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CONSTRUCTION MORTGAGE AND SECURITY AGREEMENT WITH ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS

This Construction Mortgage and Security Agreement with Assignment of Rents ("Mortgage") dated as of May 27, 1992 from BEVERLY TRUST COMPANY, an Illinois corporation, not personally, but as Trustee under Trust Agreement dated December 27, 1992 and known as Trust No. 742141 ("Trustee"), with a mailing address of 10312 fouth Cicero Avenue, Oak Lawn, Illinois 60453 and PASQUINELLI, INC., an Illinois corporation ("Beneficiary", and together with Trustee, "Mortgagor") with a mailing address of P.O. Box 1/30, 915 West 175th Street, Homewood, Illinois 60430, to and for the benefit of LASALLE BANK LAKE VIEW, an Illinois banking corporation, with its office at 3201 North Ashland Avenue, Chicago, Illinois 60657-2107 (hereinafter referred to as "Mortgagee").

WHEREAS, Mortgagor has executed and delivered to Mortgages a promissory note payable to Mortgages bearing even date herewith in the principal amount of \$5,77(,)30.00 (said note and any and all extensions and renewals thereof, amendments thereto and substitutions or replacements therefor is referred to herein as the "Note") pursuant to which Mortgagor promises to pay said principal sum (or so much thereof as may he outstanding at the maturity thereof) together with interest on the balance of principal from time to time outstanding and impaid thereon at the rate and at the times specified in the Note; and

WHEREAS, the Note has been issued under and subject to the provisions of a Construction Loan Agreement bearing evon date herewith between Mortgagor and Mortgagee (such Construction Loan Agreement being hereinafter referred to as the "Loan Agreement").

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WHEREAS, the indebtedness evidenced by the Note is a "revolving credit loan" as such term is used in Section 6405 of Chapter 17 of the Illinois Revised Statute.

NOW, THEREFORE, to secure (i) the payment when and as due and payable of the principal of and interest on the Note or so much thereof as may be advanced from time to time under and pursuant to the Loan Agreement, (ii) the payment of all other indebtedness which this Mortgage by its terms secures and (iii) the performance and observance of the covenants and agreements contained in this Mortgage, the Loan Agreement, the Note and any other instrument or document securing the Note, (all of such indebtedrass, obligations and liabilities identified in (i), (ii) and (iii) above being hereinafter referred to as the "indebtedness hereby secured"), the Mortgagor does hereby grant, sell, convey, sortgage and assign unto the Mortgages, its successors and assigns and does hereby grant to Mortgagee, its successors and assigns a security interest in all and singular the properties, rights, interests and privileges described in Granting Clauses I, II, III. IV, V and VI below all of same being collectively referred to herein as the "Mortgaged Premises":

GRANTING CLAUSE I

That certain real estate lying and being in the County of Cook and State of Illinois, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

GRANTING CLAUSE II

All buildings and improvements of every kind and description heretofore or hereafter erected or placed on the property described in Granting Clause I and all materials intended for construction, reconstruction, alteration and repair of the buildings and improvements now or hereafter erected thereon, all of which materials shall be deemed to be included within the premises immediately upon the delivery thereof to the seid real estate, all fixtures, machinery, apparatus, equipment, fittings and articles of personal property of every kind and natura whatsoever owned by Mortgagor now or hereafter attached to or contained in or used in connection with said real estate and the buildings and improvements now or hereafter located thereon and the operation, maintenance and protection thereof, including but not limited to, all machinery, motors, fittings, radiators, awnings, shades, screens, all gas, coal, steam, electric, oil and other heating, cooking, power and lighting apparatus and fixtures, all fire prevention and extinguishing equipment and apparatus, all cooling and ventilating apparatus and systems, all plumbing, incinerating, sprinkler equipment and fixtures, all elevators and escalators, all communication and electronic

monitoring equipment, all window and structural cleaning rigs and all other machinery and other equipment of every nature and fixtures and appurtenances thereto and all items of furniture, appliances, draperies, carpets, other furnishings, equipment and personal property used in the operation, maintenance and protection of the said real estate and the buildings and improvements now or hereafter located thereon and all renewals or replacements thereof or articles in substitution therefor, whether or not the same are or shall be attached to said buildings or improvements in any manner; it being mutually agreed, intended and declared that all the aforesaid property shall, so far as permitted by law, be deemed to form a part and parcel of the real estate and for the purpose of this Mortgage to be real estate and covered by this Mortgage; and as to the balance of the property aforesaid, this Mortgage is hereby deemed to re as well a Security Agreement under the provisions of the Uniform Commercial Code for the purpose of creating hereby a security interast in said property, which is hereby granted by Mortgagor as debtor to Mortgagee as secured party, securing the indebtedness hereby secured. The addresses of Mortgagor (debtor) and Mortgagee (secured party) appear at the beginning hereof.

GRANTING CLAUSE III

All right, title and interest of Mortgagor now owned or hereafter acquired in and to all and singular the estates, tenements, hereditaments, privileges, easements, licenses, franchises, appurtenances and royalties, mineral, oil and water rights belonging or in any wise appertaining to the property described in the preceding Granting Clause I and the buildings and improvements now or hereafter located hereon and the reversions, rents, issues, revenues and profits thereof, including all interest of Mortgagor in all rents, issues and profits of the aforementioned property and the rents, issues, profits, revenues, royalties, bonuses, rights and benefits due, payable or accruing (including all deposits of soney as advance rent or for security) under any and all leases and renewals thereof or under any contracts or options for the sale of all or any part of said property (including during any period allowed by law for the redemption of said property after any foreclesure or other sale), together with the right, but not the obligation, to collect, receive and receipt for all such rents and other was and apply them to the indebtedness hereby secured and to demand, sue for and recover the same when due or payable; provided that the assignments made hereby shall not impair or diminish the obligations of Mortgagor under the provisions of such leases or other agreements nor shall such obligations be imposed upon Mortgagee. By acceptance of this Mortgage, Mortgagee agrees that until an Event of Default (as hereinafter defined) shall occur giving Mortgagee the right to foreclose this Mortgage, Mortgager may collect, receive (but not more than 30 days in advance) and enjoy such rents.

CRANTING CLAUSE IV

All judgments, awards of damages, settlements and other compensation hereafter made resulting from condemnation proceedings or the taking of the property described in Granting Clause I or any part thereof or any building or other improvements now or at any time hereafter located thereon or any easement or other appurtenance thereto under the power of eminent domain, or any similar power or right (including any award from the United States Government at any time after the allowance of the claim therefor, the ascertainment of the amount thereof and the issuance of the warrant for the payment thereof), whether permanent or temporary, or for any damage (whether caused by such taking or otherwise) to said property or any part thereof or the improvements thereon or any part thereof, or to any rights appurtenant thereto, including severance and consequential damage, and any award for change of grade of streets (collectively "Condemnation Awards").

GRANTING CLAUSE Y

All property and rights, if any, which are by the express provisions of this instrument required to be subjected to the lien hereof and any additional property and rights that may from time to time hereafter by imptallation or writing of any kind, be subjected to the lien hereof.

GRANTING CLAUSE VI

All rights in and to common area and access roads on adjacent properties heretofore or hereafter granted to Mortgagor and any after-acquired title or reversion in and to the beds of any ways, roads, streets, avenues and alleys adjoining the property described in Granting Clause I or any part thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the Mortgaged Premises and the properties, rights and privileges hereby granted, bargained, sold, conveyed, mortgaged, pledged and assigned, and in which a security interest is granted, unto Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, forever; provided, however, that this instrument is upon the express condition that if the principal of and interest on the Note shall be paid in full and all other indebtedness hereby secured shall be fully paid and performed and any commitment to advance funds contained in the Loan Agreement shall have been terminated, then this instrument and the estate and rights hereby granted shall cease, determine and be void and this instrument shall be released by Mortgagee upon the written request and at the expense of Mortgagor, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

Mortgagor hereby covenants and agrees with Mortgagee as follows:

- 1. Payment of the Indebtedness. The indebtedness hereby secured will be promptly paid as and when the same becomes due.
- Representation of Title and Further Assurances. Mortgagor will execute and deliver such further instruments and do such further acts as may be reasonably necessary or proper to carry out more effectively the purpose of this instrument and, without limiting the foregoing, to make subject to the lien hereof any property agreed to be subjected hereto or covered by the Granting Clauses hereof or intended so to be. At the time of delivery of these presents, the Mortgagor is well seized of an indefeasible estate in fee simple in the portion of the Mortgaged Premiser which constitutes real property subject only to the matters set forth in Exhibit "B" attached hereto and hereby made a part hersef (the "Permitted Exceptions"), and Mortgagor has good right, full power and lawful authority to convey, mortgage and create a security interest in the same, in the manner and form aforesaid; except as set forth in Exhibit "B" hereto, the same is free and clear of all liens, charges, easements, covenants, condition, restrictions and encumbrances whatsoever, including the personal property and fixtures, security agreements, conditional sales contracts and anything of a similar nature, and the Mortgagor shall and will forever defend the title to the Mortgaged Premises against the claims of all persons whomsoever.
- Mortgage, in part, secures an obligation for the construction of improvements on the real property harrin described, and constitutes a construction mortgage for the purpose of Article Nine of the Uniform Commercial Code of Illinois and is entitled to all of the benefits afforded construction mortgages thereunder.
- 4. Compliance with Loan Agreement. Morcgagor will abide by and comply with and be governed and restricted by all of the terms, covenants, provisions, restrictions and agreements contained in the Loan Agreement, and in each and every supplement thereto or amendment thereof which may at any time or from time to time be executed and delivered by the parties thereto or their successors and assigns.
- 5. Provisions of Loan Agreement. The proceeds of the Note are to be disbursed by the Mortgages in accordance with the terms contained in the Loan Agreement, the provisions of which are incorporated herein by reference to the same extent as if fully set forth herein. Mortgagor covenants that any and all monetary disbursements made in accord with the Loan Agreement shall constitute adequate consideration to Mortgagor for the enforceability of this Mortgage and the Note, and that all advances and indebtedness arising and accruing under the Loan Agreement from time to time, whether or not the total amount

thereof may exceed the face amount of the Note, shall be secured by this Mortgage; provided, however, that the total indebtedness secured by the Note and any other document or instrument now or hereafter given as security for the indebtedness hereby secured shall not in any event exceed \$20,000,000.00. Upon the occurrance of an Event of Default under the Loan Agreement, the Mortgages may (but need not): (i) declare the entire principal indebtedness and interest thereon due and payable and pursue all other remedies conferred upon Mortgages by this Mortgage or by law upon a default; or (ii) complete the construction of the improvements described in the Loan Agreement and enter into the necessary contracts therefor. All monies so expended shall be so much additional indebtedness secured by this Mortgage and shall be payable on demand with interest at the Default Interest Rate (as defined in the Note). Mortgagee may exercise either or both of the aforesaid remedies. The provisions, rights, powers and remedies conceined in the Loan Agreement are in addition to, and not in substitution for, those contained herein.

- Payment of Taxes. Mortgagor shall pay before any 6. penalty attaches all general taxes and all special taxes, special assessments, water, drainage and sewer charges and all other charges, of any kind whatsoever, ordinary or extraordinary, which may be levied, assessed, imposed or charged on or against the Mortgaged Premises or any part thereof and which, if unpaid, might by law become a lien of charge upon the Mortgaged Premises or any part thereof, and shall exhibit to Mortgages official receipts evidencing such payments, except that, unless and until foreclosure, distraint, sale or other similar proceedings shall have been commenced, no such charge or claim need be paid if being contested (except to the extent any full or partial payment shall be required by law), after notice to Mortgagee, by appropriate proceedings which shall operate to prevent the collection thereof or the sale or forfeiture of the Mortgaged Premises or any part thereof to satisfy the same, conducted in good faith and with due diligence and if Mortgagor shall have furnished such security, if any, as may be required in the proceedings or required by Mortgagee's title insurer to insure over the lien of such taxes.
- Mortgages. Mortgagor agress that if any tax, assessment of imposition upon this Mortgage or the indebtedness hereby secured or the Note or the interest of Mortgages in the Mortgaged Premises or upon Mortgages by reason of any of the foregoing (including, without limitation, corporate privilege, franchise and excise taxes, but excepting therefrom any income tax on interest payments on the principal portion of the indebtedness hereby secured imposed by the United States or any State) is levied, assessed or charged, then, unless all such taxes are paid by Mortgagor to, for or on behalf of Mortgages as they become due and payable (which Mortgagor agrees to do upon demand of

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Mortgages, to the extent permitted by law), or Mortgages is reimbursed for any such sum advanced by Mortgages, all sums hereby secured shall become immediately due and payable, at the option of Mortgages upon thirty (30) days' notice to Mortgagor, notwithstanding anything contained herein or in any law heretofore or hereafter enacted, including any provision thereof forbidding Mortgagor from making any such payment. Mortgagor agrees to provide to Mortgages, upon request, official receipts showing payment of all taxes and charges which Mortgagor is required to pay hereunder.

Tax and Insurance Deposits. Upon Mortgagee's request, Mortgagor sovenants and agrees to deposit with Mortgages, commencing on the date of Mortgagee's request and on the first day of each month thereafter until the indebtedness secured by this Mortgage 44 fully paid, a sum equal to (i) one-twelfth (1/12th) of the animal taxes and assessments (general and special) on the Mortgaged Premises (unless said taxes are based upon assessments which exclude improvements thereon now constructed or to be constructed, in which event the amount of such deposits shall be pased upon Mortgagee's reasonable estimate as to the amount of taxes and assessments to be levied and assessed) and (ii) one-twelfth (1/12th) of the annual premiums payable for the insurance required to be maintained in accordance with Paragraph 11 hereof. If prior deposits are insufficient, immediately following an Event of Default (as hereinafter defined), Mortgagor shall deposit with Mortgagee an amount of money which, together with the aggregate of the monthly deposits made or to be made pursuant to (i) above as of one month prior to the date on which the total annual taxes and assessments for the current calendar year become due, shall be sufficient to pay in full the total annual taxes and assessments estimated by Mortgagee to become due an payable with respect to the Mortgaged Premises for the current calendar year, and an amount of money which, together with the aggregate deposits made or to be made pursuant to (ii) above as of one month prior to the date on which the next annual insurance premium becomes due, shall be sufficient to pay in full the total annual insurance premium estimated by Mortgagee to next become due and payable with respect to the Mortgaged Premises. Such deposits are to be reld without any allowance of interest and are to be used for the payment of taxes and assessments (general and special) and insurance premiums, respectively, on the Mortgaged Premises next due and payable when they become due. Mortgagee may, at its option, itself pay such taxes, assessments and insurance premiums when the same become due and payable (upon submission of appropriate bills therefor from Mortgagor) or shall release sufficient funds to Mortgagor for payment of such taxes, assessments and insurance pramiums. If the funds so deposited are insufficient to pay any such taxes, assessments (general or spacial) and premiums for any year when the same shall become due and payable, Mortgagor shall within ten (10) days after receipt

of demand therefor, deposit additional funds as may be necessary to pay such taxes, assessments (general and special) and premiums in full. If the funds so deposited exceed the amount required to pay such taxes, assessments (general and special) and premiums for any year, the excess shall be applied on a subsequent deposit or deposits. Said deposits need not be kept separate and apart from any other funds of Mortgagee. Anything in this Paragraph 8 to the contrary notwithstanding, if the funds so deposited are insufficient to pay any such taxes, assessments (general or special) or premiums or any installment thereof, Mortgagor will, not later than the thirtieth (30th) day prior to the last day on which the same may be paid without penalty or interest, deposit with Mortgagoe the full amount of any such deficiency.

- Mortgages's Interest In and Use of Deposits. Upon the occurrence of an Event of Default under this Mortgage, the Note, the Loan Agreement or any other document securing the Note, the Mortgages may at it's option, without being required so to do, apply any monies at the time on deposit pursuant to Paragraph 8 hereof to the performance of any of Mortgagor's obligations hereunder or under the Mote or Loan Agreement, in such order and manner as Mortgagee may elect. When the indebtedness secured hereby has been fully paid, any remaining deposits shall be paid to Mortgagor. Such deposits are hereby pledged as additional security for the indebtedness narsunder and shall be irrevocably applied by Mortgages for the purposes for which made hereunder and shall not be subject to the direction or control of Mortgagor; provided, however, that Mortgages shall not be liable for any failure to apply to the payment of taxes, assessments and insurance premiums any amount so deposited unless Mortgagor, while not in default hereunder, shall have requested Mortgages in writing to make application of such funds to the payment of which they were deposited, accompanied by the bills for such taxes, assessments and insurance premiums. Mortgages Shall not be liable for any act or omission taken in good faith or pursuant to the instruction of any party.
- 10. Recordation and Payment of Taxes and Expense Incident Thereto. Mortgagor will cause this Mortgage, all mortgage, supplemental hereto and any financing statement or other notices of a security interest required by Mortgagee at all times to be kept, recorded and filed at its own expense in such manner and in such places as may be required by law for the recording and filing or for the rerecording and refiling of a mortgage, security interest, assignment or other lien or charge upon the Mortgaged Premises, or any part thereof, in order fully to preserve and protect the rights of Mortgagee hereunder, and, without limiting the foregoing, Mortgagor will pay or reimburse Mortgagee for the payment of any and all taxes, fees or other charges incurred in connection with any such recordation or rerecordation, including any documentary stamp tax or tax imposed

upon the privilege of having this instrument or any instrument issued pursuant hereto recorded.

- 11. <u>Insurance</u>. Mortgagor will, at its expense, maintain insurance in accordance with the requirements of the Loan Agraement. The proceeds of such insurance shall be applied as provided in Section 12 hereof. In the event of foreclosure, Mortgagor authorizes and empowers Mortgagee to effect insurance upon the Mortgaged Premises in the amounts aforesaid, for a period covering the time of redemption from foreclosure sale provided by law, and if necessary therefor, to cancel any or all existing insurance policies.
 - 12. Pamage to and Destruction of the Improvements.
- (a) Notice. In the case of any material damage to or destruction of any improvements which are or will be constructed on the Mortgaged Premises or any part thereof, Mortgagor shall promptly give notice thereof to Mortgagee generally describing the nature and extent of such damage or destruction. Material damage shall mean damages in excess of \$10,000.00.
- (b) Restoration. (pon the occurrence of any damage to or destruction of any improvements on the Mortgaged Premises, provided Mortgagee permits the proceeds of insurance to be used for repairs as provided in Paragraph 12(c) below, Mortgagor shall cause same to be restored, replaced or rebuilt as nearly as possible to their value, condition and character immediately prior to such damage or destruction. Such restoration, replacement or rebuilding shall be effected promptly and Mortgagor shall notify the Mortgagee if it appears that such restoration, replacement or rebuilding may unduly delay completion of such improvements. Any amounts required for repairs in excess of insurance proceeds shall on paid by Mortgagor.
- (c) Application of Insurance Proceeds. Net Insurance proceeds received by the Mortgagee under the provision, of this Mortgage or any instrument supplemental hereto or therata or any policy or policies of insurance covering any improvements on the Mortgaged Premises or any part thereof shall be applied by the Mortgages at its option as and for a prepayment on the Note (whether or not the same is then due or otherwise adequately secured) or shall be disbursed for restoration of such improvements (in which event the Mortgages shall not be obligated to supervise restoration work nor shall the amount so released or used be deemed a payment of the indebtedness evidenced by the If insurance proceeds are permitted to be used to restore such improvements as provided in this Paragraph 12(c), Mortgages may do all necessary acts to accomplish that purpose including using funds deposited by Mortgagor with it for any purpose and advancing additional funds, all such additional funds to

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constitute part of the indebtedness secured by the Mortgage. Mortgages elects to make the insurance proceeds available to Mortgagor for the purpose of effecting such a restoration, or, following an Event of Default, elects to restore such improvements, any excess of insurance proceeds above the amount necessary to complete such restoration shall be applied as and for a prepayment on the Note. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions Mortgagee agrees that net insurance proceeds shall be made available for the restoration of the portion of the Mortgaged Premises damaged or destroyed if written application for such use is made within thirty (30) days after receipt of such proceeds and the following conditions are satisfied: (1 Event of Default, or event which if uncured within any applicable cure period, would constitute an Event of Default, shall have occurred or be continuing hereunder or under the Loan Agreement (and if such an event shall occur during restoration Mortgagee may, at its election, apply any insurance proceeds then remaining in its hands to the reduction of the indebtedness evidenced by the Note and the other indebtedness hereby secured), (ii) if the cost of repairs exceeds \$25,000 Mortgagor shall have submitted to Mortgage plans and specifications for the restoration which shall be actisfactory to it in Mortgagec's reasonable judgment, (iii) Mortgager shall have submitted to Mortgagee evidence satisfactory to Mortgagee (including, at Mortgagee's election, fixed price contracts with good and responsible contractors and materialmen (cyering all work and materials necessary to complete restoration), that the cost to complete restoration is not in excess of the amount of insurance proceeds available for restoration, or if a deficiency shall exist, Mortgagor shall have deposited the abount of such deficiency with Mortgages, (iv)
Mortgagor shall have obtained a waiver of the right of
subrogation from any incurer under such policies of insurance,
(v) in Mortgagee's judgment, all restoration can be completed
prior to the "Schedulea Completion Date" (as defined in the Loan Agreement), and (vi) no lesses or contracts for the sale of any portion of the Mortgaged Premises are terminated as a result of such casualty. Any insurance proceeds to be released pursuant to the foregoing provisions may at the option of Mortgagee be disbursed from time to time as restoration progresses to pay for restoration work completed and in place and such disbursements shall be disbursed in such manner in Mortgagee may determine. Mortgagee may impose such further conditions upon the release of insurance proceeds (including the receipt of title insurance) as are customarily imposed by prudent construction lenders to insure the completion of the restoration work free and clear of all liens or claims for lien. All necessary and reasonable title insurance charges and other costs and expanses paid to or for the account of Mortgagee in connection with the release of such insurance proceeds shall constitute so much additional indebtedness secured by this Mortgage to be payable upon demand and if not paid upon demand shall bear interest at the Default Mortgages may Interest Rate (as defined in Section 37 hereof)

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deduct any such costs and expenses from insurance proceeds at any time held by Mortgagee. No interest shall be payable to Mortgagor upon insurance proceeds held by Mortgagee.

(d) <u>Adjustment of Loss</u>. Mortgages is hereby authorized and empowered, at its option, to adjust or compromise any loss of more than \$25,000 under any insurance policies covering or relating to the Mortgaged Premises and to collect and receive the proceeds from any such policy or policies. Mortgagor hereby irravocably appoints Mortgagee as its attorney-in-fact for the purposes set forth in the preceding sentence. Each insurance company is hereby authorized and directed to make payment (i) of 100% of all such losses of more than said amount directly to Mortgages alone and (ii) of 100% of all such losses of said amount or less directly to Mortgagor alone, and in no case to Mortgagor end Mortgagee jointly. After deducting from such insurance proceeds any expenses incurred by Mortgagee in the collection and sattlement thereof, including without limitation attorneys' and adjusters' fees and charges, Mortgagee shall apply the net proceeds as provided in Paragraph 12(c). Mortgages shall not be responsible for any failure to collect any insurance proceeds due under the terms of any policy regardless of the cause of such failure except for its gross negligence or willful misconduct.

13. Eminent Domain.

- (a) Notice. Mortgagor covenants and agrees that Mortgagor will give Mortgages immediate notice of the actual or threatened commencement of any proceedings under condemnation or eminent domain affecting all or any part of the Mortgaged Premises including any easement therein or appurtenance thereof or severance and consequential damage and change in grade of streets, and will deliver to Mortgages copied of any and all papers served in connection with any such proceedings.
- Assignment of Claim, Power of Attorney to Collect, Etc. Any and all awards heretofore or hereafter made or to be made to the present and all subsequent owners of the Mortgages Premises by any governmental body for taking or affecting the whole or any part of said Mortgaged Premises, the improvements on the Mortgaged Premises or any easement therein or appurtenance thereto (including any award from the United States Government at any time after the allowance of the claim therefor, the ascertainment of the amount thereof and the issuance of the award for payment thereof) are hereby assigned by Mortgagor to Mortgagee to the extent of the existing principal balance, interest thereon and other outstanding charges owed by Mortgagor to Mortgagee and Mortgagor hereby irrevocably constitutes and appoints Mortgagee its true and lawful attorney in fact with full power of substitution for it and in its name, place and stead to collect and receive the proceeds of any such award granted by

virtue of any such taking and to give proper receipts and acquittances therefor. Mortgages shall not settle any condemnation award with the condemning party without the consent of the Mortgagor. Mortgagor shall have the right to participate in any proceedings which determine the award to be granted.

- Effect of Condemnation and Application of Awards. the event that any proceedings are commenced by any governmental body or other person to take or otherwise affect the Mortgaged Premises, the improvements thereon or any easement therein or appurtenance thereto, Mortgagee may, at its option, apply the proceeds of any award made in such proceedings as and for a prepayment on the indebtedness evidenced by the Note, notwithstanding the fact that said indebtedness may not then be due and payable or is otherwise adequately secured. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Mortgagee agrees that Mortgagee shall not apply the proceeds of any award made at such proceedings as and for prepayment on the indebtedness evidenced by the Note if the following conditions are satisfied: (i) the effect of such proceedings will not materially interfere with the ability of Mortgagor to utilize the Mortgaged Premises for its intended purpose; (ii) the proceedings do not cause one or more tenants to terminate the leases; (iii) no Event of Default, or event which if uncured within any applicable cure period, would constitute an Event of Default, shall have occurred or be continuing hereunder or under the Loan Agreement; and (iv) if the proceedings will result in a need to perform repairs upon the Mortgaged Premises, the requirements listed in subparagraphs (ii), (iii), (v) and (vi) of Section 12(c) of this Mortgage concerning the application of insurance proceeds are satisfied.
- Construction, Repair, Waste, Etc. Except for the improvements on the Mortgaged Premises to be constructed pursuant to the provisions of the Loan Agreement, Morcoagor covenants and agrees (i) that no building or other improvement on the Mortgaged Premises and constituting a part thereof shall be materially altered, removed or demolished nor shall any fixtures or appliances on, in or about said buildings or improvements be severed, removed, sold (except as expressly permitted in provided in Paragraph 8.6 of the Loan Agreement) or mortgaged, without the consent of Mortgages; and in the event of the demolition or destruction in whole or in part of any of the fixtures, chattels or articles of personal property covered hereby, the same will be replaced promptly by similar fixtures, chattels and articles of personal property at least equal in quality and condition to those replaced, free from any security interest in or encumbrance thereon or reservation of title thereto; (ii) to permit, commit or suffer no waste, impairment or deterioration of the Mortgaged Premises or any part thereof; (iii) to keep and maintain said Mortgaged Premises and every part thereof in good and first class repair and condition (ordinary wear and tear excepted); (iv) to effect such repairs as Mortgagee may reasonably require and from

time to time to make all needful and proper replacements and additions so that said buildings, fixtures, machinery and appurtenances will, at all times, be in good and first class condition, fit and proper for the respective purposes for which they were originally erected or installed; (v) to comply with all statutes, orders, requirements or decrees relating to said Mortgaged Premises by any Federal, State or Municipal authority; (vi) to observe and comply with all conditions and requirements necessary to preserve and extend any and all rights, licenses, permits (including, but not limited to, zoning variances, special exceptions and nonconforming uses), privileges, franchises and concessions which are applicable to the Mortgaged Premises or which have been granted to or contracted for by Mortgagor in connection with any existing or presently contemplated use of the Mortgaged Premises or any part thereof and not to initiate or acquiesce in any changes to or terminations of any of the foregoing or of zening classifications affecting the use to which the Mortgaged Framises or any part thereof may be put without the prior written consent of Mortgagee; and (vii) to make no alterations in or Exprovements or additions to the Mortgaged Premises without Mortgage's written permission except as contemplated by the Luan Agreement or required by governmental. authority.

15. Liens and Encumbrances. Mortgagor will not, without the prior written consent of Mortgagee, directly or indirectly, create or suffer to be created, or to remain, and will discharge or promptly cause to be discharged any mortgage, lien, encumbrance or charge on, pledge of conditional sale or other title retention agreement with respect to the Mortgaged Premises or any part thereof, whether superior or subordinate to the lien hereof, except for this instrument and the lien of all other documents given to secure the indebtedness hereby secured; provided, however, that Mortgagor may contest the validity of any mechanic's lien, charge or encumbrance (other than the lien of this Mortgage or of any other document securing payment of the Note) upon giving Mortgages timely notice of its intention to contest the same and either (a) maintaining with Mortgagee a deposit of cash or negotiable securities satisfactory to Mortgagee in an amount sufficient in the opinion of Mortgagee to pay and discharge or to assure compliance with the matter under contest in the event of a final determination thereof adversely to Mortgagor or (b) obtaining title insurance coverage over such lien on Mortgagee's title insurance policy. Mortgagor agrees to prosecute and contest such lien diligently and by appropriate legal proceedings which will prevent the enforcement of the matter under contest and will not impair the lien of this Mortgage or interfere with the normal conduct of business on the Mortgaged Premises. On final disposition of such contest, any cash or securities in Mortgagee's possession not required to pay

or discharge or assure compliance with the matter contested shall be returned to Mortgagor without interest.

- 16. Right of Mortgages to Perform Mortgagor's Covenants. Etc. If Mortgagor shall fail to make any payment or perform any act required to be made or performed hereunder, Mortgages, without waiving or releasing any obligation or default, may (but shall be under no obligation to) at any time thereafter upon prior written notice to Mortgagor and failure of Mortgagor to make such payment or perform such act within any applicable cure period provided herein make such payment or perform such act for the account and at the expense of Mortgagor, and may enter upon the Mortgaged Premises or any part thereof for such purpose and take all such action thereon as, in the opinion of Mortgagee, may be necessary or appropriate therefor. All sums so paid by Mortgagee and all costs and expenses (including, without limitation, reasonable attorneys' fees and expenses) so incurred, together with interest thereon from the date of payment or incurrence at the Default Interest Rate, shall constitute so much additional indebtedness hereby secured and shall be paid by Mortgagor to Mortgague on demand. Mortgages in making any payment authorized under this Section relating to taxes or assessments may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate or into the validity of any tax assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof.
- hereafter acquired Property. Any and all property hereafter acquired which is of the kind or nature herein provided and related to the premises described in Granting Clause I hereof, or intended to be and become subject to the lien hereof, shall ipso facto, and without any further scaveyance, assignment or act on the part of Mortgagor, become and of subject to the lien of this Mortgage as fully and completely as though specifically described herein; but nevertheless Mortgagor shall from time to time, if requested by Mortgagee, execute and deliver any and all such further assurances, conveyances and assignments as Mortgagee may reasonably require for the purpose of expressly and specifically subjecting to the lien of this Mortgage, all such property.
- 18. <u>Inspection by Mortgages</u>. Mortgages and its agents shall have the right to inspect the Mortgaged Premises at all reasonable times, and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.
- 19. <u>Subrogation</u>. Mortgagor acknowledges and agrees that Mortgages shall be subrogated to any lien discharged out of the proceeds of the loan evidenced by the Note or out of any advance by Mortgages hereunder or under the Loan Agreement, irrespective of whether or not any such lien may have been released of record.

- 20. Environmental Matters.
- (a) <u>Definitions</u>. As used herein, the following terms shall have the following meanings:
 - (i) "Environmental Laws" means all federal, state and local statutes, laws, rules, regulations, ordinances, requirements, or rules of common law, including but not limited to those listed or referred to in paragraph (b) below, any judicial or administrative interpretations thereof, and any judicial and administrative consent decrees, orders or judgments, whether now existing or hardinafter promulgated, relating to public health and safaty and protection of the environment.
 - (11) "Hazardous Material" means any above or underground storage tanks, flammables, explosives, accelerants, asbestos, radioactive materials, radon, urea formaldehyde foam insulation, lead-based paint, polychlorinated hiphenyls, petroleum or petroleum based or related substances hydrocarbons or like substances and their additives or constituents, methane, solid wastes, refuse, garbage, construction debris, rubble, hazardous materials, hazardous westes, toxic substances or related materials, and including, without limitation, substances now or hereafter defined as "hadardous substances", "hazardous materials", "toxic substances" or "hazardous wastes" in The Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act of 1980, as amanued (42 U.S.C. \$9601, at. seq.), as amended by the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986 (P.L. 99-499, 42 U.S.C.), Toxic Substance Control Act of 1976 as amended, (15 U.S.C. \$2601 et. seq.), The Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, as amended (42 U.S.C. \$6901, et. seg.) The Hazardous Materials Transportation Act, as amended (49 U.S.C. \$1801, at. ssq.), The Clean Water Act, as amended (13 U.S.C. §1251, at. seq.), The Clean Air Act, as amended (410 U.S.C. \$7401 et. seg.), The Illinois Environmental Protection Act, as amended (Ill. Rev. Stat. Ch. 111-1/2 51001 et. 2011), any so-called "Superfund" or "Superlien" law or any other applicable federal, state or local law, common law, code, rule, regulation, or ordinance, presently in effect & hereafter enacted, promulgated or implemented.
 - (iii) "Environmental Liability" means any losses, liabilities, obligations, penalties, charges, fees, claims, litigation demands, defenses, costs, judgments, suits, proceedings, response costs, damages (including consequential damages), disbursements or expenses of any kind or nature whatsoever (including attorneys' fees at trial and appellate levels and experts' fees and disbursements and expenses incurred in investigating,

defending against or prosecuting any litigation, claim or proceeding) which may at any time be imposed upon, incurred by or asserted or awarded against Mortgagee or any of Mortgagee's parent or subsidiary corporations, and their affiliates, shareholders, directors, officers, employees, and agents (collectively "Affiliates") in connection with or arising from:

- a. any Hazardous Material on, in, under or affecting all or any portion of the Mortgaged Premises, the groundwater, or any surrounding areas;
- b. any misrepresentation, inaccuracy or breach of any warranty, covenant and agreement contained or Taferred to in this Section;
- c. any violation or claim of violation by Mortyagor of any Environmental Laws;
- d. the imposition of any lien for damages caused by, or the recovery of any costs for, the cleanup, release or threatened release of Hazardous Material;
- e. the costs of removal of any and all Hazardous Materials from all or any portion of the Mortgaged Premises of any surrounding areas;
- f. costs incurred to comply, in connection with all or any portion of the Mortgaged Premises or any surrounding areas, with all Environmental Laws with respect to Hazardous Materials;
- g. all civil penalties, armages, costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees incurred by reason of any violation of the Illinois Responsible Property Transfer Act, Ill. Rev. Stat., Ch. 30, Sec 901 et seq. ("IRPTA"), including, but not limited to, the production and recording and filing of a disclosure document in connection with the execution and delivery of the Mortgage to Mortgages or the transactions evidenced or secured by the Note, Loan Agreement and Mortgage.

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- (b) Representations and Warranties. Beneficiary hereby represents and warrants and Trustee represents to Mortgagee that:
 - (i) <u>Compliance</u>. The Mortgaged Premises (including underlying groundwater and areas leased to tenants, if any), and the use and operation thereof, are currently in compliance with all applicable Environmental Laws. All required governmental permits and licenses are in effect,

and Mortgagor is in compliance therewith. All Hazardous Material generated or handled on the Mortgaged Premises, if any, have been disposed of in a lawful manner. Without limiting the foregoing, all Hazardous Material shall be handled in compliance with all applicable Environmental Laws.

- (ii) Absence of Hazardous Material. No generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, transportation or disposal of Hazardous Material is occurring nor, except as disclosed in the Underground Storage Tank Removal Report dated September 15, 1990 from Omega Environmental Services, Inc. and the Supplement dated November 8, 1991 from Mittelhauser Corporation, has occurred on or from the Mortgaged Premises. No environmental or public health or safety hazards currently exist with respect to the Mortgaged Premises or the business or operations conducted thereon. No underground storage tanks (including petroleum storage tanks) are present on or under the Mortgaged Premises.
- (iii) <u>Proceedings and Actions</u>. There are no pending or threatened: (a) actions or proceedings by any governmental agency or any other entity regarding public health risks or the environmental condition of the Mortgaged Premises, or the disposal or presence of Hazardous Material, or regarding any Environmental Laws; or (b) liens or governmental actions, notices of violations, notices of noncompliance or other proceedings of any kind that could impair the value of the Mortgaged Premises, or the priority of this Mortgage lien or of any of the other documents or instruments now or hereafter given as security for the indebtedness hereby secured.
- (iv) Illinois Responsible Property Transfer Act. The Mortgaged Premises is not "real property" within the meaning of Section 3(e) of IRPTA and the granting of this Mortgage does not require the delivery or recording (a) a disclosure document pursuant to IRPTA.
- (c) <u>Mortgagor's Covenants</u>. Mortgagor hereby covenants and agrees with Mortgagee as follows:
 - (i) Compliance. The Mortgaged Premises and the use and operation thereof shall comply with all Environmental Laws. All required governmental permits and licenses shall remain in effect, and Mortgagor shall comply therewith. All Hazardous Material present, handled or generated on the Mortgaged Premises will be disposed in a lawful manner. Mortgagor will satisfy all requirements of applicable Environmental Laws for the maintenance and removal of all underground storage tanks on the Mortgaged Premises, if any. Without limiting the foregoing, all Hazardous Material shall

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be handled in compliance with all applicable Environmental Laws.

- (ii) Absence of Hazardous Material. No Hazardous Material shall be introduced to or handled on the Mortgaged Premises.
- (iii) <u>Proceedings and Actions</u>. Mortgagor shall immediately notify Mortgagee and provide copies upon receipt of all written complaints, claims, citations, demands, inquiries, reports or notices relating to the condition of the Mortgaged Premises or compliance with Environmental Laws. Mortgagor shall promptly cure and have dismissed any such actions and proceedings to the satisfaction of Mortgagee. Mortgagor shall keep the Mortgaged Premises free of any lien imposed pursuant to any Environmental Laws.
- (iv) Environmental Audit. Mortgagor shall provide such information and certifications which Mortgagee may resonably request from time to time to insure Mortgagor's compliance with this Section. To investigate Mortgagee's compliance with Environmental Laws and with this Section, Mortgagee shall have the right, but no obligation, at any time to enter upon the Mortgaged Premises, take samples, review Mortgagor's books and records, interview Mortgagee's employees and officers, and conduct similar activities. Mortgagor shall cooperate in the conduct of such an audit.
- (d) Mortgages Right to Rely. Mortgages is entitled to rely upon Mortgagor's representations and warranties contained in this Section despite any independent investigations by Mortgages or its consultants. The Mortgagor shall take reasonable actions to determine for itself, and to remain awars of, the environmental condition of the Mortgaged Premises and shall have no right to rely upon any environmental investigations or findings made by Mortgages of its consultants.
- (a) Indemnification. Mortgagor agrees to indemnify, defend (at trial and appellate levels and with counsel acceptable to Mortgagee and at Mortgagor's sold rost) and hold Mortgagee and its Affiliates free and harmless from and against Mortgagee's Environmental Liability. The foregoing indemnity shall survive satisfaction of the loan evidenced by the Note and any transfer of the Mortgaged Premises to Mortgagee by voluntary transfer, foreclosure or by a deed in lieu of foreclosure. This indemnification shall not apply to any liability incurred by Mortgagee as a direct result of affirmative actions of Mortgagee as owner and operator of the Mortgaged Premises after Mortgagee has acquired title to the Mortgaged Premises and which actions are the sole and direct cause of damage resulting from the introduction and initial release of a Hazardous Material upon the Mortgaged Premises by Mortgagee; PROVIDED, HOWEVEN, this

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indemnity shall otherwise remain in full force and effect, including, without limitation, with respect to Hazardous Material which is discovered or released at the Mortgaged Premises after Mortgagee acquires title to the Mortgaged Premises but which was not actually introduced at Mortgaged Premises by Mortgagee, with respect to the continuing migration or release of Hazardous Material previously introduced at or near the Mortgaged Premises and with respect to all substances which may be Hazardous Material and which are situated at the Mortgaged Premises prior to Mortgagee taking title but are removed by Mortgagee subsequent to such date.

(f) Waiver. Mortgagor, its successors and assigns, hereby waive, release and agree not to make any claim or bring any cost recovery action against Mortgagee under CERCLA or any state equivalent, or any similar law now existing or hereafter enacted. It is expressly understood and agreed that to the extent that Mortgagee is strictly liable under any Environmental Laws, Mortgagor's obligation to Mortgagee under this indemnity shall likewise be without regard to fault on the part of Mortgagor with respect to the violation or condition which results in liability to Mortgagee.

21. Transfer of the fortgaged Premises.

(a) In determining whether or not to make the loan secured hereby, Mortgagee has examined the credit-worthiness of Mortgagor, found it acceptable and relied and continues to rely upon same as the means of repayment of the loan. Mortgagor is well-experienced in borrowing money and owning and operating property such as the Mortgaged Premises was ably represented by a licensed attorney at law in the negotiation and documentation of the loan secured hereby and bargained at erm's length and without duress of any kind for all of the two and conditions of the loan, including this provision. Mortgagor tacognizes that Mortgagee is entitled to keep its loan portfolic at ourrent interest rates by either making new loans at such Tate or collecting assumption fees and/or increasing the interest rate on a loan, the security for which is purchased by a party other than the original Mortgagor. Mortgagor further recognizes that any secondary or junior financing placed upon the Mortgaged Pramises, (a) may divert funds which would otherwise be used to pay the in Note secured hereby, (b) could result in acceleration and foreclosure by any such junior encumbrancer which would force Mortgagee to take measures and incur expenses to protect its Pramises should Mortgages come into possession thereof with the intention of selling same: and (d) impair Montgages accept a deed in lieu of foreclosure as a foreclosure by Mortgagee would be necessary to clear the title to the Mortgaged Premises.

- (b) In accordance with the foregoing and for the purposes of (i) protecting Mortgagee's security, both of repayment by Mortgagor and in the value of the Mortgaged Premises; (ii) giving Mortgagee the full benefit of its bargain and contract with Mortgagor; (iii) allowing Mortgagee to raise the interest rate and/or collect assumption fees; and (iv) keeping the Mortgaged Premises free of subordinate financing liens, Mortgagor agrees that if this Paragraph be deemed a restraint on alienation, that it is a reasonable one, and Mortgagor shall not permit or suffer to occur any sale, assignment, conveyance, mortgage, lease, pledge, encumbrance or other transfer of, or the granting of any option in, or any contract for any of the foregoing (on an instal) sent basis or otherwise) pertaining to:
 - (1) the Mortgaged Premises, any part thereof, or any interest therein, other than the sale of individual residences in the ordinary course of business as permitted under the Loan Agreement;
 - (ii) the beneficial interest in the Trustee; or
 - (iii) any stock in Beneficiary,

whether involuntary or by operation of law or otherwise, without the prior written consent of fortgages having been obtained to such sale, assignment, conveyance, mortgage, lease, option, pledge, encumbrance or other transfer. Mortgagor agrees that in the event the ownership of the Mcrigaged Premises, any interest therein or any part thereof becomes vested in a person other than Mortgagor, Mortgagee may, without notice to Mortgagor, deal in any way with such successor or successors in interest with reference to this Mortgage, the Note, and any other document evidencing the indebtedness secured hereby. Vithout in any way vitiating or discharging Mortgagor's liability hereunder or under any other document evidencing the indebtedness sacured hereby. No sale of the Mortgaged Premises, forbearance to any person with respect to this Mortgage, or extension to any person of the time for payment of the Note given by Mortgagee shall operate to release, discharge, modify, change or affect the liability of Mortgagor, either in whole or in part, except to the except specifically agreed in writing by Mortgagee. Without limitation of the foregoing, in any event in which the written consent of Mortgagee is required in this Paragraph 21, Mortgagee may condition its consent upon any combination of (i) the payment of compensation to be determined by Mortgages, (ii) the increase of the interest rate payable under the Note, (iii) the shortening of maturity of the Note, and (iv) other modifications of the terms of the Note or the other instruments evidencing the indebtedness secured hereby.

(c) Without limitation of the foregoing, (i) in any event in which Mortgagee's consent is requested in accordance with the

terms of this Paragraph 21, Mortgagor shall pay all expenses incurred by Mortgagee, including reasonable attorneys' fees, in connection with the processing of such request, and (ii) the consent of Mortgagee to any transfer of the Mortgaged Premises shall not operate to release, discharge, modify, change or affect the liability of Mortgagor, either in whole or in part.

- 22. Events of Default. Any one or more of the following shall constitute an "Event of Default" hereunder:
 - (a) Default in making payment within three (3) business days following written notice of the failure to payment (whether by lapse of time, acceleration, or otherwise) of the principal of or interest on the Note or any other indebtedness hereby secured;
 - (b) The Mortgaged Premises is abandoned by the Mortgagor;
 - (c) Default in the observance or performance of any other covenant, condition, agreement or provisions hereof or of the Note or any additional collateral document which is not remedied within that y (30) days after written notice thereof to Mortgagor by Mortgagee;
 - (d) Any representation or warranty made by the Mortgagor or any guarantor of the Note (a "Guarantor") herein or in the Note, Loan Agreement or any additional collateral documents or in any statement or certificate furnished pursuant hereto or thereto proves untrue in any material respect as of the date of the issuance or making thereof;
 - (e) Trustee, Beneficiary or any Guaranter becomes insolvent or bankrupt or admits in writing his or their inability to pay its or their debts as they mature or makes an assignment for the benefit of creditors or applies for or consents to the appointment of a trustee, custodian or receiver for any of them or for the major part of the property of any of them;
 - (f) Mortgagor is unable to satisfy any condition of their right to the receipt of any advances under the Loan Agreement for a period in excess of thirty (30) days other than as a result of matters beyond its control;
 - (g) Bankruptcy, reorganization, arrangement, insolvency or liquidation proceedings or other proceedings for relief under any bankruptcy laws or laws for the relief of debtors are instituted by or against the Trustee,

Beneficiary or a Guarantor and if instituted are not dismissed within sixty (60) days after such institution;

- (h) Any judgment or judgments, writ or writs or warrant or warrants of attachment or any similar process or processes in an aggregate amount in excess of \$25,000 shall be entered or filed against Trustee, Beneficiary or a Guarantor, or against any of their respective property or assets and remains unsatisfied, unvacated, unbonded or unstayed for a period of sixty (60) days;
- (i) The title company refuses to issue the endorsement provided for in Section 4.3(a)(6) of the Loan Agreement because of a change in the state of title or a survey exception and Mortgagor is unable to correct the condition giving rise to the refusal and procure issuance of the notice within thirty (30) days of notice of any such refusal given to Mortgagor by Mortgages; or
- (j) The death of a Guarantor unless such Guarantor's estate complies with the requirements of Section 11.1(r) of the Loan Agreement; or
- (k) Any Event of Default shall occur under the Loan Agreement or any other accument evidencing or securing the indebtedness evidenced by the Note which is not cured or remedied within any applicable grace period(collectively the "Loan Documents").
- 23. Remedies. When any Event of Default has happened and is continuing (regardless of the pendency of any proceeding which has or might have the effect of preventing mortgagor from complying with the terms of this instrument) and in addition to such other rights as may be available under applicable law or under the Loan Agreement, but subject at all times to any mandatory legal requirements:
- (a) Acceleration. Mortgages may, by written rotice to Mortgagor, declare the Note and all unpaid indebtedness of Mortgagor hereby secured, including interest then accrued thereon, to be forthwith due and payable, whereupon the same shall become and be forthwith due and payable, without other notice or demand of any kind.
- (b) <u>Uniform Commercial Code</u>. Mortgages shall, with respect to any part of the Mortgaged Premises constituting property of the type in respect of which realization on a lien or security interest granted therein is governed by the Uniform Commercial Code, have all the rights, options and remedies of a secured party under the Uniform Commercial Code of Illinois, including without limitation, the right to the possession of any such property or any part thereof, and the right to enter with legal

process any premises where any such property may be found. Any requirement of said Code for reasonable notification shall be met by mailing written notice to Mortgagor at its address above set forth at least ten (10) days prior to the sale or other event for which such notice is required. The expenses of retaking, selling and otherwise disposing of said property, including reasonable attorneys' fees and legal expenses incurred in connection therewith, shall constitute so much additional indebtedness hereby secured and shall be payable upon demand with interest at the Default Interest Rate.

- (c) Foreclosure. Mortgages may proceed to protect and enforce the rights of Mortgagee hereunder (i) by any action at law, suit in equity or other appropriate proceedings, whether for the specific performance of any agreement contained herein, for an injunction against the violation of any of the terms hereof, or in aid of the exercise of any power granted hereby or by law, or (ii) by the foreclosure of this Mortgage. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness hereby secured in the decree of sale, all expenditures and expenses authorized by the Illinois Mortgage Foreclosure Law, Chapter 110, Section 15-1101, et seq. Illinois Revised Statutes (1987), as from time to time amended (the "Act") and all other expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgages for attorney's fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographer's charges, publication costs, and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expanded after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, title insurance policies, and similar data and assurance with respect to title as Mortgagee may deem reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at sales which may be had pursuant to such decree the true conditions of the title to or the value of the Mortgaged Premises. All expenditures and expenses of the dature mentioned in this paragraph, and such other expenses and feet as may be incurred in the protection of the Mortgaged Premises and rents and income therefrom and the maintenance of the lien of this Mortgage, including the fees of any attorney employed by Mortgages in any litigation or proceedings affecting this Mortgage, the Note or the Mortgaged Premises, including bankruptcy proceedings, or in preparation of the commencement or defense of any proceedings or threatened suit or proceeding, or otherwise in dealing specifically therewith, shall be so much additional indebtedness hereby secured and shall be immediately due and payable by Mortgagor, with interest thereon at the Default Interest Rate until paid.
- (d) <u>Appointment of Receiver</u>. Mortgagee shall, as a matter of right, without notice and without giving bond to Mortgagor or anyone claiming by, under or through it, and without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagor or Beneficiary or the

then value of the Mortgaged Premises, be entitled to have a receiver appointed pursuant to the Act of all or any part of the Mortgaged Premises and the rents, issues and profits thereof, with such power as the court making such appointment shall confer, and Mortgagor hereby consents to the appointment of such receiver and shall not oppose any such appointment. Any such receiver may, to the extent permitted under applicable law, without notice, enter upon and take possession of the Mortgaged Premises or any part thereof by force, summary proceedings, ejectment or otherwise, and may remove Mortgagor or other persons and any and all property therefrom, and may hold, operate and manage the same and receive all earnings, income, rents, issues and proceeds accruing with respect thereto or any part thereof, whether during the pendency of any foreclosure or until any right of redemption shall expire or otherwise.

- Upon demand Taking Possession, Collecting Rents, Etc. by Mortgagee, Mortgagor shall surrender to Mortgagee and Mortgagee may enter and take possession of the Mortgaged Premises or any part thereof personally, by its agent or attorneys or be placed in possession pursuant to court order as mortgagee in possession or receiver as provided in the Act, and Mortgages, in its discretion, personally by its agents or attorneys or pursuant to court order as mortgagee in possession or receiver as provided in the Act may enter upon and take and maintain possession of all or any part of the Mortgaged Premises, together with all documents, books, records, papers, and accounts of Mortgagor relating thereto, and May exclude Mortgagor and any agents and servants thereof wholly therefrom and may, on behalf of Mortgagor, or in its own name as Mortgages and under the powers herein granted:
 - (i) hold, operate, manage and control all or any part of the Mortgaged Premises and conduct the business, if any, thereof, either personally or by its agence, with full power to use such measures, legal or equitable, as in its discretion may be deemed proper or necessary to enforce the payment or security of the rents, issues, deposits, profits, and avails of the Mortgaged Premises, including without limitation actions for recovery of rent, actions in forcible detainer, and actions in distress for rent, all without notice to Mortgagor;
 - (ii) cancel or terminate any lease or sublease of all or any part of the Mortgaged Premises for any cause or on any ground that would entitle Mortgagor to cancel the same;
 - (iii) elect to disaffirm any lease or sublease of all or any part of the Mortgaged Premises made subsequent to this Mortgage without Mortgagee's prior written consent;

- (iv) extend or modify any then existing leases and make new leases of all or any part of the Mortgaged Premises, which extensions, modifications, and new leases may provide for terms to expire, or for options to lessees to extend or renew terms to expire, beyond the maturity date of the loan evidenced by the Note and the issuance of a deed or deeds to a purchaser or purchasers at a foreclosure sale, it being understood and agreed that any such leases, and the options or other such provisions to be contained therein, shall be binding upon Mortgagor, all persons whose interests in the Mortgaged Premises are subject to the lien hereof, and the purchaser or purchasers at any foreclosure sale, nativithstanding any redemption from male, discharge of the indebtedness hereby secured, satisfaction of any foreclosure decree, or issuance of any cortificate of sale or deed to any such purchaser;
- (v) make all necessary or proper repairs, decoration renewals, replacements, alterations, additions, betterments, and improvements in connection with the Mortgaged Premises as may seem judicious to Mortgagee, to insure and reinsure the Mortgaged Premises and all risks incidental to Mortgagee's possession, operation and management thereof, and to receive all rents, issues, deposits, profits, and avails therefrom; and
- (vi) apply the net income, after allowing a reasonable fee for the collection thereof and for the management of the Mortgaged Premises, to the payment of taxes, premiums and other charges applicable to the Mortgaged Premises, or in reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured in such order and manner as Mortgagee shall select.

Nothing herein contained shall be construed as constituting Mortgagee a mortgagee in possession in the absence of the actual taking of possession of the Mortgaged Premises. right to enter and take possession of the Mortgaged Premises and use any personal property therein, to manage, operate, conserve and improve the same, and to collect the rents, issues and profits thereof, shall be in addition to all other rights or remedies of Mortgages hereunder or afforded by law, and may be exercised concurrently therewith of independently thereof. The expenses (including any receiver's fees, counsel fees, costs and agent's compensation) incurred pursuant to the powers herein contained shall be secured hereby which expenses Mortgagor promises to pay upon demand together with interest at the rate applicable to the Note at the time such expenses are incurred. Mortgagee shall not be liable to account to Mortgagor for any action taken pursuant hereto other than to account for any rents actually received by Mortgagee. Without taking possession of the Mortgaged Premises,

Mortgagee may, in the event the Mortgaged Premises become vacant or are abandoned, take such steps as it deems appropriate to protect and secure the Mortgaged Premises (including hiring watchmen therefor) and all costs incurred in so doing shall constitute so much additional indebtedness hereby secured payable upon demand with interest thereon at the Default Interest Rate.

- (b) If any provision of this Mortgage shall grant to Mortgagee any rights or remedies upon default of the Mortgagor which are more limited than the rights that would otherwise be vested in Mortgagee under the Act in the absence of said provision, Mortgagee shall be vested with the rights granted in the Act to the full extent permitted by law.
- (c) Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, all expenses incurred by Mortgages to the extent reimbursable under Sections 15-1510 and 15-1512 of the Act, whether incurred before or after any decree or judgment of foreclosure, and whether enumerated in Sections 23(c) or 26 of this Mortgage, shall be added to the indebtadness secured by this Mortgage or by the judgment of foreclosure.
- 25. Waiver of Right to Redeem From Sala Waiver of Appraisement, Valuation, Etc. Mortgagor shall not and will not apply for or avail itself of any appraisement, valuation, stay, extension or exemption laws, or any so-called "Moratorium Laws," now existing or hereafter enacted in order to prevent or hinder the enforcement or foreclosure of this Mortgage, but hereby waives the benefit of such laws. In the event of any sale made under or by virtue of this instrument, the whole of the Mortgaged Premises may be sold in one parcel as an entirety or in separate lots or parcels at the same or different times, all as the Mortgagee may determine. Mortgagee shall have the right to become the purchaser at any sale made under or by virtue of this instrument and Mortgages so purchasing at any such sale shall have the right to be credited upon the amount of the hid made therefor by Mortgagee with the amount payable to

Mortgagee out of the net proceeds of such sale. In the event of any such sale, the Note and the other indebtedness hereby secured, if not previously due, shall be and become immediately due and payable without demand or notice of any kind. Mortgagor acknowledges that the Mortgaged Premises does not constitute agricultural real estate, as defined in Section 15-1201 of the Act, or residential real estate, as defined in Section 15-1219 of the Act. To the fullest extent permitted by law, Mortgagor, pursuant to Section 15-1601(b) of the Act, hereby voluntarily and knowingly waives any and all rights of redemption on behalf of Mortgagor, and each and every person acquiring any interest in, or title to the Mortgaged Premises described herein subsequent to the date of this Mortgage, and on behalf of all other persons to the extent permitted by applicable law.

- Costs and Expenses of Foreclosure. In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof there shall be allowed and included as additional indeficedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgagee for attorneys' fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expant evidence, stenographic charges, publication costs and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after the entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, witle searches and examination, quarantee policies, Torrene certificates and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Mortgagee may deem to be reasonably necessary either to prosecute any foreclosure action or to evidence to the bidder at any sale pursuant thereto the true condition of the title to or the value of the Mortgaged Premises, and all of which expenditures shall become so much additional indebtedness hereby secured which Mortgagor agrees to pay and all of such shall be immediately due and payable with interest thereon from the date of expenditure until paid at the Default Interest Rate.
- 27. Insurance After Foreclosure. - 29. <u>Protective Advances</u>. All advances, disbursements and expenditures made by Mortgages before and during a foreclosure, and before and after judgment of foreclosure, and at any time prior to sale, and, where applicable, after sale, and during the pendency of any related proceedings, for the following purposes, in addition to those otherwise authorized by this Mortgage or by the Act (collectively "Protective Advances"), shall have the benefit of all applicable provisions of the Act, including those provisions of the Act hereinbelow referred to:
- (a) all advances by Mortgagee in accordance with the terms of this Mortgage to: (i) preserve or maintain, repair, restore or rebuild the improvements upon the Mortgaged Premises; (ii) preserve the lien of this Mortgage or the priority thereof; or (iii) enforce this Mortgage, as referred to in Subsection (b) (5) of Section 15-1302 of the Act;
- (b) payments by Mortgagee of: (i) when due installments of principal, interest or other obligations in accordance with the terms of any senior mortgage or other prior lien or encumbrance; (ii) when due installments of real estate taxes and assessments, general and special and all other taxes and assessments of any kind or nature whatsoever which are assessed or imposed upon the mortgaged real estate or any part thereof; (iii) other obligations authorized by this Mortgage; or (iv) with court approval, any other amounts in connection with other liens, encumbrances or interests reasonably necessary to preserve the status of title, as referred to in Section 15-1505 of the Act;
- (c) advances by Mortgagee in saitlement or compromise of any claims asserted by claimants under menior mortgages or any other prior liens;
- (d) attorneys' fees and other costs incurred (other than in connection with an unsuccessful attempt by Mortgages to enforce the provisions of this mortgage): (i) in connection with the foreclosure of this Mortgage as referred to in Section 1504 (d)(2) and 15-1510 of the Act; (ii) in connection with any action, suit or proceeding brought by or against the Mortgages for the enforcement of this Mortgage or arising from the interest of the Mortgages hereunder; or (iii) in the preparation for the commencement or defense of any such foreclosure or other action;
- (a) Mortgagee's fees and costs, including attorneys' fees, arising between the entry of judgment of foreclosure and the confirmation hearing as referred to in Subsection (b)(1) of Section 15-1508 of the Act;
- (f) advances of any amount required to make up a deficiency in deposits for installments of taxes and assessments and insurance premiums as may be authorized by this Mortgage;

- (g) expenses deductible from proceeds of sale as referred to in Subsections (a) and (b) of Section 15-1512 of the Act;
- (h) expenses incurred and expenditures made by Mortgagee for any one or more of the following: (a) premiums for casualty and liability insurance paid by Mortgagee whether or not Mortgages or a receiver is in possession, if reasonably required, in reasonable amounts, and all renewals thereof, without regard to the limitation to maintaining of existing insurance in effect at the time any receiver or mortgagee takes possession of the mortgaged real estate imposed by Subsection (c)(1) of Section 15-1704 of the Act; (b) repair or restoration of damage or destruction in excess of available insurance proceeds or condemnation awards; (c) payments required or deemed by Mortgagee to be for the benefit of the Mortgaged Premises under any grant or declaration of easement, easement agreement, agreement with any adjoining land owners or instruments creating covenants or restrictions for the benefit of or affecting the mortgaged real estate; (d) shared or common expense assessments payable to any association or corporation in which the owner of the mortgaged real estate is a member in any way affecting the mortgaged real estate; (e) pursuant to any lease or other agreement for occupancy of the mortgages real estate.

All Protective Advances shall be so much additional indebtedness secured by this Mortgage, and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon from the date of the advance until paid at the Default Interest Rate.
