#### Sec. 6321. Lian For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest additional amount, audition to tax or session behalty together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a tien in favor of the United States upon all propi and rights to stoperty, whether real or personal, belonging to

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is epecifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the desess-ment is made and shall continue until the flabelty for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxdeyet arieling out of such liability) is astisfied or secomes unshforceable by reason of lapse of time

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judament Lien Creditors. - The den impored by acction 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, medianic's lienor, or judg-ment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirenents of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary

#### m Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing. The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the triws of such State, in which the property subject to

the lien is situitated, and

(ii) Personal Property-in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental aubdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is attusted, except their State law merely conforming to reenacting Federal law establishing a national filing system dose not constitute a second office for filing as designated by the taws of such State; or

(B) With Clerx Of District Court-In the office of the clack of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien to situated, whenever the State has not by lew designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A1, or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Co-lumbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District

of Columbia, if the property subject to the ken is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Cf Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphic (1) and (4), property shall be desired to be altuated. (A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical ncation, or

(B) Personal Property-In the case of personal property, whether trigony or intengible, at the residence of the texpeyer at the me the notice of lien is filed.

(3) Form - The form and contains of the notice referred to in subsection (a) at ill be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwinshinding any other provision of law regarding the form or contain, of a notice of lien.

(t) General Rule. - Unless notice of tien to refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of iten shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f) after the expiration of such refilling period.

(2) Place For Filing, --- A notice of tien refiled during the required refiling period shall be effective only-

(A) If-

(i) such notice of tien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(II) in the case of real property, and the fact of retiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refling of notice of tien under subparagraph (A), the

(3) Required Refiling Period.—in the of any notice of lien, the term "required refiling period" case of any notice of lies, the term means-

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 10 years after the date of the assessment of th tex, and

(B) the one-year pariod ending with the expiration of 10 years after the close of the preceding required refiling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien .- Subject to such requlations as the Scoretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a pertiticate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which .

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, togethor with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully eatisfied or isas become legaliti unenforceable, or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Seplatary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the priment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in ir spect, hereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with auch requirers wis relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bong and elireties thereon, as may be specified by such

#### de Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposer.-

(2) Disclosure of arrount of outstanding tien-if a notice of fien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the putetanding obligation accured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that his new a right in the property subject to such lies or intends to obtain a right in such property.
