Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any fax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount addition to tax, or deseasable beneity, objecter with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be attent in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless snother date is apecifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 8021 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment agenci the texpayer atising out of such lability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The lien imposed by section 8321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, machanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsoction (f) has been filled by the Secretary.
