

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the seme after domaind, the amount (including any Interest, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, fogether with any costs that may accrue in addition therotoly creat be a lien in favor of the Unitap States upon all property and ignits to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such nesser.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by taw. the lian imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such tability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of tapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder or a security interest, mechanic's lienor, pr judgment flor creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filled by the Secretary.

m Place For Filing Notice; Form. -

(1) Place For Filling . The notice reterred to in subsection (a) shall be filled.

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the Sista (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property-in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; except that State law merely conforming to reenacting Federal law stabilishing a national filling system does not constitute a second office for filling as designated by the laws of such State; or

(8) With Clerk Of District Countin the office of the clork of the United States district countror the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is cituated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the configuration of the property of subparagraph (A), or

requirements of subparagraph (A), or (C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is altuated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be altusted-(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(P) Personal Property-in the case of personal property, whether tanyible or intengible, at the residence of the texpayer at the timr the notice of lien is filed.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or purposes in shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal in principal office of the business is located, and the residence of a tiangyer whose residence is without the United States shall be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - he form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) show by a socioled by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or contrible a notice of flets.

(0) Refilling Of Notice.—For purposes of this section-

- (1) General Rule, —Unless notice of lien is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of then shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f) after the expiration of such refilling period.
- (2) Place For Filling.—A notice of tien rafilled during the required refilling period shall be effective only-

(A) if-

- (i) such notice of lien is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and
- (ii) in the case of real property, and the fact of reliling is annexed and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(8) In any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a satisfying of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations (seued by the Secretary) conterming a change in the taxpeyer's residence, it is notice of such line is also filled in accordance with subsection (i) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period.—In the case of any notice of lian, the term "required refiling period" means.

(A) the one-year portion anding 30 days after the expiration of 10 years after the date of the assessment of the lax and

(b) the one-year period anding with the expiration of 10 years after the close of the proceeding required refiling period for such notice of tien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien.—Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may proscribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any tien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the emount assessed, together with all interest in respect the reof, has been fully satisfied or

has become legally unaniprocable; or

(2) Band Accepted There is turnished to the Semotary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon this payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest is respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any intention of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond end enterties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.—

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien, if a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 8323(f), the amount of the outstanding colligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfiation, written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such ben or intends to obtain a right in such property.
