MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE IS DATED FEBRUARY 14, 1992, between Bert A. Grasso and Sharon L. Grasso, his wife (J), whose address is 18001 Arthur Dr., Orland Park,, il. 60462 (referred to below as "Grantor"); and Marquette National Bank, whose address is 6316 South Western Avenue, Chicago, il. 60636 (referred to below as "Lender").

GRANT OF MORTGAGE. For valuable consideration, Grantor mortguiges, warrants, and conveys to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to the following descripted real property, together with all existing or subsequently erricted or affixed buildings, improvements and fixtures; all easements, rights of way, and appurtenances; all water, water rights, watercourses and dilch rights (including stock in utilities with dilch or irrigation rights); and all other rights, royalf's, and profits relating to the real property including without limitation all interests, oil, gas, geothermal and similar matters, located in Cook County, State of Illinois (the "Retail Property"):

Lot 49 in Eagle Ridge Estates Unit 1, Being A Subdivision Of Part Of The North 1/2 Of The South East 1/4 And The East 1/2 Cf The South West 1/4 Of Section 32, Township 36 North, Range 12 East Of The Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois.

The Real Property or its address is commonly known as 18001 Arthur Dr., Orland Park, IL. 60462. The Real Property lax identification number is 27–32-400-008.

Grantor presently assigns to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to all leases of the Property and all Rents from the Property. In addition, Grantor grants to Lender a Uniform Commercial Code security interest in the Personal Property and Rents.

DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following magnings when used in this Mortgage. Terms not otherwise defined in this Mortgage shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Uniform Comine cial Code. All references to dollar amounts shall mean amounts in lawful money of the United States of America.

Credit Agreement. The words "Credit Agreement" mean the revening line of credit agreement dated February 14, 1992, between Lender and Grantor with a credit limit of \$30,000.00, together with all renewals of, extensions of, modifications of, refinancings of, consolidations of, and substitutions for the Credit Agreement. The interest rate under the revolving line of credit is a variable interest rate based upon an index. The index currently is 6.500% per annum. The interest rate to be applied to the outstanding account balance shall be at a rate 1.000 percentage points above the index, subject however to the following minimum and maximum rates. Under no circumsiances shall the interest rate be less than 9.000% per annum or more than the lesser of 18.000% per annum or the maximum rate allowed by applicable law.

Existing Indebtedness. The words "Existing Indebtedness" mean the indeptedness described below in the Existing Indebtedness section of the Mortgage.

Grantor. The word "Grantor" means Bert A. Grasso and Sharon L. Grasso. The Crantor is the mortgagor under this Mortgage.

Guarantor. The word "Guarantor" means and includes without limitation, each and all of the guarantors, sureties, and accommodation parties in connection with the Indebtedness.

Indebtedness. The word "indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under the Credit Agreement and any amounts expended of advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Grantor or expenses incurred by Lender to interest on such amounts as provided in this Mortgage. Specifically, without immitation, this Mortgage secures a revolving line of credit and shall secure not only the amount which Lender has presently advanced to Grantor under the Credit Agreement, but also any future amounts which Lender may advance to Grantor under the Credit Agreement with a twenty (20) years from the date of this Mortgage to the same extent as if such future advance were made as of the date of the execution of the Mortgage. The revolving line of credit obligates Lender to make advances to Grantor so long as Grantor compiles with all the terms of the Credit Agreement and Related Documents. Such advances may be made, repaid, and remade from time to time, subject to the imitation that the total outstanding balance owing at any one time, not including finance charges on such halance at a fixed or variable also of such that the total outstanding Agreement, any temporary overages, other charges, and any amounts expended or advanced as provided in the Credit Agreement. It is the intention of Grantor and Lende, that that Mortgage secures the balance outstanding under the Credit Agreement from time to time zero up to the Credit Limit of provided above and any intermediate balance.

Personal Property. The words "Personal Property" mean all equipment, fixtures, and other articles of personal property now or hereafter owned by Grantor, and now or hereafter attached or affixed to the Real Property; together with all accessions, parts, and additions to, all replacements of, and all substitutions for, any of such property; and together with all proceeds (including without limitation all insurance proceeds and refunds of premiums) from any sale or other disposition of the Property.

Property. The word "Property" means collectively the Real Property and the Personal Property.

Real Property. The words "Real Property" mean the property, Interests and rights described above in the "Grant of Mortgage" section.

Rents. The word "Rents" means all present and future rents, revenues, income, issues, royalties, profits, and other benefits derived from the Property.

THIS MORTGAGE, INCLUDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND THE SECURITY INTEREST IN THE RENTS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY, IS GIVEN TO SECURE (1) PAYMENT OF THE INDEBTEDNESS AND (2) PERFORMANCE OF ALL OBLIGATIONS OF GRANTOR UNDER THIS MORTGAGE. THIS MORTGAGE IS INTENDED TO AND SHALL BE VALID AND HAVE PRIORITY OVER ALL SUBSEQUENT LIENS AND ENCUMBRANCES, INCLUDING STAUTORY LIENS, EXCEPTING SOLELY TAXES AND ASSESSMENTS LEVIED ON THE REAL PROPERTY, TO THE EXTENT OF THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT SECURED HERBBY. THIS MORTGAGE IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except as otherwise provided in this Mortgage, Grantor shall pay to Lerider all amounts secured by this Mortgage as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grantor's obligations under this Mortgage.

POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that Grantor's possession and use of the Property shall be governed by the following provisions:

Possession and Use. Until in default, Grantor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Real Property and collect the Rents.

Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in tenantable condition and promptly perform all repairs, replacements, and maintenance necessary to preserve its value.

Nulsance, Waste. Grantor shall not cause, conduct or permit any nuisance nor commit, permit, or suffer any stripping of or waste on or to the Property or any portion of the Property. Specifically without limitation, Grantor will not remove, or grant to any other party the right to remove, any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), soil, gravel or rock products without the prior written consent of Lender.

DUE ON SALE - CONSENT BY LENDER. Lender may, at its option, declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this Mortgage upon the sale or transfer, without the Lender's prior written consent, of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest in the Real Property. A "sale or

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transfer" means the conveyance of Real Property or any right, little or interest therein; whether legal or equitable; whether voluntary or involuntary; whether by outright sale, deed, installment sale contract, land contract, contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three (3) years, lease-option contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer of any beneficial interest in or to any land trust holding title to the Real Property, or by any other method of conveyance of Real Property interest. If any Grantor is a conjugation or partnership, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than twenty-five percent (25%) of the voting stock or partnership interests, as the case may be, of Grantor. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if such exercise is prohibited by federal law or by illinois law.

TAXES AND LIENS. The following provisions relating to the taxes and items on the Property are a part of this Mollgage.

Payment. Grantor shall pay when due (and in all events prior to delinquency) all taxes, payroll taxes, special taxes, assessments, water charges and sewer service charges levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of all tiens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lerider under this Mortgage, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, except for the Existing Indebtedness referred to below, and except as otherwise provided in the following paragraph.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on an actual cash value basis for the full insurable value covering att improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgagee clause in taxor of Lender. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor shall duliver to Lender certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lender. Should the Real Property at any time become located in an area designated by the Director of the Federal Emergency Management Agency as a special flood hazard area, Grantor agrees to obtain and maintain Federal Flood insurance, to the extent such insurance is required and is or becomes available, for the term of the loan and for the full unpaid principal balance of the loan, or the insurance limit of coverage that is available, whichever is less.

Application of Nuceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Lender of any loss or damage to the Property. Lender may make proof of loss if Grantor tails to do so withy infleen (15) days of the casualty. Whether or not funder's security is impaired, Lender may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the indebtedness, payment of any lien affecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property.

EXPENDITURES BY LENCE'S. If Grantor fails to comply with any provision of this Mortgage, including any obligation to maintain Existing Indebtedness in good standing as required below, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interests in the Property, Lender on Grantor's behalf may, but shist of be required to, take any action that Cender deems appropriate. Any amount that Lender expends in so doing will be an interest at the rate charged hintor. The Credit Agreement from the date incurred or paid by Lender to the date of repayment by Grantor. All such expenses, at Lender's option, will (a) be payable on demand, (b) be added to the balance of the credit line and be apportioned among and be payable with any installment paymens to become due during either. (i) the term of any applicable insurance policy or. (ii) the remaining term of the Credit Agreement, or. (c) be treated as a calloon payment which will be due and payable at the Credit Agreement's maturity. This Mortgage also will socure payment of these amounts. The rights or orvided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lender that it otherwise would have had.

WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE. The following rook ions relating to ownership of the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Title. Grantor warrants that: (a) Grantor holds good and marketable title of record to the Property in fee simple, free and clear of all flens and encumbrances other than those set torth in the Rual Property description or in the Existing indebtedness section below or in any title insurance policy, title report, or final title opinion issued in favo. And accepted by, Lender in connection with this Mortgage, and (b) Grantor has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Moripage to Lender.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the lawful claims of all persons.

EXISTING (NDEBTEDNESS. The following provisions concerning existing indebtedness (the "Existing Indebtedness") are a part of this Mortgage.

Existing Lien. The lien of this Mortgage securing the Indebtedness has be secondary and inferior to the lien securing payment of an existing obligation to NBD Mortgage Company described as: Mortgage itself dated August 29,1991 and recorded in Book September 4,1991. The existing obligation has a current principal balance of approximately \$187,570.00 and is in the original principal amount of \$188,000.00. Grantor expressly covenants and agrees to pay, or see to the payment of, the Existing Indebtedness and to prevent any default on such indebtedness, any default under the instruments evidencing such indebtedness, or any default under the course for such indebtedness.

DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lender, shall constitute an even, of default ("Event of Default") under this Mortgage: (a) Grantor commits fraud or makes a material misrepresentation at any time in connection thin the credit line account. This can include, for example, a false statement about Grantor's income, assets, liabilities, or any other aspects of Grantor's francial condition. (b) Grantor does not meet the repayment terms of the credit line account. (c) Grantor's action or inaction adversely affects the collateral for the credit line account or Lender's rights in the collateral. This can include, for example, failure to maintain required insurance, waste or desire clive use of the dwelling, failure to pay taxes, death of all persons liable on the account, transfer of title or sale of the dwelling, creation of a lien on the one ling without Lander's permission, foreclosure by the holder of another lien, or the use of funds of the dwelling for prohibited purposes.

RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default and at any in the Preventer, Lender, at its option, may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by taw:

Accelerate Indebtedness. Lender shall have the right at its option without notice to Grantor to de tare the entire Indebtedness immediately due and payable, including any prepayment penalty which Grantor would be required to pay.

UCC Remedies. With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property, Lender shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code.

Judicial Foreclosure. Lender may obtain a judicial decree foreclosing Grantor's Interest in all or any part of the Property.

Deficiency Judgment. If permitted by applicable law, Lender may obtain a judgment for any deficiency remaining in the Indebtedness due to Lender after application of all amounts received from the exercise of the rights provided in this section.

Other Remedies. Lender shall have all other rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or the Cradit Agreement or available at law or in equity.

Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. In the event of foreclosure of this Mortgage, Lander shall be entitled to recover from Grantor Lender's attorneys' fees and actual disbursements necessarily incurred by Lender in pursuing such foreclosure.

MISCELL ANEDUS PROVISIONS. The following miscellaneous provisions are a part of this Mortgage:

Applicable Law. This Mortgage has been delivered to Lender and accepted by Lender in the State of Illinois. This Mortgage shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois.

Time is of the Essence. Time is of the essence in the performance of this Mortgage.

Walver of Homestead Exemption. Grantor hereby releases and waives all rights and benefits of the homestead exemption laws of the State of Illinois as to all Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage.

EACH GRANTOR ACKNOWLEDGES HAVING READ ALL THE PROVISIONS OF THIS MORTGAGE, AND EACH GRANTOR AGREES TO ITS TERMS.
