### Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

#### Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person fails to pay any tax, neglect or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amounts, in addition to the tax, or assessable finally, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

#### Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

#### Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) **Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Liens, And Judgment Lien Creditors.**—The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not prevail over any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lien, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (b) has been filed by the Secretary.

#### In Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) **Place For Filing.**—The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed:

(A) **Under State Laws.**

(i) **Real Property.**—In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated, and

(ii) **Personal Property.**—In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; except that State law may continuing to re-enacting Federal law, re-enacting a national filing system does not constitute a second office for filing as designated by the laws of such State, or

(B) **With Clerk Of District Court.**—In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to the lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A); or

(C) **With Register Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia.**—In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) **Sale Of Property Subject To Lien.**—For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (2), property shall be deemed to be situated:

(A) **Real Property.**—In the case of real property, at its principal location, or

(B) **Personal Property.**—In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For purposes of paragraph (2)(B), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located, and the residence of a taxpayer whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) **Form.**—The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law requiring the formal consent of a holder of the

7. Residential property subject to a mechanic's lien for certain repair work improvements
8. Attorney's fees

(4) **Refiling Of Notice.**—For purposes of this section:

(1) **General Rule.**—Unless notice of lien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (1) after the expiration of such refiling period).

(2) **Place For Filing.**—Such notice of lien refiled during the required refiling period shall be effective only:

(A) **At:**

(i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed; and

(ii) in the case of real property, and the face of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (1)(4); and

(iii) in any case in which 30 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the
