

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tall reglects or refuses to perthe same after demand, the amount (including any interest), wadditional amount, addition to tax, or assussable penalty. together with any costs that may accrue in eddition thereto) shift be a her in taxo; of the United States upon all property and rights to properly, whether reaf or personal, belonging to such person

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another cate is specifically fixed by law, the hen emposed by sortion 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and whill continue until the limbility for the amount so assessed for a judgment against the tuxpayer arising out at such limitaty) is satisfied or becomes ununforceable by reason of lapse of time

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And

Judgment Lien Creditors, -Tru hen imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (I) has been filed by the Secretary

m Place For Filling Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filling - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed-

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situtated; and

(III Personal Property-In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intengible, in one office within the State (or the county, or offine governmental aubdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property aubject to the lien is sounted; except that their law merely conforming to reenacting Federal law establishing a national filing gallit tot exitto broose a stuttance for filling

an designated by the taws of such State; or (B) With Clerk Of District Court-in the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to tien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the

requirements of subparagraph (A), or (C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Cojumpla - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.

Fill purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or pair ersorp shall be doomed to be the place at which the principal manetive office of the business is located, and the residence (flaifurgyer whose residence is without the United States shall be formed to be in the District of Columbia

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 10 years ritor the date of the assosament of the

(B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 10 years ofter the close of the proceding regulied refilling period for such notice of hen.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien.—Subject to such reguintions as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day

(1) Linbility Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary lands that the liability for the amount assessed, togethor with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unerforceable, or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Bematery and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any liters in of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond is id-directles thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.
