTMOOR PARK SECOND ADDITION, BEING A SUBDIVISION IN THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 36 NORTH, RANGE 14, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PIN # 29-32-403-037

The Real Property or its address is commonly known as 11/10 C'LIVE ROAD, HOMEWOOD, IL 60430. The Real Property tax identification number is 28-32-403-037.

DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following meanings when used in this Assignment, Terms not otherwise defined in this Assignment shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Uniform Commercial Code. All references to deliar amounts shall mean amounts in lawful money of the United States of America.

Assignment. The word "Assignment" means this Assignment of Rents between Granter and Lander, and includes without limitation all assignments and security interest provisions relating to the Rents.

Event of Default. The words "Event of Default" mean and include any of the Events of Default set for h below in the section titled "Events of Default."

Grantor. The word "Grantor" means DENNIS M. CARRABINE and LORI A. CARRABINE.

Indebtedness. The word "indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under the Note and any amounts expended or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Granter or expenses incurred by Lender to enforce obligations of Granter under the xeelignment, together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Assignment.

Lander. The word "Lender" means FIRST NATIONAL BANK, its successors and assigns.

Note. The word "Note" means the premissory note or credit agreement dated March 4, 1992, in the original principal amount of \$88,500,00 from Granter to Lender, together with all renewals of, extensions of, modifications of, refinancings of, consolidations of, and substitutions for the promissory note or agreement. The interest rate on the Note is 7,780%. The Note is payable in 180 monthly payments of \$644,77.

Property. The word "Property" means the real property, and all improvements thereon, described above in the "Assignment" section.

Real Property. The words "Real Property" mean the property, interests and rights described above in the "Property Definition" section.

Related Documents. The words "Related Documents" mean and include without limitation all promissory notes, credit agreements, icon agreements, guaranties, security agreements, nortgages, deeds of trust, and all other instruments and documents, whether new or hereafter existing, executed in connection with Granter's Indebtodness to Lander.

Rents. The word "Rents" means all rents, revenues, income, issues, and profile from the Property, whether due now or later, including without limitation all Rents from all leases described on any exhibit attached to this Assignment.

THIS ASSIGNMENT IS GIVEN TO SECURE (1) PAYMENT OF THE INDEBTEDNESS AND (2) PERFORMANCE OF ANY AND ALL OBLIGATIONS OF GRANTOR UNDER THE NOTE AND THIS ASSIGNMENT. THIS ASSIGNMENT IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except as otherwise provided in this Assignment, Borrower shall pay to Londor all amounts secured by this Assignment as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Borrower's obligations. Unless and until Landor exercises its right to collect the Rents as provided below and so long as there is no default under this Assignment, Granter may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the Rents.

LENDER'S RIGHT TO COLLECT RENTS. Londer shall have the right at any time, and even though no default shall have occurred under this Assignment, to collect and receive the Rents. For this purpose, Londer is hereby given and granted the following rights, powers and authority:

Notice to Tenants. Lender may send notices to any and all fenants of the Property advising them of this Assignment and directing all Rents to be paid directly to Lender or Lender's agent.

Enter the Property. Londor may only upon and take possession of the Property; demand, collect and receive from the tenants or from any officer persons liable therefor, all of the Rents; institute and carry on all legal proceedings necessary for the protection of the Property, including such proceedings as may be necessary to recover possession of the Property; collect the Rents and remove any tenant or tenants or other persons from the Property.

Maintain the Property. Lender may enter upon the Property to maintain the Property and keep the same in repair; to pay the costs thereof and of all services of all employees, including their equipment, and of all continuing costs and expenses of maintaining the Property in proper repair and condition, and also to pay all taxes, assessments and water utilities, and the premiums on fire and other insurance affected by Lender on the Property.

Compliance with Laws. Lender may do any and all things to execute and comply with the laws of the State of Illinois and also all other laws, rules, orders, ordinances and requirements of all other governmental agencies affecting the Property.

Lease the Property. Lander may rent or lease the whole or any part of the Property for such term or terms and on such conditions as Lender may deem appropriate.

Employ Agents. Unider may engage such agent or agents as Londer may doem appropriate, either in Londer's name or in Granter's name, to rent and manage the receiver, including the collection and application of Rents.

Other Acts. Londor (20) do all such other things and acts with respect to the Property as Londor may down appropriate and may act exclusively and solely in the place of disease of Granter and to have all of the powers of Granter for the purposes stated above.

No Requirement to Act. Length shall not be required to do any of the foregoing acts or things, and the fact that Lunder shall have performed one or more of the foregoing acts or mings shall not require Lender to do any other specific act or thing.

APPLICATION OF RENTS. All costs an Expenses incurred by Lender in connection with the Property shall be for Borrower's account and Lender may pay such costs and expenses from the Ponts. Lender, in its sole discretion, shall determine the application of any and all Rents received by it; however, any such Rents received by Lender which are not applied to such costs and expenses shall be applied to the Indebtedness. All expenditures made by Lender under this Assignment and not combined from the Rents shall become a part of the Indebtedness secured by this Assignment, and shall be payable on demand, with Interest at the Note rate from date of expenditure until paid.

FULL PERFORMANCE. If Grantor pays all of the Indeptouries when due and otherwise performs all the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Assignment and the Note, Lander shall execute and deliver or Crantor a sultable satisfaction of this Assignment and sultable statements of termination of any financing statement on file evidencing Lender's security increase in the Rents and the Property. Any termination fee required by law shall be paid by Grantor, if permitted by applicable law.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Granter falls to comply with any provision of this Assignment, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interests in the Property, Lender on Granter's behalf may, but shall not be required to, take any action that Lender deems appropriate. Any amount that Lender expends in so doing will bear Interest to the charged under the Note from the date incurred or paid by Lender to the date of repayment by Granter. All such expenses, at Lender's pallon, will (a) be payable on demand, (b) be added to the balance of the Note and be apportioned among and be payable with any installment payments to come due during either (i) the term of any applicable insurance policy or (ii) the remaining term of the Note, or (c) be treated as a balloon payment which will be due and payable at the Note's maturity. This Assignment also will secure payment of these amounts. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lender may be entitled on account of the default. Any such action by Lender shall not be construed as curing the default so as to bar Lender from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Londer, shall constitute an event of default ("Event of Default") under this Assignment:

Default on Indebtedness. Failure of Granter to make any payment when due on the Indebtedness.

Compliance Default. Failure to comply with any other term, obligation, covenant or condition con since in this Assignment, the Note or in any of the Related Documents. If such a failure is curable and if Granter has not been given a notice of a breach of the same provision of this Assignment within the proceeding twelve (12) months, it may be cured (and no Event of Default will have occurred) if Granter, after Londer nonde written notice demanding cure of such failure: (a) cures the failure within fifteen (15) days; or (b) if the cure recultred more than fifteen (15) days, immediately initiates steps sufficient to cure the failure and thereafter continues and completes all reasonable rule executives a sufficient to cure the failure and thereafter continues and completes all reasonable rule executives.

Breaches. Any warranty, representation or statement made or furnished to Lender by or on behalf of Granter under this Assignment, the Note or the Related Documents is, or at the time made or furnished was, false in any material respect.

Other Defaults. Fallure of Granfor to comply with any term, obligation, covenant, or condition contained in any other agreement between Granfor and Londor.

Insolvency. The insolvency of Grantor, appointment of a receiver for any part of Grantor's property, any assignment for the benefit of creditors, the commencement of any proceeding under any bankruptcy or insolvency laws by or against Grantor, or the dissolution or termination of Grantor's existence as a going business (if Grantor is a business). Except to the extent prohibited by federal law or Illinois law, the death of Grantor is an individual) also shall constitute an Event of Default under this Assignment.

Foreclosure, etc. Commencement of foreclosure, whether by judicial proceeding, self-help, repossession or any other method, by any creditor of Grantor against any of the Property. However, this subsection shall not apply in the event of a good faith dispute by Grantor as to the validity or reasonableness of the claim which is the basis of the foreclosure, provided that Grantor gives Lander written notice of such claim and furnishes reserves or a surely bond for the claim satisfactory to Londer.

Events Affecting Guarantor. Any of the preceding events occurs with respect to any Guarantor of any of the indebtedness or such Guarantor dies or becomes incompetent. Londer, at its option, may, but shall not be required to, permit the Guarantor's estate to assume unconditionally the obligations arising under the guaranty in a manner satisfactory to Londer, and, in doing so, cure the Event of Default.

Insecurity. Lender reasonably dooms itself insecure.

RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default and at any time thereafter, Lender may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

Accelerate Indebtedness. Lender shall have the right at its option without notice to Granter to declare the entire indebtedness immediately due and payable, including any prepayment panalty which Granter would be required to pay.

Collect Rents. Lander shall have the right, without notice to Grantor, to take possession of the Property and collect the Rents, including amounts past due and unpaid, and apply the not proceeds, over and above Lender's costs, against the Indebtedness. In furtherance of this right, Lender

may require any tenant or other user of the Property to make payments of rent or use fees directly to Lender. If the Rents are collected by Lender, then Grantor irrevocably designates Londer as Grantor's attorney-in-fact to endorse instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by tenants or other users to Londer in response to Londer's demand shall satisfy the obligations for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper grounds for the demand existed. Lender may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

Mortgages in Possession. Lender shall have the right to be placed as mortgages in possession or to have a receiver appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding tereclosure or sale, and to collect the Renta from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, against the Indebtedness. The mortgages in possession or receiver may serve without band it permitted by law. Lander's right to the appointment of a receiver shall exist whether or not the apparent value of the Property exceeds the Indebtedness by a substantial amount. Employment by Lander shall not disquality a person from serving as a receiver.

Other Remedies. Lander shall have all other rights and remodies provided in this Assignment or the Note or by law.

Walver; Election of Remedies. A waiver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Assignment shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's rights otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. Election by Lander to pureue any remode intelligence not exclude pursuit of any other remady, and an election to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Granter under this Assignment after " this a of Granter to perform shall not affect Lander's right to declare a default and exercise his remadics under this Assignment.

Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. If Landar Institutes any suit or sation to enforce any of the terms of this Assignment, Landar shall be suitled to recover atternoys' feet at rial and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expension incurred by Lender that in Londor's opinion are necessary at any time for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the indebtedness payable on domand and the bear interest from the date of expenditure until repaid at the Note rate. Expenses covered by this paragraph include, without limitation, he ve ar subject to any limits under applicable law, Lender's atternage' fees and legal expenses whether or not there is a lawault, including attornoya' foculto, pankruptcy proceedings (including efforts to modify or vacate any automatic atmy or fulunction), appeals and any anticipated post-judgment collection services, the cost of bearching records, obtaining title reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyors reports, and appraisal loss, and little insurance, to the extent permitted by applicable law. Granter also will pay any court conta, in addition to all other sums provided by law.

MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS. The following miscellaneous provisions are a part of this Assignment:

Amendments. This Assignment, together with any Related Documents, constitutes the entire understanding and agreement of the parties as to the matters set forth in this Assignment. No alteration of or amondment to this Assignment shall be allective unless given in writing and algred by the party or parties sought to be charged or bound by the alteration or amondment.

Applicable Law. This Assignment has been delivered to Londor and accepted by Londor in the State of Illinois. This Assignment shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois.

Multiple Parties. All obligations of Grantor under this Assignment shall be joint and several, and all references to Grantor shall mean each and every Grantor. This means that each of the persons signing below is responsible for all obligations in this Assignment.

No Modification. Grantor shall not enter into any agreement with the huider of any mortgage, doed of trust, or other accurity agreement which has priority over this Assignment by which that agreement is modified, are indeed, extended, or renewed without the prior written consent of Lander. Granter shall neither request nor accept any future advances under eny such security agreement without the prior written consent of

Severability. If a court of compotent jurisdiction finds any provision of this Assignment to be invalid or unenforceable as to any person or circumstance, such finding shall not render that provision invalid or unenforceable as to any chor persons or circumstances. If feasible, any such offending provision shall be deemed to be modified to be within the limits of enforcembility or waithly; however, if the effending provision cannot be so modified, it shall be stricken and all other provisions of this Assignment in all other respect, what remain valid and enforcemble.

Successors and Assigns. Subject to the limitations stated in this Assignment on transfer of Grence's interest, this Assignment shall be binding upon and inure to the banefit of the parties, their successors and assigns. If ownership of the Property becomes vested in a person other than Granter, Lander, without notice to Granter, may deal with Granter's successors with reference to this Assignment and the Indebtodress by way of forbearance or extension without releasing Grantor from the obligations of this Ausignment or liability under the includes a

Walver of Homestead Exemption. Grantor hereby releases and walves all rights and benefits of the homestead exemption laws of the State of Illinois as to all Indebtodness secured by this Assignment.

Walvers and Consents. Lender shall not be deemed to have walved any rights under this Assignment (or under the Relinud Documents) unless such walver is in writing and signed by Lender. No delay or omission on the part of Londer in exercising any right shall operate as a walver of such right or any other right. A waiver by any party of a provision of this Assignment shall not constitute a waiver of or projudice the party's right otherwise to demand strict compilance with that provision or any other provision. No prior waiver by Lender, nor any course of dealing between Lender and Grantor, shall constitute a waiver of any of Lender's rights or any of Grantor's obligations as to any luture transactions. Whenever consent by Lender is required in this Assignment, the granting of such consent by Lender in any instance shall not constitute continuing consent to subsequent instances where such consent is required.

EACH GRANTOR ACKNOWLEDGES HAVING READ ALL THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS, AND EACH GRANTOR AGREES TO ITS TERMS.
