#### Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

#### Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person hame to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after domand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assosable penalty, federate with any costs that may accrue in addition thereby shall be a fien in tayor of the United States upon all property and tight to stopping, whether test or personal, belonging to such person.

#### Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by few, the nenimposed by section 6321 shall alone at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the stability for the amount so assessed for a judgment against the takeayer ensing out of such flability) is satisfied in becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

# (a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And

Studgment Lien Creditors.—The lien imposer by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a sacurity interest, mechanicly lienor, or judgment ben creditor uniffractice thereof which theets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filled by the Secretary.

(a) Release Of Lien.—Subject to such reletions as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary & issue a conflicate of release of any lien imposed with resp to any internal revenue tax not leter than 30 days after that on which.
