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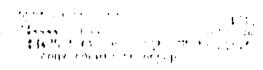

1. GRANT OF MORTGAGE. 2. DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following meanings when used in this Mortgage. Terms not otherwise defined in this Mortgage shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Illinois Uniform Commercial Code. All references to dollar amounts shall mean amounts in tawful money of the United States of America.

Borrower. The word "Borrower" means each and every person who signs the LOANLINER® Home Equity Plan Credit Agreement secured by this Mortgage.

Credit Agreement. The words "Credit Agreement" mean the revolving line of credit agreement dated <u>Julio 1 1992</u>, between Lender and Grantor with a credit limit of the amount shown on the first page of this Security Instrument, logether with all renewals of, extensions of, modifications of, refinancings of, consolidations of, and substitutions for the Credit Agreement. The interest rate under the revolving line of credit is a variable interest rate based upon an index. The index currently is $\frac{1}{2012}$, per annum. The interest rate to be applied to the outstanding account balance shall be at a rate $\frac{3}{2012}$, percentage points above the index, subject however to the following minimum and maximum rates. Under no circumstances shall the interest rate be less than 8.000% per annum or more than the maximum rate allowed by applicable law.

Indebtedness. Specifically, without Hinitation, this Mortgage secures a revolving line of credit, which obligates Lender to make advances to Grantor so long as Grantor compiles with all the terms of the Credit Agreement. Such advances may be made, repaid, and remade from time to time, subject to the limitation that the total outstanding belance owing at any one time, not including finance charges on such belance at a fixed or variable rate or sum as provided in the Credit Agreement, any temporary overages, other, charges, and any amounts expended or advanced as provided in this paragraph, shall not exceed the Credit as provided in the Credit Agraement. Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Lender in writing prior to doing so and so long as Lender's interests in the Property are not jeopardized. Lender may require Grantor to post adequate security or a surely bond, reasonably satisfactory to Lender, to protect Lender's interest.

Payment. Grantor shall pay when due (and in all events prior to duling lency) all taxes, payroll taxes, special taxes, assessments, water charges and sewer service charges levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for with done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Right To Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any lax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Lender's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Lender at least fitteen (15) days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property, if any mechanic's lien, materialmen's lien, or other lien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials and the cost exceeds \$10,000.00. Grantor will upon request of Lender furnish to Lender advance assure any satisfactory to Ender that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

10. PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Mortgage:

Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgagee clause in favor of Lender. If the Real Property is located in an area designated by the Director's of the Federal Emergency Managament Agency as a special flood hazard area, Grantor agrees to obtain Federal Flood Insurance to the extent's such insurance is required and is available for the term of the loan and for the full unpaid principal balance of the loan. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor shall deliver to Lender certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lender.

Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Lender of any loss or damage to the Property if the estimated cost of repair or replacement exceeds \$10,000.00. Lender may make proof of loss if Grantor fails to do so within fifteen (15) days of the casualty. If, in Lander's judgment, the restoration or repair is economically feasible and Lender's security is not lessened, insurance proceeds shall be applied to restoration or repair of the damaged Property. If the restoration or repair is not economically feasible or Lender's security would be lessened, the insurance proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Mortgage whether or not then due, with any excess paid to Grantor. If Grantor abandons the Property, or does not answer within thirty (30) days a notice from Lender that the insurance carrier has offered to settle a claim, then Lender may collect the insurance proceeds. Lender may use the proceeds to repair or restore the Property or to pay sums secured by this Mortgage, whether or not then due.

This can include, for example, failure to maintain required insurance, waste or destructive use of the dwelling, failure to pay texes, death of all persons liable on the account, transfer of title or sale of the dwelling, creation of a lien on the dwelling without Lender's permission, foreclosure by the holder of another lien, or the use of funds or the dwelling for prohibited purposes.
- 19. GRANTOR'S RIGHT TO CURE. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default (other than fraud or material misrepresentation) and prior to

exercising any of the rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or by law, Lender shall give notice as provided in the Mortgage and as required by applicable law. The notice may be combined or sent with any notice required by applicable law and shall specify: (a) the Event of Default, (b) the action required to cure the default, (c) a date not less than thirty (30) days (or any longer period as required by applicable law or elsewhere in this Mortgage) from the date the notice is given to Grantor by which the default must be cured and. (d) that failure to cure the default on or before the date specified in the notice may result in acceleration of the sums secured by this Mortgage and sale of the property. The notice shall further inform Grantor of the right to reinstate after acceleration and thu right to assert in a foreclosure proceeding the nonexistence of an event of default or any other defense of Grantor to acceleration and sale. However, if Lander has given Grantor a right to cure with respect to a prior Event of Default which occurred within three hundred sixty-five (365) days of the present event of Default, Grantor shall not be entitled to receive the right to cure described in this paragraph.

20. RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default and at any time thereafter, Lender, at its option, may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

Accelerate Indebtedness. Lender shall have the right at its option to declare the entire Indebtedness immediately due and payable.

Mortgagee in Possession. Lender shall have the right to be placed as mortgagee in possession or to have a receiver appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding foreclosure or sale, and to collect the Rents from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, against the indebtedness. The mortgagee in possession or receiver may serve without bond if permitted by law. Lander's right to the appointment of a receiver shall exist whether or not the apply and value of the Property exceeds the indebtedness by a substantial amount. Employment by Lander shall not disquality a person from serving as a receiver.

Judicial Forectosure. Lind ir may obtain a judicial decree foreclosing Grantor's interest in all or any part of the Property.

Deficiency Judgment. If parmitted by applicable law, Lender may obtain a judgment for any deficiency remaining in the indebtudness due to Lender after application of all arrich its received from the exercise of the rights provided in this section.

Other Remedies. Lender shall have all other rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or the LOANLINER® Home Equity Plan Cradit Agreement or available at law or in equity.

Sale of the Property. To the extent permitted by applicable law, Grantor hereby waives any and all right to have the property marshalled. In exercising its rights and remedies, Lender shall be free to sell all or any part of the Property together or separately, in one sale or by separate sales. Lender shall be entitled to bid at any public solution and property.

Notice of Sale. Lerider shall give Grantor reasonable notice of the hime and place of any public sale of the Personal Property or of the time after which any private sale or other intended disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least ten (10) days before the time of the sale or disposition.

Walver; Election of Remedies. A waiver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's rights otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision of the provision. Election by Lender to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expanditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Mortgage after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect Lender's right to decisir, a default and exercise its remedies under this Mortgage.

Altorneys' Fees; Expenses. If Lender institutes any suit or action to anrons any of the terms of this Morigage, Lender shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys' fees at trial and, on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Lender that in Lender's opinion are microstary at any time for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the indebtedness payable on demand and shall 'tier interest from the date of expenditure until repaid at the Credit Agreement rate. Expenses covered by this paragraph include, without tambation, however subject to any limits under applicable law, Lender's attorneys' fees and tegal expenses whether or not there is a lawsuit, including attorneys' fees for bankruptcy proceedings (including efforts to modify or vacate any automatic stay or injunction), appeals and any anticipated post-judgment collection services, the cost of searching records, obtaining title reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyors' reports, and appraise 'tells, and title insurance, to the extent permitted by applicable law. Grantor also will pay any court costs, in addition to all other surns provided by law.

- 21. NOTICES TO GRANTOR AND OTHER PARTIES. Any notice under this Mortgage, including without imitation any notice of default and any notice of sale to Grantor, shall be in writing and shall be effective when actually delivered or, if mailed, shall be deem to effective when deposited in the United States mail first class, registered mail, postage prepaid, directed to the addresses shown near the beginning of the Mortgage. Any party may change its address for notices under this Mortgage by giving formal written notice to the other parties, specifying that the (urpo is of the notice is to change the party's address. All copies of notices of foreclosure from the holder of any lien which has priority over this Mortgage and to Lender's address, as shown near the beginning of this Mortgage. For notice purposes, Grantor agrees to keep Lender informed at all times or Grantor's current address.
- 22. ASSOCIATION OF UNIT OWNERS. The following provisions apply if the Real Property has been submitted to unit (with ship law or similar law for the establishment of condominiums or cooperative ownership of the Real Property.

Power of Attorney. Grantor grants an irrevocable power of attorney to Lender to vote in its discretion on any matter that may come before the association of unit owners. Lander shall have the right to exercise this power of attorney only after default by Grantor; however, Lender may decline to exercise this power as it sees fit.

trisurance. The insurance as required above may be carried by the association of unit owners on Grantor's behalf, and the proceeds of such insurance may be paid to the association of unit owners for the purpose of repairing or reconstructing the Property. If not so used by the association, such proceeds shall be paid to Lender.

Compliance with Regulations of Association. Grantor shall perform all of the obligations imposed on Grantor by the declaration submitting the Real Property to unit ownership, by the bylaws of the association of unit owners, or by any rules or regulations thereunder. If Grantor's interest in the Real Property is a leasehold interest and such property has been submitted to unit ownership, Grantor shall perform all of the obligations imposed on Grantor by the lease of the Real Property from its owner.

23. MISCELL ANEOUS PROVISIONS. The following miscellaneous provisions are a part of this Mortgage:

Amendments. This Mortgage, together with any Related Documents, constitutes the antire understanding and agreement of the parties as to the matters set forth in this Mortgage. No alteration of or amendment to this Mortgage shall be effective unless given in writing and signed by the party or parties sought to be charged or bound by the alteration or amendment.

Applicable Law. This Mortgage shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of illinois.

Caption Headings. Caption headings in this Mortgage are for convenience purposes only and are not to be used to interpret or define the provisions of this Mortgage.

Grantor's Copy of Documents. Lender agrees to provide Grantor with a conformed copy of both the LOANLINER® Home Equity Plan Credit Agreement and this Mortgage at the time they are executed or within a reasonable time after this Mortgage is recorded.

UNOFFICIAL COPY

Merger. There shall be no merger of the interest or estate created by this Morigage with any other interest or estate in the Property at any time held by or for the benefit of Lender in any capacity, without the written consent of Lender.

Severability. If a court of competent jurisdiction finds any provision of this Mortgage to be invalid or unenforceable as to any person of circumstance, such finding shall not render that provision invalid or unenforceable as to any other persons or circumstances. If leasible, any such offending provision shall be deemed to be modified to be within the limits of enforceability or validity; however, if the offending provision cannot be so modified, it shall be stricken and all other provisions of this Mortgage in all other respects shall remain valid and enforceable.

Successors and Assigns. Subject to the limitations stated in this Mortgage on transfer of Grantor's interest, this Mortgage shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors and assigns. If ownership of the Property becomes vested in a person other than Grantor. Lender, without notice to Grantor, may deal with Grantor's successors with reference to this Mortgage and the Indebtedness by way of torbearance or extension without releasing Grantor from the obligations of this Mortgage or liability under the Indebtedness.

Time to of the Essence. Time is of the essence in the performance of this Mortgage

Waiver of Homestead Exemption. Grantor hereby releases and waives all rights and benefits of the homestead exemption laws of the State of Illinois as to all Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage.

Walvers and Consents. Lender shall not be deemed to have waived any rights under this Mortgage (or under the Related Documents) unless such waiver is in writing and signed by Lender. No delay or omission on the part of Lender in exercising any right shall operate as a waiver of such right or any office, right. A waiver by any party of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's right otherwise to demand sinct compliance with that provision or any other provision. No prior waiver by Lender, nor any course of dealing between Lender and Grantor, shall constitute a waiver of any of Lender's rights or any of Grantor's obligations as to any future transactions. Whenever consent by Lender is required in this Mortgage, the granting of such consent by Lender in any instance shall not constitute continuing consent to subsequent instances where single consent is required.
