

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount addition to tax; or seessable pennify, logather with any costs that may accrue in addition thereta) shall be a lied in fewer of the United Stane upon all property and rights to property whether read or hereaunal, bedding to such person. [1].

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 5321 what arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayor arising out of such liability is satisfied or becomes unaniforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Valldity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And

Sudgment Lien Creditors.—The Hen Imposed by section 5321 shall not be valid as against any surchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's liency, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the flews of such State, in which the property subject to the lien as stutsted; and

(ii) Personal Property-In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intengible, in one office within the Blate (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is estuated; except that State have manely centerming to researching Federal law establishing a national filling system does not constitute a second office for filling or described by the laws of such State, or

(B) Personal Property in the case of personal property, whether varigible or intemptible at the residence of the taxpeyer at the time on nutice of lien is filed.

(g) Refiling Of Notice.—For purposes of this section:

(1) General Rule, —Unless notice of lien is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f) after the expiration of such refiling period.

(2) Place For Filling.—A notice of then refilled during the required refilling period shall be effective only-

(A) If-

(I) such notice of lien is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, and the fact of refling is entered and recorded in un index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of iten under subpengraph (A), the

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 10 years after the date of the assessment of the last, and

(B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 10 years after the close of the preceding required reffling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Referse Of Lieft, —Subject to such requiations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall see a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which:

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable. The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Becreary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any later slor of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the upon all euroles thereon, as may be specified by such

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(t) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes.—

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding flen, if a notice of tien has been filled pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such tier risy be disclosed to any person who furnishes estellation; written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lient or intends to obtain a right in such property.
