APPEAL NOTIFICATION

Rev. Stat., Ch. 110, Sec. 3-10. of seq.) and all amendments thereof, and rules adopted pursuant thereto (III. Rev. Stat., Ch. 24, Sec. 11-31, 1-11; Chicago Municipal Code, Sec. 13-14-180).

Any action to review a final administrative prost shall be commenced by the filling of a complaint and issuance of a summons within thirty-five (35) days from the data that a copy of the decision sought to be reviewed was mailed to the party affected thereby.
