Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

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if any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pa the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty together, with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in jayor of the United States upon all properly and rights to properly, whither left of personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 small arise at the time the assersment is made and shall continue until the liability for the gmount so assessed (or a Judgment against the taxpayor arising out of such flability) is satisfied or becomes unanforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The Hen Imposod by section 6321 shall not be yaird as against any burcheser, holder of a specifity (blarest, mechanic s-lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice hereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

In one office) within the State (or the county, or other governmental aubdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is structed; except that State law merely conforming to reenacting Federal law establishing a national fi
