THIS MORTGAGE ("Security Instrument") is given on JUNE 10 ^{19 93} The mortgagor is

This Security Instrument is given to CITIBANK, FEDERAL SAVINGS BANK, which is organized and existing under the laws of THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, and whose address is 180 GRAND AVENUE, OAKLAND, CALIFORNIA 94612 ("Lender"). Borrower owes Lender the principal sum of SIXTY THOUSAND AND 00/100

Dollars (U.S. \$ 60,000.00). This debt is evidenced by Borrower's note dated the same date as this Security Instrument ("Note"), which provides for monthly payments, with the full debt, if not paid earlier, due and payable on JULY 1, 2008. This Security Instrument secures to Lender: (a) the repayment of the debt evidenced by the Note, with interest, and all renewals, extensions and modifications of the Note; (b) the payment of all other sums, with interest, advanced under paragraph 7 to protect the security of this Security Instrument; and (c) the performance of Borrower's covenants and agreements under this Security Instrument and the Note. For this purpose, Borrower does hereby mortgage, grant and convey to Lender the following described property located in

TOGETHER WITH all the improvements or hereafter erected on the property, and all easements, appurtenances, and fixtures now or hereafter a part of the property. All replacements and additions shall also be covered by this Security Instrument. All of the foregoing is referred to in this Security Instrument as the "Property."

BORROWER COVENANTS that Borrower is lawfully seized of the estate hereby conveyed and has the right to mortgage, grant and convey the Property and that the Property is unencumbered, except for encumbrances of record. Borrower warrants and will defend generally the title to the Property against all claims and demands, subject to any encumbrances of record.

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4. CHARGES; LENS. Borrower shall pay all taxes, assessments, charges, fines and impositions attributable to the property which may affect this Security Instrument, and leasehold payments or ground rents, if any. Borrower shall pay these obligations in the manner provided in paragraph 2, or if not paid in that manner, Borrower shall pay them on time directly to the person owed payment. Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender all notices of amounts to be paid on time directly to the person owed payment. Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender receipts indicating this paragraph. If Borrower makes these payments directly, Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender receipts indicating this paragraph.

3. APPLICATION OF PAYMENTS. Unless applicable law provides otherwise, all payments received by Lender under paragraphs 1 and 2 shall be applied first, to any prepayment charges due under the Note; second, to amounts payable under paragraph 2; and any sums payable by Borrower to Lenders in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 8, in lieu of the payment of mortgage insurance premiums; third, to interest due; fourth, to principal due; and last, to any late fees and other amounts due under the Note.

Lender shall apply the Funds to pay the Escrow Account credits to the Escrow Account and debits to the Escrow Account, showing credits and debits to the Escrow Account and the purpose for which each debit from the Escrow Account was made. The Funds in the Escrow Account are pledged to Lender as additional security for all sums secured by this Security Instrument. Upon payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument, Lender shall refund to Borrower any Funds held by Lender. Such refund shall be made within 30 days of Borrower's payment of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. Lender and Borrower agree that Lenders' estimate of the amount of Funds needed in the Escrow Account is an approximation to calculate Escrow items. At any time if the Escrow Account balance in the Escrow Account is less than the amount of the defalcation, Borrower may notify Lender to pay Lender the amount of the defalcation. Borrower fails to timely pay Lender the amount of the defalcation, Borrower shall be in default if, after receipt of notice from Lender, Borrower fails to timely pay Lender the amount of the defalcation. Borrower shall pay to Lender on the day monthly payments are due under the Note, until the Note is paid in full, a sum ("Funds") equal to Lender's estimate, as described below, of (a) one-twelfth of each type of yearly taxes and assessments which may attain priority over this Security Instrument; (b) one-twelfth of yearly leases held by lessees and assessable rents on the Property, if any; (c) one-twelfth of the yearly hazard insurance premiums, if any; (d) one-twelfth of the Property taxes and assessments which may attain priority over this Security Instrument; (e) one-twelfth of any similar items which are commonly paid by borrowers to Lender, whether now or in the future, in connection with secured debt. The items described in (a) - (f) are called "Escrow Items".

1. PAYMENT OF PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST; PREPAYMENT AND LATE CHARGES. Borrower shall promptly pay when due the principal of and interest on the debt evidenced by this Note and any prepayment and late charges due under the Note.

S. HAZARD OF PROPERTY INSURANCE. Borrower shall keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the Property insured against loss by fire, hazards included within the term "extended coverage" and any other hazards for which Lender requires insurance, including floods or flooding, whether or not identified or existing at the time the loan is made. This insurance shall be maintained in the amounts and for the periods that Lender requires. The insurance carrier providing the insurance shall be chosen by Borrower subject to Lender's approval which shall not be unreasonably withheld. If Borrower fails to maintain coverage described above, Lender may, at Lender's option, obtain coverage to protect Lender's rights in the Property in accordance with Paragraph 7.

All insurance policies and renewals shall be acceptable to Lender and shall include a standard mortgage clause. Lender shall have the right to hold the policies and renewals. If Lender requires, Borrower shall promptly give to Lender all receipts of paid premiums and renewal notices. In the event of loss, Borrower shall give prompt notice to the insurance carrier and Lender. Lender may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Borrower.

Insurance proceeds shall be applied to restoration or repair of the Property damaged if, in Lender's sole determination, the restoration or repair is economically feasible and Lender's security is not lessened. If the restoration or repair is not economically feasible or Lender's security would be lessened, the insurance proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due, with any excess paid to Borrower. If Borrower abandons the Property, or does not answer within 30 days a notice from Lender that the insurance carrier has offered to settle a claim, then Lender may collect the insurance proceeds. Lender may use the proceeds to repair or restore the Property or to pay sums secured by this Security Instrument, whether or not then due. The 30-day period will begin when the notice is given.

Unless Lender and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, any application of proceeds to principal shall not extend or postpone the due date of the monthly payments referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 or change the amount of the payments. If under paragraph 21 the Property is acquired by Lender, Borrower's right to any insurance policies and proceeds resulting from damage to the Property prior to the acquisition shall pass to Lender to the extent of the sums secured by this Security Instrument immediately prior to the acquisition.

6. OCCUPANCY, PRESERVATION, MAINTENANCE AND PROTECTION OF THE PROPERTY; BORROWER'S LOAN APPLICATION; LEASEHOLDS. Borrower shall occupy, establish, and use the Property as Borrower's principal residence within sixty days after the execution of this Security Instrument and shall continue to occupy the Property as Borrower's principal residence for at least one year after the date of occupancy, unless Lender otherwise agrees in writing, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld, or unless extenuating circumstances exist which are beyond Borrower's control. Borrower shall not destroy, damage or impair the Property, allow the Property to deteriorate, or commit waste on the Property. Borrower shall be in default if any forfeiture action or proceeding, whether civil or criminal, is begun that in Lender's good faith judgment could result in forfeiture of the Property or otherwise materially impair the lien created by this Security Instrument or Lender's security interest. Borrower may cure such a default and reinstate, as provided in paragraph 18, by causing the action or proceeding to be dismissed with a ruling that, in Lender's good faith determination precludes forfeiture of the Borrower's interest in the Property or other material impairment of the lien created by this Security Instrument or Lender's security interest. Borrower shall also be in default if Borrower, during the loan application process, gave materially false or inaccurate information or statements to Lender (or failed to provide Lender with any material information) in connection with the loan evidenced by the Note, including, but not limited to, representations concerning Borrower's occupancy of the Property as a principal residence. If this Security Instrument is on a leasehold, Borrower shall comply with all the provisions of the lease. If Borrower acquires fee title to the Property, the leasehold and the fee title shall not merge unless Lender agrees to the merger in writing.

7. PROTECTION OF LENDER'S RIGHTS IN THE PROPERTY. If Borrower fails to perform the covenants and agreements contained in this Security Instrument, or there is a legal proceeding that may significantly affect Lender's rights in the Property (such as a proceeding in bankruptcy, probate, for condemnation or forfeiture or to enforce laws or regulations), then Lender may do and pay for whatever is necessary to protect the value of the Property and Lender's rights in the Property. Lender's actions may include paying any sums secured by a lien which has priority over this Security Instrument, appearing in court, paying reasonable attorneys' fees and paying fees for periodic inspections of the Property. In addition to these actions Lender may enter on the Property to make repairs, change locks, replace or board-up doors and windows, drain pipes, eliminate building code violations or dangerous conditions, turn utilities on or off, or undertake whatever else is necessary to protect the value of the Property and Lender's rights in the Property. Although Lender may take action under this paragraph 7, Lender does not have to do so.

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12. SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS BOUND; JOINT AND SEVERAL LIABILITY; CO-SIGNERS. The covenants and agreements of this Security Instrument shall bind and benefit the successors and assigns of Lender and Borrower, subject to the provisions of paragraph 17. Borrower's covenants and agreements shall be joint and several. Any Borrower who co-signs this Security Instrument but does not execute the Note, (a) is co-signing this Security Instrument only to mortgage, grant and convey that Borrower's interest in the sums secured by this Security Instrument under the terms of this Note, and (b) is not bound by the terms of this Note without the Borrower's consent.

Modifications of any of Borrower's or Lender's covenants or agreements under this Security Instrument shall not affect Lender's rights to prohibit or restrict future modifications requested by Borrower, or (iv) affect Property, (iii) act as a satisfaction, release or novation, (ii) change or impair Lender's security interest in the Note or (i) affect Lender's rights to prohibit or restrict future modifications requested by Borrower, or (iv) affect adder's rights or remedies under this Security Instrument or the Note.

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13. LOAN CHARGES. Any notice to Lender shall be given by first class mail postage prepaid to Lender's address stated herein or any other address Lender designates by notice to Borrower. Any notice provided for in this Security Instrument shall be deemed to have been given to borrower or Lender when given as provided in this paragraph.

15. SEVERABILITY. In the event that any provision or clause of this Security Instrument or the Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Security Instrument or the Note which can be given effect without the conflicting provision. To this end the provisions of this Security Instrument and the Note are declared to be severable.

16. BORROWER'S COPY. Borrower shall be given one duplicate of the Note and of this Security Instrument.

17. TRANSFER OF THE PROPERTY OR A BENEFICIAL INTEREST IN BORROWER. If all or any part of the Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred (or if a beneficial interest in borrower is sold or transferred and borrower is not a natural person) without Lender's prior written consent, Lender may, at its option, require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Security Instrument. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if exercise is prohibited by federal law as of the date of this Security Instrument.

If Lender exercises this option, Lender shall give Borrower notice of acceleration. the notice shall provide a period of not less than 30 days from the date the notice is delivered or mailed within which Borrower must pay all sums secured by this Security Instrument. If borrower fails to pay these sums prior to the expiration of this period, Lender may invoke any remedies permitted by this Security Instrument without further notice or demand on Borrower.

18. BORROWER'S RIGHT TO REINSTATE. If borrower meets certain conditions, borrower shall have the right to have enforcement of this Security Instrument discontinued at any time prior to the earlier of: (a) 5 days (or such other period as applicable law may specify for reinstatement) before sale of the Property pursuant to any power of sale contained in this Security Instrument; or (b) entry of a judgment enforcing this Security Instrument. Those conditions are that Borrower: (a) pays Lender all sums which then would be due under this Security Instrument and the Note as if no acceleration had occurred; (b) cures any default of any other covenants or agreements; (c) pays all expenses incurred in enforcing this Security Instrument, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorneys' fees; and (d) takes such action as Lender may reasonably require to assure that the lien of this Security Instrument, Lender's rights in the Property and Borrower's obligation to pay the sums secured by this Security Instrument shall continue unchanged. Upon reinstatement by Borrower, this Security Instrument and the obligations secured hereby shall remain fully effective as if no acceleration had occurred. However, this right to reinstate shall not apply in the case of acceleration under paragraph 17.

19. SALE OF NOTE; CHANGE OF LOAN SERVICER. The Note or a partial interest in the Note (together with this Security Instrument) may be sold one or more times without prior notice to Borrower. A sale may result in a change in the entity (known as the "Loan servicer") that collects monthly payments due under the Note and this Security Instrument. There also may be one or more changes of the Loan Servicer unrelated to a sale of the Note. If there is a change of the Loan Servicer, Borrower will be given written notice of the change in accordance with paragraph 14 above and applicable law. The notice will state the name and address of the new Loan Servicer and the address to which payments should be made. The notice will also contain any other information required by applicable law.

20. HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES. Borrower shall not cause or permit the presence, use, disposal, storage, or release of any Hazardous Substances on or in the Property. Borrower shall not do, nor allow anyone else to do, anything affecting the Property that is in violation of any Environmental Law. The preceding two sentences shall not apply to the presence, use, or storage on the Property of small quantities of Hazardous Substances that are generally recognized to be appropriate to normal residential uses and to maintenance of the Property.

Borrower shall promptly give Lender written notice of any investigation, claim, demand, lawsuit or other action by any governmental or regulatory agency or private party involving the Property and any Hazardous Substance or Environmental Law of which Borrower has actual knowledge. If Borrower learns, or is notified by any governmental or regulatory authority, that any removal or other remediation of any Hazardous Substance affecting the Property is necessary, Borrower shall promptly take all necessary remedial actions in accordance with Environmental Law.

pesticides and herbicides, volatile solvents, materials containing asbestos or formaldehyde, and radioactive materials. As
used in this paragraph 20, "Environmental Law" means federal laws and laws of the jurisdiction where the Property is
located that relate to health, safety or environmental protection.
