THIS MORTGAGE IS DATED MAY 7, 1993, between Thomas R. Rybks and Lenore M. Rybks, his wife (J), whose address is 5340 South Christiana Avenue, Chicago, IL. 60632-3216 (referred to below as "Granter"); and Marquette Nation Bank, whose address is 5400 South Kedzie, Chicago, IL. 60632 (referred to below as "Lender").

GRANT OF MORTGAGE. For valuable consideration, Grantor mortgages, warrants, and conveys to Lander all of Grantor's right, little, and interest in and to the following described real property, together with all existing or subsequently erected or affixed buildings, improvements and fixtures; all easements, rights of way, and appurtenances; all water, water rights, watercourses and ditch rights (Including stock in utilities with ditch or irrigation rights); and all other rights, rules and profits relating to the real property, including without limitation all minerals, oil, gas, geothermal and similar matters, located in Cook County, State of Illinois (the "Real Property");

The Real Property or its address is commonly known as 5340 South Christians Avenue, Chicago, IL. 60632. The

Grantor presently assigns to Lender all of Grantor's light, title, and interest in and to all leases of the Property and all Rants from the Property. In addition, Grantor grants to Lender a Uniform Commercial Code security interest in the Personal Property and Rents.

DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following inconings when used in this Mortgage. Terms not otherwise defined in this Mortgage shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Uniform Campieralal Code. All references to dollar amounts shall mean amounts in lewful money of the United States of America.

Credit Agreement. The words "Credit Agreement" mean the revolving line of credit agreement dated May 7, 1993, between Lender and Granton With a credit limit of \$10,000.00, together with all renuwals of, extensions of, modifications of, refinancings of, consolidations of, and substitutions for the Credit Agreement. The maturity date of this identical may 13, 2000. The interest rate under the revolving line of credit is a variable interest rate based upon an index. The index currently is 8,000% per annum. The interest rate to be applied to the outstanding account balance shall be at a rate 1,000 percentage points above the index, subject however to the following minimum and maximum rates. Under no circumstances shall the interest rate be less than 1,000% per annum or not a than the lesser of 18,000% per annum or the maximum rate allowed by applicable law. ettler tide 1989 a kurent morre.

Existing indebtedness. The words "Existing Indebtedness" mean the Indebtedness described below in the Existing Indebtedness section of this Mortgage.

Grantor. The word "Grantor" means Thomas R. Rybka and Lenore M. Rybka. The Grantor is the mortgagor under this Mortgage. ATABIG

Quarantor. The word "Guaranter" means and includes without ilmitation, each and a lift guaranters, suraties, and accommodation parties in connection with the Indebtedness.

indebtedness. The word "indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under the Credit Agreement and any amounts expended or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Grantor or expenses incurred by Lender to entered obligations of Grantor under this Mortgage, together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Mortgage. Specifically, without time". Item, this Mortgage secures a revolving line together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Mortgage. Specifically, without fimif—item, this Mortgage secures a revolving line of credit and shall secure not only the amount which Lender has presently advanced to Granfor under the Credit Agreement within fiverity (20) years from the date of this Mortgage to the same extent as it such tuture advance were made as of the date of the execution of this Mortgage. The revolving line of credit obligates Lender to make advances to Granfor so long as Granfor complies with all the terms of this Credit Agreement and Related Documents. Such advances may be made, repaid, and remade from time to time, subject to the limit donn that the Itelal outsiangling balance owing at any one time, not including finance charges on such balance at a fixed or variable raw or was provided in the Credit Agreement, any temporary overages, other charges, and any amounts expended or advanced as provided in the paragraph, shall not exceed the Credit Limit as provided in the Credit Agreement. It is the intention of Granfor and Lender that the Mortgage securise the balance outstanding under the Credit Agreement from time to time from zero up to the Credit Limit as provided above and intermediate balance. intermediate balance.

Personal Property. The words "Personal Property" mean all aquipment, fixtures, and other articles of personal property now or hereafter owned by Grantor, and now or hereafter attached or affixed to the Real Property; together with all accessions, parts, and additions to, all replacements of, and all substitutions for, any of such property; and together with all proceeds (including without limitation all insurance proceeds and refunds of premiums) from any sale or other disposition of the Property.

Property. The word "Property" means collectively the Real Property and the Personal Property.

Real Property. The words "Real Property" mean the property, interests and rights described above in the "Grant of Morigage" eaction. 😘

nd Reals Property. Rents. The word "Rents" means all present and future rents, revenues, income, issues, royalties, profits, and other benefits derived from the 1990, 1995, Book and Block managers as an annihada transprop

THIS MORTGAGE, INCLUDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND THE SECURITY INTEREST IN THE HENTS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY, IS GIVEN TO SECURE (1) PAYMENT OF THE INDESTEDNESS AND (2) PERFORMANCE OF ALL OBLIGATIONS OF GRANTOR UNDER THIS MORTGAGE. THIS MORTGAGE IS INTENDED TO AND SHALL BE VALID AND HAVE PRIORITY OVER ALL SUBSEQUENT LIENS AND ENCUMBRANCES, INCLUDING STAUTORY LIENS, EXCEPTING SOLELY TAXES AND ASSESSMENTS LEVIED ON THE REAL PROPERTY, TO THE EXTENT OF THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT SECURED HEREBY. THIS MORTGAGE IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except as otherwise provided in this Mortgage, Grantor shall pay to Lender all amounts secured by this Mortgage as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grantor's obligations under this Mortgage.

POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that Grantor's possession and use of the Property shall be governed by the following provisions:

Possession and Use. Until in default, Grantor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Real Property and collect the Rants.

Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in tenantable condition and promptly perform all repairs, replacements, and maintenance necessary to preserve its value.

Nulsance, Waste. Grantor shall not cause, conduct or permit any nuisance nor commit, permit, or suffer any stripping of or waste on or to the Property or any portion of the Property. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Grantor will not remove, or grant to any other party the right to remove, any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), soil, gravel or rock products without the prior written consent of Lander.

BUTE ON SALE - CONSENT BY LENDER. Lender may, at its option, declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this Mortgage upon the

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sale or transfer, without the Lender's prior written consent, of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest in the Real Property. A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of Real Property or any right, title or interest therein; whether legal or equitable; whether voluntary or involuntary; whether by cutright sale, deed, installment sale contract, tand contract, contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three (3) years, lease-option contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer of any beneficial interest in or to any land trust holding title to the Real Property, or by any other method of conveyance of Real Property Interest. If any Grantor is a corporation or partnership, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than twenty-five percent (25%) of the voting stock or partnership interests, as the case may be, of Grantor. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender II such exercise is prohibited by federal law or by Illinois law.

TAXES AND LIENS. The following provisions relating to the laxes and fiens on the Property are a part of this Mortgage. 643.00

Psyment. Grantor shall pay when due (and in all events prior to delinquency) all taxes, payroll taxes, special taxes, assessments, water charges and sewer service charges levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of all liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, except for the Edsting Indebtedness referred to below, and except as otherwise provided in the following paragraph.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on an actual cash value basis for the full insurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgages clause in favor of Lender. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor shall deliver to Lender certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of ten (10) days prior written notice to Lender and not containing. any disclaimer of the insurer's stability for failure to give such notice. Should the Real Property at any time become located in an area designated by the Director of the Federal Emergency Management Agency as a special flood hazard area, Grantor agrees to obtain and maintain Federal Flood insurance, to the extent such insurance is required and to or becomes available, for the term of the loan and for the full unpaid principal balance of the loan, of the maximum limit of coverage that is available, whichever is less.

Application of Procured. Grantor shall promptly notify Lender of any loss or damage to the Property. Lender may make proof of loss if Grantor talls to do so within fift ion (15) days of the casualty. Whether or not Lender's security is Impaired, Lender may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the investigations, payment of any lien affecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Carlor falls to comply with any provision of this Mortgage, including any obligation to maintain Existing indebtedness in good standing as required below. Whany action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interests in the Property, Lender on Grantor's behalf may, but shall not be required to, take any action that Lender deems appropriate. Any amount that Lender expends in so doing will bear interest at the rate charged under the Credit Agreement from the date incurred or paid by Lender to the date of repayment by Grantor. All such expenses, at Lender's option, will (a) be payable on demand. (b) be added to the balance of the credit fine and be apportioned among and be payable with any installment payments to become due during either (i) the term of any applicable insurance policy or (ii) the remaining term of the Credit Agreement, or (c) be treated as a ballo on payment which will be due and payable at the Credit Agreement's maturity. This Mortgage also will secure payment of these amounts. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lander may be entitled on account of the default. Any such action by Lander shall not be construed as curing the default so as to bar Lander from any remedy. may be entitled on account of the default. Any such actional find thereise would have had.

WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE. The following province relating to ownership of the Property are a part of this Mortgage

Title. Grantor warrants that: (a) Grantor holds good and marketable title of record to the Property in fee simple, free and clear of all flens and encumbrances other than those set forth in the Real Pripe by sescription or in the Existing indebtedness section below or in any title insurance policy, title report, or final title opinion issued in favor of, and accepted by Lender in connection with this Mortgage, and (b) Grantor has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Mortgage to Lender.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Crantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the tewful claims of all persons.

EXISTING INDEBTEDNESS. The following provisions concerning additing indiptedness (the "Existing Indebtedness") are a part of this Mortgage.

Existing Lien. The flen of this Mortgage securing the indebtedness may be secondary and inferior to the flen securing payment of an existing obligation to LaSalle Talman Home Assn. described as: Mortgage Loan Give April 30, 1979, and recorded in Book May 18, 1979. The existing obligation has a current principal balance of approximately \$29,000.00 and is in the original principal amount of \$37,800.00. Grantor expressly coverants and agrees to pay, or see to the payment of, the Existing indebtedness and to prevent any default on such indebtedness, any default under the instruments evidencing such indebtedness, or any default under any security documents for such indebtedness.

DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lender, shall constitute an event of defruit "Event of Default") under this Mortgage: (a) Grantor commits fraud or makes a material misrepresentation at any time in connection with the (redit line account. This can include, for example, a false statement about Grantor's income, assets, liabilities, or any other aspects of Grantor's financial condition. (b) Grantor does not meet the repayment terms of the credit line account. (c) Grantor's action or inaction adversely affects the collateral or the credit line account or Lender's rights in the collateral. This can include, for example, failure to maintain required insurance, waste or destructly a set of the dwelling, tailure to pay taxes, death of all persons liable on the account, transfer of title or sale of the dwelling, creation of a lien on the dwelling windut Lender's permission, foreclosure by the

Accelerate Indebtedness. Lender shall have the right at its option without notice to Grantor to declare the entire indebtedness immediately due and payable, including any prepayment penalty which Grantor would be required to pay.

UCC Remedies. With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property. Lender shall be used to the Uniform Commercial Code.

Judicial Foreclosure. Lender may obtain a judicial decree foreclosing Grantor's interest in all or any part of the Property.

Deficiency Judgment. If permitted by applicable law, Lender may obtain a judgment for any deficiency remaining in the indebtedness due to Lender after application of all amounts received from the exercise of the rights provided in this section.

Other Remedies. Lender shall have all other rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or the Credit Agreement or available at law or in

Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. In the event of foreclosure of this Mortgage. ender shall be entitled to recover from Grantor Lender's attorneys' fees and actual disbursements necessarily incurred by Lender in pursuing such foreclosure.

MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS. The following misceflaneous provisions are a part of this Mortgage:

Applicable Law. This Mortgage has been delivered to Lender and accepted by Lender in the State of Illinois. This Mortgage shell be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois.

Time is of the Essence. Time is of the essence in the performance of this Mortgage.

Waiver of Homestead Exemption. Grantor hereby releases and waives all rights and benefits of the homestead exemption laws of the State of illinois as to all indebtedness secured by this Mortgage.

EACH GRANTOR ACKNOWLEDGES HAVING READ ALL THE PROVISIONS OF THIS MORTGAGE, AND EACH GRANTOR AGREES TO ITS TERMS.
